DAME'S ROCKET broke sharply but was beaten to the lead, settled four-wide in the tracking group, gradually advanced towards the front through the turn, set down at the top of the stretch with DODECAHEDRON engaged in a spirited stretch duel with a very game rival, and got a favorable bob at the line. DODECAHEDRON hustled away to clear the field, got to the inside, with only one rival in close pursuit early, opened up a bit on the turn, then was confronted by DAME'S ROCKET approaching the quarter pole, battled gamely along the rail but got tagged in the last jump. GLADLY raced two-deep in mid-pack, then chased the top pair to the wire. CATNIP HILL was outpaced from the start despite some early coaxing from the rider, was last by a large margin going into the turn, then started to run on with three furlongs to go, swung seven-wide into the lane, continued the rally through the stretch, and improved to fourth. BLAZEN EYES got away well, tracked close initially, then dropped back to mid-pack and finished evenly. HOPE SHE FIRES steadily dropped back to the back after a level start, went four-wide through the turn and ran on some to improve while never a serious threat. BARBIE B dropped back after the start, raced well back, then went one-paced through the stretch. MOTHER VOLGA traveled in mid-pack to the stretch but came up empty.

OONDIRI away well, raced up close along the rail, came under a ride leaving the three-furlong pole and tired in upper stretch. NOT TODAY BOSS ducked in at the start, was slow to get going, raced near the back, kept to the inside through the turn, but did not rally. PAT'S BUTTON broke well, and got into a good stalking position behind DODECAHEDRON early, switched out to the three-path midway on the backstretch, continued to chase that one through the turn, then weakened before the quarter pole and came up empty in the stretch.

VIBORA showed speed and contested the early pace from inside, set a contested pace while a bit off of the rail nearing the quarter marker, shook free to upper stretch, drew off through the lane and won in hand as much the best. CHIQUITA'S WAY settled along the inside, tipped to the two path then was caught in traffic nearing the top of the lane, split rivals three wide into the final sixteenth, was no match late for the winner but bested the rest. ALWAYS IN VOGUE tracked the early pace from the second flight, coaxed three to four wide to upper stretch, was no match late for the winner and was outkicked for the place, while holding safely for the show. PINIT ANNIE chased from the inside early on, saved ground to upper stretch, lacked the needed response in the drive and flattened out. OJOS LOCOS was crowded then bumped with outer rival at the start, trailed to the turn, weaved through rivals in the lane and passed tiring foes late. MS JINXY hustled away from the gate, went up and pressed outside of VIBORA into the turn, attended to the pace through the bend then was repelled into upper stretch and gave way in the lane. LATE SPRING NIGHT broke in and bumped with inner rival at the start, settled to the turn, asked four then five wide for the drive and did not factor late. ELITE MISS off a step slowly, settled outside of rivals heading to the turn, was coaxed along while widest to upper stretch and failed to threaten in the drive. MESCOOL rated just off of the early pace, was well placed heading into the turn, chased the leaders two to three wide to upper stretch, could not find the needed response in the drive then came up empty late.

OUR SHENANIGAN broke well but ceded the lead early, stalked close up to the turn, then responded when asked to go after the leader, leaving the five-sixteenths marker, took command in upper stretch, and drew off in the late stages. MOON LAW broke a step slow then settled off the pace not far from the front, navigated through rivals on the turn, and finished up well to gain the place. HIDDEN QUARRY assumed command mid-way down the backstretch, led the field into the stretch, then was overtaken, but managed to hold third. KITTENS STORMY GAL was a little slow into stride and chased from last early, hugged the rail into the stretch and made mild improvement late. BINDI broke on top but yielded the front to HIDDEN QUARRY early on, tracked close up along the rail through the turn, came under a ride before the quarter-pole, and was outfinished. MIKELLE broke outward at the start, chased three-wide off the pace, then lacked any response in the stretch.

SOCIAL BELLE settled in mid-pack off the pace, made a forward move four-wide through the turn, took command at the furlong marker, and drew clear late under steady handling. GLADRIEL sprinted clear of the field early, surrendered the lead in upper stretch but kept on gamely to save the place. HIDEKI chased four-wide at the rear of the main pack through the early stages, continued four-wide through the turn to gain contention approaching the stretch, had a little trouble with the lead change in the stretch but finished well despite it, and was able to grab the minor award. PROTOMAGIC tracked the early pace in second position into the turn, bid three-wide under a drive past the quarter pole, kept on well to be third. MISSY BEE got caught four-wide on the first turn, settled in mid-pack up the backstretch three-wide, started a forward move from the three-furlong pole, gradually closed the gap on the tiring leader and was up in the final yards. RAPIDO ROSA made the early lead without much effort going into the first turn, maintained a clear lead to the far turn, opened up leaving the quarter pole, got a little short in the final furlong, and yielded in the final yards. VINOS ANGEL got caught five-wide on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, then started to move forward on the far turn, continued wide into the stretch, and

