PENNY LOAFER , angled in soon after the start, hugged the inner rail, stalked the pace, eased out to the two path mid way on the final turn, took the lead in upper stretch and drove clear. VANCE SCHOLARS set the pace along the inner rail, was challenged in upper stretch and weakened. SIN PERMISO , four wide the first turn, moved up four deep leaving the final turn and flattened out. RAPIDITY , five wide entering the first turn, swung four wide entering the backstretch, remained wide the final turn and was no factor. BONDED , outside VANCE SCHOLARS, chased that one for six furlongs and weakened. LIKEBELIVINGNMAGIC raced forwardly in the three path around the first turn and gave way leaving the backstretch.

LADSFIRSTLOVE , three wide to clear, dropped in and set a rated pace, took to rousing into the far turn, remained on the left lead through the lane and held sway under a drive. KINDA KRAZY , forwardly placed between runners early, gave hard chase saving ground past the three eighths, eased out and had aim past the three sixteenths, flattened out but remained well clear of the rest. ASHWEEE broke slowly then bumped with TAI TAI RUSH, regrouped and was used wide around the first turn to reach contention, pursued three then two wide, failed to kick on leaving the quarter pole and faded. TAI TAI RUSH hopped at the break then moved outward and bumped with a rival, angled out near the five eighths and edged up three wide, chased past the three eighths, lacked a response around the final turn and tired. SECRET FLAME gave early chase while saving ground and faltered.

GOOD MAN DAN , tucked up inside while stalking the pace, remained close under a hustling wide and off a duel into the far turn, shifted out soon after, circled four wide with progress into the lane, sustained under strong handling, wrested command in deep stretch then edged clear at the wire. NIGHT OF MAGIC broke on top and cleared early, set the pace toward the inner rail, handled outer pressure leaving the half, dueled with ZIO LINO from the quarter pole to deep stretch, clung to a slim lead past the sixteenth pole then gave way stubbornly. ZIO LINO prompted the pace outside NIGHT OF MAGIC, moved alongside under asking into the far turn, sparred into the lane, drifted out a bit near the sixteenth pole and faded very late. JOEL'S BOY , urged in the clear and towards the inside, failed to muster up a rally. MAGNIFICENT RAGS broke a step slow and was outrun.
