PERIPOLI rated nicely off of the early pace, tracked to the turn then loomed three wide into the bend, vied for the lead at the quarter marker, battled GIGGITY into the stretch then repelled that foe into the final furlong, kept to task late while on the left lead and held safely for the win. WIN WINNIE WIN broke a bit slowly and was unhurried in the early stages, saved ground to the turn and made a steady advance to upper stretch, angled out at the furlong grounds, closed willingly late and was second best. HARD TALK broke out at the start, chased the early pace from between rivals, ran in pursuit two then three wide into the turn, coaxed four wide for the stretch drive, could not impact the top pair late but was able to close for the show honors in deep stretch. GIGGITY broke alertly and vied for the early lead, ceded the front to NOAHS PRIDE and stalked that foe into the turn, bid between rivals into the bend then battled PERIPOLI into upper stretch, was repelled at the furlong pole then weakened in the final stages. NOAHS PRIDE sent for the early lead, assumed command and set a decent pace into the turn, was overtaken nearing the quarter pole, fought to upper stretch then faded in the drive. HALLOW'S ICE settled off of the early pace, coaxed two to three wide to the quarter pole, swung four wide to upper stretch and was not a threat in the lane. ALEXANDER K settled off of the early pace while never far back, advanced while saving ground into the turn, was outkicked while chasing from the two path nearing the quarter pole, could not find more into upper stretch and faltered in the drive. UNCLEBRUCERULES broke slowly and lacked early speed, trailed to the turn and did not factor in the stretch drive.

CASH THE CHECK raced close up to the early pace while three deep, shifted in into the first turn then tracked the pace while saving ground along the backstretch, chased the leading pair from the inside heading to the quarter pole, tipped to the two path to upper stretch and was set down for the drive, closed willingly to the final sixteenth, reeled in SOMERSET MIA in deep stretch and was determinedly up in time. SOMERSET MIA broke alertly, assumed early command and set the pace to the first turn, carved out prompted fractions along the backstretch run, led to the quarter pole then shook free into upper stretch, kept to task to the final sixteenth then was all out in deep stretch, was caught in the final strides for the win and was well clear of the rest for second. KNOWLEDGE IS GOOD was forwardly placed while between rivals heading to the first turn, attended to the modest pace into the backstretch run, pressed SOMERSET MIA to the far turn then was turned away into upper stretch, was outkicked in the drive but ran on late to be a clear third. D ORBIE'S GIRL settled off of the early pace while outside of rivals, tracked from the second flight into the backstretch run, lost position two wide nearing the quarter pole, could not find more into the stretch and weakened late. INSTAPURCHASE rated off of the early pace and saved ground to the first turn, was well placed into the backstretch run, lacked the needed response heading to the far turn and gave way in the stretch drive. MELODY FACTOR settled between rivals leaving the start, steadied off of heels into the first turn, recovered to the backstretch run then was outrun to the half-mile pole, trailed into the far turn, was eased through the lane and walked off.

FORTUNATE RYDER assumed early command then contested the pace with AND THATS MY STORY into the backstretch run, disputed the pace from the inside heading into the far turn, took command to upper stretch and led into the final furlong, dug in and met the bid of GRAND LIAM into the final sixteenth, held off the runner-up in deep stretch and kept to task in the final yards to prevail. GRAND LIAM settled leaving the start and trailed to the first turn, made an outside middle move into the backstretch run, tracked four to five wide approaching the far turn, rallied to upper stretch and was set down for the drive, responded well into the late stages, could not get by the determined winner in deep stretch and was a clear second. AND THATS MY STORY was forwardly placed in the early stages, went up and contested the pace outside of FORTUNATE RYDER, disputed the moderate pace with that foe into the far turn, was repelled into upper stretch, yielded to the top pair in the lane and was a clear third. XIAO LONG raced close up to the early pace while three deep, tracked

the leading pair into the backstretch run, chased three wide into the far turn, could not sustain his run into the stretch and flattened out. RED SKY MORNING settled in mid-pack, saved ground along the backstretch run, coaxed two wide and between rivals into the far turn, swung three wide to upper stretch and lacked the needed late response. KID KAOS settled to the first turn, advanced outside of rivals along the backstretch run, chased the leading pair two wide and between foes into the far turn, was outkicked to upper stretch then weakened in the final stages. EFFICACY allowed to settle early, coaxed three wide along the backstretch run, got caught in traffic between foes heading into the far turn, chased three wide to the quarter pole and did not threaten in the late stages. KENSINGTON AVENUE settled off of the early pace then was caught a bit in tight into the first turn, coaxed two wide along the backstretch, ran in pursuit into the far turn, angled out for the stretch drive and did not rally late. SHER HAN rated just off of the early pace and saved ground to the first turn, was well placed to the backstretch, saved all of the ground to the far turn, could not muster the needed response to upper stretch and gave way in the drive. MATTY B GOOD settled while saving ground to the first turn, was unhurried along the backstretch run, saved ground to the quarter marker and did not factor in the stretch drive.

ITS SATISFACTUAL unhurried in the early running, roused five wide approaching the far turn, loomed at the quarter marker then swung widest to upper stretch, made a sustained rally to the furlong pole and responded well in the drive, battled LIFE ADVICE to the final sixteenth and determinedly outfinished the runner-up to prevail. LIFE ADVICE sent to vie for the early lead, took command and showed the way into the first turn, controlled the pace into the backstretch run, led into the far turn then dug in into the stretch, met the bid of ITS SATISFACTUAL past the furlong pole, was gamely bested in the final yards and held safely for second. APPLE SHAKE SHAKE allowed to settle in the early stages, chased four wide into the far turn, bid between rivals at the quarter marker then ran in pursuit five wide into upper stretch, battled to the furlong pole, was outkicked in deep stretch but held well late for third. TEMPLE CITY TABOO broke alertly then ceded the early lead, saved ground to the backstretch run, coaxed two wide to the far turn, got caught in traffic at the quarter marker and angled out to upper stretch, closed into the final sixteenth and just missed at the wire for third. MIDWAY VOW settled outside of rivals in the early stages, coaxed three to four wide along the backstretch, roused six wide into the far turn, angled in nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit into the stretch, offered a mild late rally but could not impact the leaders late. SUNDAY TIFF rated off of the early pace and saved ground to the first turn, maintained an inside path along the backstretch run, angled three wide into the far turn and advanced nearing the quarter marker, raced within aim of the lead into upper stretch, could not sustain her run to the final sixteenth and flattened out. TERRIE T was prominent leaving the start, rated into the first turn then saved ground into the backstretch run, well placed approaching the half-mile, chased from the inside heading into the far turn, could not keep pace into upper stretch and weakened in the lane. MY GAL was forwardly placed while between rivals leaving the start, settled to the first turn then tracked from the second flight along the backstretch run, chased two then three wide and between foes into the far turn, got shuffled back nearing the quarter marker, gave way into upper stretch and could not find more late. TWO TURNTABLES raced close up to the early pace while between rivals, ceded the early lead to LIFE ADVICE and tracked that rival to the backstretch, chased two wide and between foes into the second turn, was outkicked to upper stretch then tired in the final furlong. I HEARD SOMETHINGS prominent in the early running, tracked the pace four then three wide into the first turn, settled in the second flight along the backstretch, chased three wide to the far turn, was shuffled back into that bend, trailed to the quarter marker and did not offer a late response.
