SWISS DANCER coaxed along chasing the top trio up the backstretch, went four to five wide around the bend, drifted out in upper stretch and gained the show honors. TOP REVIEW bumped with inner rival in the beginning, vied three deep up the backstretch, fought outside CLUBHOUSE DRAMA past the five-sixteenths pole, could not keep up with the leader late on the bend and weakened in the drive. COASTAL WATERS tracked from inside out of range, chased two wide into the lane, moved out in the drive, put a head in front in deep stretch but got outkicked by the winner. ITS A BOY settled in the early stages on the inside, moved off the rail on the backstretch, traveled three deep on the far turn, moved out further in the lane, rallied from outside but got outclosed by the top pair. FLINT STROLL was closest in pursuit of the lone speed from the two path to the top of the lane, chased within striking distance down the stretch but could not summon the needed late kick. ORTH sped clear and steered across to the inside, controlled the pace up the backstretch, remained clear to the eighth pole, lost command with a sixteenth remaining and weakened late. FLY NIGHTLY unhurried from outside, angled down to the two path, spun three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. LESLIE CHOW was off slow from inside, traveled outside a rival at the back and was never a factor. PEPPER JACK tracked two wide out of range early, remained two wide to the stretch and failed to rally. MONTANA tucked inside at the back, saved ground to the stretch and failed to make an impact. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

BERT'S PROSPECT got bumped early, tracked out of range a bit off the rail, chased within striking distance two wide into the lane, swept by MAXIMUM CAPACITY in upper stretch and held safely over the late run from the runner-up. ECHO CANYON settled along the rail, gained two then three wide on the far turn, put in late run but ran out of ground. MAXIMUM CAPACITY grabbed the early lead from outside and crossed over once in the clear, set all the pace to the stretch, yielded to the winner in upper stretch and stayed on to secure third. LET ME LOVE YOU was forced to check early, traveled near the back in the two path early on, went three then four wide around

RUN BABA RUN got forced in and lost a clear path early, chased three then two wide well off the pace around the clubhouse turn, rounded the far turn two wide then along the rail and was never a factor. LASMUIGH (GB) tracked from inside out of range, dropped back further on the far turn and tired. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

RAIDER NATION dueled from inside, cleared STREET GUN approaching the five-sixteenths pole, then drew off in the furlong grounds. TOMORROWNEVERCOMES bumped leaving the gate, chased three deep into the turn, went four to five wide into the lane, showed late run to gain second but could not threaten the winner. STREET GUN broke inward, went up to fight for the lead from outside, could not keep up with RAIDER NATION nearing the five-sixteenths pole, chased two wide into the lane, could not re-rally down the lane and lost second late. CRAZY STORM tracked from inside, ran into traffic and put the breaks on at the five-sixteenths pole, stayed on the inside to the stretch and produced a mild rally to earn a minor award. IMA RASCAL hustled from the gate, chased three then four wide around the turn and weakened. SON O' SANPETE bumped leaving the gate, altered out into the turn, chased three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. AUTISM MIND raced up close early, chased along the rail on the turn, tipped out in to the lane and

weakened. DON'T HAVE ANOTHER followed four deep into the turn, moved into the three path around the bend and failed to menace. CHICKEN NUGGET reluctant loading into the gate, broke slow and shifted in at the start, trailed five wide into the lane and was never a factor. MR. THIRSTY showed brief speed, dropped back two wide on the turn and tired.
