PANAMANIAC chased the pace from the inside, bid along the rail past the quarter pole then couldn't handle the winner. DANZA MAGIC trailed into the stretch and passed the tiring pacesetter while four wide. RAINBOW SHIP sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, set the pace in the six path down the backstretch, angled inward on the turn, maintained the advantage to the top of the stretch, drifted out before the furlong marker and was used up.