finished well to move up into third while no threat to the top pair. GIGI'S WORLD raced three-wide off the pace up the backstretch, continued around the turn, but lacked a late kick. CORA'S LEGACY secured a rail position under a tight hold on the first turn, raced close up to the far turn, was under a drive midway through the far turn, and went evenly through the stretch. ZIGGZAPPA unhurried from the break was the trailer turning up the backstretch, launched a mild rally midway through the second turn, flattened out in upper stretch, but still managed to improve. HIDDEN RECIPE was roused from the break but was not quick enough to contest the early pace, settled in along the rail in the back half of the field for the first half-mile, dropped to last before the far turn, then kept on to pass tired foes in the stretch. STEAMPUNK was pushed from the gate for early speed but did not respond, settled in mid-pack, then offered nothing in the late stages. SPOILS OF WAR got forward position two-wide on the first turn, tracked RAPIDO ROSA up the backstretch, was close up until the quarter pole, then weakened through the stretch.

LOST AND FOUND was crowded a bit at the start and off a step slowly, sent to vie for the early lead, took command along the backstretch then dictated terms into the turn, kicked clear at the quarter pole, kept to task while clear through the lane and held sway to the wire. STRONG LIKE SARA close up to the early pace, took back and tracked two wide to the turn, shifted to the rail along the bend and chased to the quarter marker, moved back to the two path while in pursuit into upper stretch, could not impact the winner into the final sixteenth and bested the rest. BUNDCHEN threw her head at the start and broke a step slowly, tracked the early pace from the second flight, coaxed three wide along the turn, chased four wide into the lane, was outkicked into the final sixteenth but held at the wire for third. TAKEMETOTHEBEACH crowded at the start and trailed early on, settled to the turn, moved to the outside of rivals

along the bend, angled widest into upper stretch, found her best stride late and just missed for third at the wire. BILYANA shuffled back at the start, moved up between rivals and three wide into the turn, set down four then five wide into the lane, chased while on the left lead into the final sixteenth and finished evenly. ZO LEE prominent away from the start, stalked the early pace from outside of LOST AND FOUND, chased the pacesetter into the turn then was repelled nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit to mid-stretch then weakened. FRANGO ELECTRICO bobbled then broke out at the start then was squeezed back in the opening yards, settled to the turn then trailed nearing the quarter pole, coaxed two wide for the stretch drive and did not factor late. ALWAYS WANTING was forwardly placed away from the start, tracked the early pace while saving ground then was shuffled back into the turn, saved ground to the stretch, could not find more at the furlong marker and gave way. THE AMAZING MIZZEN settled in the second flight to begin, coaxed four to five wide into the turn, was outrun at the three-sixteenths and came up empty in the lane.

PROPHETIC DEBBY (IRE) veered outward but otherwise came away running, got caught six-wide into the first turn, raced three-wide well off the early pace for the first half-mile, launched a four-wide bid through the far turn, gradually closed the gap on LADY FAYE on the lead despite being carried out to the center of the track by that rival, and won a tight photo in a solid debut. LADY FAYE got forward position on the first turn, settled in along the rail, started a bid for the lead leaving the five-sixteenths marker, took the lead in upper stretch, drifted out through the final furlong, and came out on the short end of the photo. STARLIT SKY got put in tight after the start, was the only entrant to put any pressure on the pacesetter, did not respond when asked to kick on from the three-furlong pole, but kept on well enough to win a tight battle for the minor award. COCOA NIMBUS made the lead on the first turn, led the way early with STARLIT SKY keeping close, came under threat at the quarter-pole, tried to fight back but could not kick on in the last furlong. GOLEXGO raced in the middle of the field early, moved a little closer heading into the far turn, was kept to task and stayed on mildly through the stretch. MODERN ESCAPE settled three-wide in the back half of the field through the early stages, continued through the far turn, then was mildly gaining in the final furlong. RATHER LATE

tracked close up three-wide, was set down with three furlongs to run, loomed near the top of the stretch but flattened out and was unable to menace. DAPHNE BREWNETTE steadied in traffic in the scramble to the first turn, settled near the back, and never threatened. BUGS MALONE lost the path shortly after the start, dropped far back, and was never a factor. UR HEART got squeezed at the start, but forged ahead and got a good position into the first turn, raced in mid-pack along the rail, weakened on the far turn, then had little to offer in the stretch. BEFORE THE PHOTO FINISH WAS REVEALED, THE JOCKEY ON #11 PROPHETIC DEBBY (IRE) LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST #1 LADY FAYE ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH. AS THE PHOTO SHOWED #11 THE WINNER, NO ACTION WAS NECESSARY.
