EAGLE NEST made the lead soon after the start, set all the pace, shook clear in upper stretch under right handed urging and prevailed under brisk handling. MUTINY stalked the pace three wide, dug in late and for up for second. HEY EUGENE chased the winner two wide and was outfinished for second. VENTURE ON saved ground and had a mild late gain. THAT'S THE WAY slow early, found his best stride late two wide. CORNER OFFICE raced four wide and went evenly.
