FABULOUS CANDY tracked in the two path, was roused entering the far turn, swung out to the five path at the top of the lane, rallied past an inner trio passing the furlong grounds, and drew clear. SHY SHY pressed the pace in the three path, bid under a drive in the two path around the far turn, kept on to sustain that bid into the final furlong, but flattened around the sixteenth for place. TOO HOT TO STOP chased inside, was ridden along the rail around the far turn, cut the corner to bid at the top of the lane, but faded in the final furlong to show. SING SCAT stalked in the four path, bid under a ride in the three path midway around the far turn, swung out to the six path at the top of the stretch, but weakened in the final furlong. CROSSATI set the pace inside, came under rousing passing the three-eighths pole, fought on from the three path entering the lane, but yielded in the final furlong. OMIKAMI raced off the pace in the two path, was driven from the rail around the far turn, but made no final bid. POLA OF TROUBLE trailed in the three path, was ridden in the two path around the far turn, floated out to the five path at the top of the lane, and did not threaten.

LA GATA SALVAJE chased in the two path, was ridden in the three path around the turn, swung from the five path into the lane, rallied on the left lead, and inched ahead of an inner foe in the final strides. LIZZIE BABY raced in midpack in the three path, was driven around the turn, took aim at the top of the stretch, ran on to lead just after the eighth pole, but got edged out by an outer foe in the final strides. SHOOPHEREITIS raced off the pace in the three path, was driven around the far turn, got briefly stymied turning into the lane, angled out to the six path, and rallied for show. OOPS HAHA tracked inside, was driven in the two path around the turn, bid in the three path passing the eighth pole, but flattened in the final sixteenth. HEAVENS EXPRESS was wellback along the rail, pushed along around the turn, tipped out to the three path passing the eighth pole, and mildly improved. EARLY DELIVERY was hustled between foes from in range in the two path, lost ground around the turn, cut the corner entering the stretch, stayed on but had to steady and alter

out around the eighth pole, then got out-kicked. QUEEN ATLAS drew away early to set an open pace in the two path, was cued passing the quarter, held the lead until the eighth pole, then yielded. PIZZICATO trailed in the four path early, was coaxed along around the turn, but did not threaten. ONE SPECIAL ACT raced off the pace in the two path but never menaced. JOYS OF SUMMER stalked in the three path but yielded from the two path at the top of the stretch.

ELDEST SON stalked in the four path, bid in the three path passing the quarter, took command at the top of the lane, dug in gamely, drifted in making it tight for an inner foe passing the eighth pole, then drifted out under left urging and bumped an outer bidder around the sixteenth pole, and just held on. EDDIE THE GREAT trailed in the three path up the backstretch, was under a ride in the five path around the far turn, swung from the six path into the lane, rallied to bid in the final sixteenth, but could not get by the winner. POWER ATTACK laid up close along the inside, waited in the two path around the far turn, was roused while swinging out to the five path at the top of the lane, ran on to bid entering the final furlong, but got bumped by the drifting inner eventual winner around the sixteenth, then had to steady late for show. SPANISH NOBLE was held up along the inside, cued from the rail midway around the far turn, tipped out to the four path at the top of the stretch, and stayed on. SMART STRIKER rated in the two path, was roused in the three path midway around the far turn, got carried out to six path at the top of the lane, and improved position. MAX'S MAP set the pace in the two path up the backstretch, came under a drive along the rail while being headed early around the far turn, but weakened in the final furlong. MACKENZIE'S NOVVA prompted the pace in the three path, led between foes in the two path around the far turn, lost the lead at the top of the lane, got out in tight by the outer eventual winner passing the furlong grounds, then yielded.
