JACOBI unhurried early, responded with a burst of speed four wide to make the lead inside the sixteenth pole and won going away. SILENT DRILL well placed, rallied through the stretch along the rail and got up for second. COUPLE BEERS DEEP pressed the pace along the rail into the turn, made the lead past the three furlong marker, drew off in upper stretch, maintained the lead past the sixteenth pole then was outfinished. BLUE BLOOD COWBOY well back early, found hie best stride late inside. MISTER ZAZU stalked the pace two wide into the stretch then weakened. SADIE'S GHOST set a pressured pace two wide into the turn and weakened late. TRUTH N SOUL was no threat. SKUNK APE was no factor.
