COWBOY JUSTICE unhurried while near the inside, shifted three wide entering the stretch, swerved under left handed urging late and got up in the final strides. FINISTERE allowed to settle, rallied five wide through the far turn, made the lead two wide inside the furlong marker and just missed hanging on. HEART OF AN ANGEL bore out badly bumping hard with ROYAL DECADENCE, pressed the pace three then two wide, made the lead nearing the far turn, shook clear, dropped inside, set the pace until deep stretch then was outfinished. REASON TO BELIEVE never far back, finished with good courage five wide. ACTION MAN offered a mild bid on the far turn then leveled off. BOOYAH was no factor. A BIT OF CAPTAIN was in tight along the rail entering the clubhouse turn then had no impact. NET WORTH was no threat. ASK ISAAC close up four wide, was righted sharply leaving the firsut turn, remained a sharp threat for six furlongs then gave way. ROYAL DECADENCE was bumped hard from his inside and forced outward into rivals at the start then was never involved. LT'S JACKNTHEBOX was bumped at the start then offered little. C C'S CLEAR CREEK broke alertly to set the pace into the first turn, gave

up the lead before a quarter mile, remained a sharp threat for a half mile then stopped. BREEZE THE BAYOU also bumped at the start, made the lead four wide before a quarter mile, set the pace down the backstretch, had speed into the stretch then stopped.
