RHODESIA , with the pace five wide deep and under early rating, dropped in a path and moved to apply more pressure mid turn, responded when set down soon into the lane then emerged in a duel outside TRIPLE PASS past mid stretch, briefly shook clear under a drive in deep stretch then had just enough left to last over an outer WINNING BIG. WINNING BIG flashed speed then rated back of the embattled fivesome leaving the five eighths, was hustled along pursuing past the three eighths, worked outward and came six wide into the lane, straightened away, leveled off to his best stride after switching leads near the sixteenth pole, finished fast outside the winner and simply ran out of ground. TRIPLE PASS , brushed at the break, disputed the early pace four wide between runners, dropped in a path while still between foes and sparred from the five sixteenths to upper stretch, stayed on to contest the issue inside the winner to deep stretch then gave way grudgingly. FORTY NINER GOLD , with the leaders three wide between runners through the backstretch, could not quite go on with the leading trio nearing the quarter pole, shifted out a bit in the drive and found more to make some inroads through the final seventy yards. LIGHT THE BEAM broke slowly then settled off of a contested pace, saved ground into the lane, worked outward past mid stretch and finished well between horses. THE SCENT had speed and disputed the pace two wide between rivals, dropped back some mid turn, eased out a bit and made a bit of a run leaving mid stretch, chased and flattened out. NOW AND ZEN , brushed at the break, raced off the pace while three wide, angled seven wide into the stretch but lacked a bid. IN VRONSKY STYLE advanced inside a quartet of runners and took a short lead nearing the five eighths, was hounded into and around the turn, failed to kick on nearing mid stretch and faltered.

KAWAZAKI (IRE) hopped slightly at the break but quickly recovered, rated in the clear while not far back, crept closer leaving the far turn then went on the attack three wide approaching the stretch, forged to command soon after, kicked away readily under pressure in mid stretch, was kept alert with left handed encouragement nearing the sixteenth pole then held firm. SUPERSONIC ME , unhurried early while saving ground, gained in hand heading to the far turn, worked outward to be about four wide into the lane, made a grinding run through the final furlong and just earned the place. BOB'S KID , four wide with pursuit outside foes heading to the turn, dropped in a path and moved to engage the leader soon after, dueled, took over under a drive in mid stretch, kicked clear a sixteenth out, drifted and held sway. LAST VINTAGE steadied soon after the break, recovered then chased under a ride and towards the inside mid turn, saved ground into the lane, angled out near mid stretch and rallied between foes. EMPIRE WARRIOR , three wide between rivals with early pursuit, steadied when in tight into the turn, recovered and angled out, wandered out to about the six path before correcting into the lane

and came back on through the final furlong. KARAOKE HERO , pinched back at the break, raced well back to the quarter pole, came three wide for the drive, was guided outward in the final furlong and finished with good energy. WAR ECHO , reluctant to load, was nudged clear after an alert break, set the pace two wide, was joined by the winner near the three eighths, sparred into the lane, fought on past mid stretch then faded late. AMERICAN TANGO , off the pace, saved ground nearing mid stretch, angled out and kept on with effort. TRYDENT edged up soon after the break and took up a stalking spot towards the inner rail, had aim on the dueling leaders into the lane, failed to kick on under a ride in mid stretch and faded. PETRIFIED gave early pursuit two wide between runners, checked when shuffled back into the turn and failed to recover. JUST KEN lagged back off the pace, angled out for the drive and failed to menace. GLORIOUS OSCAR gave early chase inside and weakened. START THE MUSIC , off slowly, made a mild run three to four wide mid turn, failed to sustain past the three sixteenths then was eased through the final furlong.
