TWILIGHT VISION broke inward bumping SHARP AZ CAN BE at the start, stalked the pace into the turn, inherited the lead nearing the quarter pole, set the balance of the pace and shook clear under mild right handed urging. LIAM'S LASS stalked the pace four wide into the stretch, had a mild rally two wide and finished second best. CEVICHE unhurried early, found her best stride late three wide. DIVINE FASHION was in tight at the start, trailed down the backstretch then closed a gap late outside rivals. STACY ATTACK never far back, moved up two wide in the turn then weakened late. SHARP AZ CAN BE was bumped by the winner at the start, set the pace along the inside into the turn then weakened. FULL TIME STRUTIN close up, checked around a rival in distress near the quarter pole and lost momentum. TIMELY SECRET unhurried, bumped into the rival in distress nearing the quarter pole, pulled up in upper stretch and was walked off. TAYYARA pressed the pace two wide down the backstretch, made the lead entering the turn, suffered a catastrophic injury past the five sixteenths pole, pulled up and was euthanized. THE STEWARD POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN BUT TOOK NO ACTION.
