MERGER stalked the pace into the stretch, responded with a burst of speed under left handed urging through the final stages and was along in time. GHOST OF LONDYN was fractious in the gate, bumped at the start, settled close up, rallied three wide through the turn to make the lead at the top of the stretch, shook clear before the furlong marker then couldn't handle the late charge of the winner. MISTER ZAZU set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch then was outfinished. SEEKING FREEDOM pressed the early pace along the inside and weakened on the turn. AKIMBO stumbled at the start, was allowed to settle, swung wide and passed tiring rivals six wide. VERNON'S BEST had brief speed. SO CO MANHATTAN bumped at the start, was always outrun and returned bleeding from the nostrils. SILENT DRILL bumped at the start, checked behind horses leaving the chute then was never involved. AQUAVIT bumped at the start and was no threat. HIDDEN HEART was through early.

P H FACTOR pressed the pace two wide past the quarter pole, made the lead at the top of the stretch then was outfinished. ICE BLAST trailed into the far turn swung wide and found his best stride late in the six path. AUGER moved up three wide nearing the top of the stretch then leveled off. ROYALLY FLUSHED away alertly, set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch then weakened. MR. THUNDERSTRUCK settled mid pack two wide and failed to respond. VERBIER stalked the early pace along the inside and was through after a half. AULD LANGE SYNE had no impact.

AFFAIR TO REMEMBER stalked the pace into the stretch, dug in late in the five path and just missed getting up for second. FINALLY FRIDAY offered a mild bid along the inside in upper stretch then failed to sustain that bid. BALKI BARTOKOMOUS pressed the pace two wide into the stretch then weakened. VANADIUM had speed into the turn then gave way. GRITS N GRAVY broke slowly, was never close, lost contact with his field in upper stretch and was eased to the wire.

RAMSEY stalked the early pace, rallied three wide on the far bend to make the lead at the quarter pole, dueled the balance of the trip with the winner and just missed in a game effort. MASTER OF THE NITE unhurried early, rallied four wide through the far turn and into the stretch finishing best of the rest. LEAVENWORTH failed to menace. BIG POPPER slow early, found his best stride late two wide. SMASH dueled for the lead two wide for six furlongs then weakened. SAILOR'S CHANCE was no factor. BOURBON WISDOM was no threat. OILER contested the lead along the inside for six furlongs then was used up.
