ILIKETHAT chased the leader four then two wide through the turn, rallied under left handed urging to make the lead near the three sixteenths pole and prevailed under strong handling. SOCIAL HISTORY was restless in the gate, trailed early, rallied through the stretch three wide and finished second best. NAMBITI allowed to settle, found his best stride late outside. HARTSTEIN set the pace to the top of the stretch then weakened. WEEKEND BUZZ moved up three wide entering the turn then came up empty. PECKS NOT BAD was fractious in the gate and had brief speed two wide. GOTTOMAKEITHAPPEN chased the pace three wide and was through after a half.
