INDE ROSE laid off of the pace two wide and between horses, advanced three wide approaching the far turn, tipped four wide while sustaining progress turning for home, bid in upper stretch, forged an advantage and lugged inwardly entering the final furlong, recovered quickly and drove clear. WHISKEY WHIM laid off of the pace along the inside, progressed two wide and between horses turning for home, bid inside of the leader along with an outer INDE ROSE in upper stretch, but failed to keep pace with that one into the final sixteenth and was second best. GREAT ACTRESS tracked two to three wide, got outmoved between rivals nearing the lane, moved out to the four path into upper stretch and kept on. LA ESPERANZA tracked along the inside, chased around the far turn and stayed on mildly. CHABELITA sped clear while moving to the inside around the first turn, shifted out to the three path in upper stretch and weakened between bidders reaching the furlong grounds. HADES broke outwardly, stalked the top pair from the four path, got outmoved by an outer rival approaching teh far turn, chased in the three path around that bend, moved out to teh five path into the lane, drifted out to the eight path at the furlong grounds, yet rallied to bid at the sixteenth pole and drove past. FORGED STEEL vied for the lead with an outer rival while remaining a path off of the inside, disposed of that one as a wider SIR SAFFER challenged around the far turn, battled with that one through upper stretch, led narrowly into the final furlong, but got outkicked by a wider bidder at the sixteenth pole. SIR SAFFER came out at the start, laid off of the pace in the three path, shifted out to the five path while getting headstrong at the five furlong pole, pulled to progress outside of foes down the backstretch, bid outside of a leading FORGED STEEL around the far turn, dueled with that one into the lane and through midstretch, but got outkicked by an outer bidder at the sixteenth pole and was fended off for place. OUTOFTHEDARK leaned outwardly leaving the gate, trailed along the inside, surpassed an inner rival while taking the far turn in the three path, moved back to the inside nearing the lane and improved while hanging on his left lead. THANKFULNESS (IRE) saved ground well back, launched a rally in the three path in upper stretch, tipped out to the five path at the furlong grounds, sustained progress among foes to bid leaving the sixteenth pole and edged an advantagfe. CAFE EMBRACE got keen early on, settled before pursuing from midpack in the three path, then two wide around teh far turn, swung out to the six path into the lane, rallied to bid along with an inner rival at the sixteenth pole, sparred late but got outfinished. SNEAKY GOOD tracked from the four to three path, rallied to reel in the leader at the sixteenth pole and drew clear under little urging. BLAZING BRAT tracked three to two wide and between horses, tipped out to the four path in upper stretch and rallied to gain place in the final sixteenth. EVOLUTION vied three to two wide, remained wide and led in the four path around the turn, drew clear while tucking to the three path nearing the lane, hung on her left lead while tiring in the final furlong, got caught at the sixteenth pole, weakened then just saved show at the wire. MY MISS MO bumped an outer rival at the start, pursued along the inside, yielded into the turn, shifted out to the three path in upper stretch, ran on between horses while hanging on her left lead and missed show. FREAKS GO was bumped between horses and pinched back at the start, raced off of the pace in the three to four path into the turn, shifted to

the five path into upper stretch and moved up while hanging on her left lead. SUMMER WINNER vied for the lead with an outer pair early on, failed to sustain position and chased around the turn, then tired through the lane. GERRARDS CROSS bumped an inner foe at the start, chased two wide and between horses, got floated to the four path into the lane and tired. TRUMAN'S COMMANDER crossed over causing cramped quarters for inner rivals leaving the chute, showed the way along the inside, managed a clear margin while well in hand around the far turn, maintained that advantage while hanging on his left lead through midstretch, changed over at the sixteenth pole and held from an outer pusuer. BLACKMAIL tugged forward to press outside of the leader around the first turn, chased the clear rival around the far turn, sustained pursuit and closed in to offer a rebid in the final sixteenth but was kept at bay. A MILLION DREAMS tracked from midpack in the three path, then between horses into the lane, dueled for show with his outer counterpart while trading blows through midstretch then narrowly prevailed. GLOVES OFF pursued from midpack in the two path, then in the three to four path around the far turn, progressed nearing the lane to bid for show entering it, dueled for that position while exchanging bumps with an inner rival through the lane and narrowly missed at the wire. ALAKAN stalked near the inside, chased turning for home, lacked a bid and gave way. MY RICH UNCLE was put to tight quarters between horses by an outer rival soon after the start, settled off of the pace two wide and failed to factor. HIGH YIELD HUNK hopped slightly at the start, then got floated inwardly by the leader and was forced to steady leaving the chute, tracked along the inside then faded around the far turn. MO DODGY came in soon after the start, steadied hard when put to tight rail quarters by outer rivals leaving the chute, saved ground off of the pace and faded behind a foe rounding the far turn. W W STAR steadied when outer rivals came in soon after the start, got rank and was hard to handle leaving the chute, raced well back in the two path and got outrun. EMPIRE OF GLORY lost contact with the rest early on, pulled up and walked off. THE TRAINER OF MO DODGY CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST TRUMAN'S COMMANDER ALLEGING FOUL LEAVING THE CHUTE. THE RIDER OFGLOVES OFF CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST A MILLION DREAMS ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH RUN. FOLLOWING BOTH OBJECTIONS, AS WELL AS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY, NO CHANGES WERE MADE TO THE ORIGINAL ORDER OF FINISH.
