J C'S A LEGEND settled behind the main pack down the backstretch, then took an inside path through the the turn, put SHANKADOPOLUS in tight at the quarter pole then bid two wide into the stretch, produced a strong rally under steady handling and intermittent urging, opened up, then just outlasted the late charge of an outside rival. OBSIDIAN GOLD got pinched back at the start and was far back early, regained contact with the field on the turn, the swung six wide into the stretch and produced a strong rally to just miss. RACER REX was between horses with the tracking group near the back of the pack, launched a three wide bid from the seven-sixteenths and finished up well but was not quite good enough. TENFORTHEBIGGUY was away well and contested the early pace from between horses, took short lead in the stretch, was on the wrong lead and flattened out. FARENHEIT O C broke well and vied inside for the early lead, came under pressure in upper stretch and tired. BIG SWAG chased well off the pace three wide, launched a bid with three furlongs to run, turned into the stretch on the left lead then finished evenly. LOBDELL LAKE hustled to the front and was three wide disputing the early lead, dropped back to a stalking position after passing the half-mile marker then started to face at the five-sixteenths pole and had little to offer in the stretch. SHANKADOPOLOUS lacked any early speed and stalled the group tracking near the back, kept to the inside through the turn then took up sharply at the quarter pole when JC'S A LEGEND took the path then was unable to regain momentum. THE JOCKEY ON #2 SHANKADOPOLOUS LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST #2 JC'S A LEGEND, ALLEGING INTERFERENCE ON THE TURN. TED stalked the leading pair to the far turn then launched a bid from the three furlong pole, swung three wide into the stretch and loomed a big threat, ran on well under a stiff drive but was outfinished. WELLSWORT (IRE) lagged a the rear of the field, saved ground then angled six wide for the stretch run and finished with good energy but too late. FLEETRIDGE showed good speed from the break and was sent to the front, raced between horses into the first turn then dueled with BIRTH OF COOL down the backstretch, continued to battle on when beset by challengers in the stretch then weakened late. HOUSE OF LORDS settled inside with the third flight, saved all the ground to no avail and lacked a rally. I'M NOBLE was coaxed a bit from the break and vied three wide through the first turn for the lead, backed off the pace battle and stalked three wide down the backstretch, re-bid for the lead late on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, but could not find the needed late kick. BIRTH OF COOL broke well and secured the inside position while contesting the early lead, battled to mid-stretch and tired.

and rallied well under strong handling to prevail. DUPLICATION broke well but opted to sit behind the pace through the early stages, raced three wide then launched a bid with three furlongs to run, turned into the stretch with the lead but could not hold off the winner but did well to hold the place. SUNNY SPOT was off a step slow then went immediately to the rail when clear, made a middle move three wide through the far turn and continued a sustained advance down the stretch to gain third while no threat to the top pair. MOVE OVER (GB) deftly angled to the rail before the first turn, advanced into contention late on the second bend but became boxed in late on the turn, did not get clear until deep stretch then was outkicked to the finish. SWAMPDRAINER raced evenly three wide throughout. THIRTY SECONDS OUT bobbled slightly at the start, but showed good speed and vied inside through the first turn, raced close up down the backstretch while behind held up to keep a stalking position, was stuck behind horses on the turn while full of run, could not get clear until the furlong marker, swung out out to the four path, was gaining late but ran out of time. ROBO tracked mid-pack through the early stages then was starting to make a move on the turn, had to check and alter course to avoid OSTINI who was backing up, was still with run and swung seven our eight wide into the stretch but flattened out. HAPI HAPI was pushed early but unable to contest the pace, settled three wide with the second group, steadied two or three times into the far turn to avoid running up heels, came about nine wide into the stretch to find clear run then finished evenly in the stretch. PACO'S PICO broke well and vied for the early lead without really being asked, dueled inside through moderate fractions to the far turn, remained a factor to upper stretch then tired. AQUACAT tracked at the head of the second group down the backstretch, took up at the three furlong marker then steadied again to avoid OSTINI who was backing up rapidly, lost momentum and was not pushed hard through the late stages. SHUT UP MICHAEL (IRE) was hustled to get forward position then went three wide through the first turn, pressed the pace down the backstretch, was making a bid for the lead at the quarter pole then got overtaken in upper stretch and faded in the late stages. OSTINI vied between horses on the lead, dropped off the pace and faded quickly through the field at the three furlong marker and was not persevered with in the stretch.

SAPADILLA broke well and took the early lead with VHAGAR and PRINCESS K pressing the pace on both sides, cut the corner a little early entering the turn putting both PRINCESS K and BANGO'S HEAT in tight quarters, then opened a length on the rest through the turn, was challenged by VHAGAR to the outside leaving the quarter pole, quickly disposed of that rival then was taken on by PRINCESS K to the inside, staged a spirited duel to the wire with that one and got a nose in front at the wire. PRINCESS K pressed the pace from the inside, then was put in tight entering the turn also causing a rival to the inside to take up, got a clean run inside through the turn then cut the corner into the stretch, engaged SAPADILLA in a battle to the finish and just missed in a game effort. BANGO'S HEAT was not far back early then was making a forward move to the inside when PRINCESS K took the path, checked hard, came back on and finished well to get third. TIA SUZI raced close up four wide through the early stages then bid six wide into the stretch, finished with good energy to get fourth but was never a serious threat. BET THE CHALK raced well off the pace to the inside, held position through the turn and could not improve in the stretch. WHIMSICAL HEIR was never far back and started to move in on the leaders at the head of the turn but flattened out and went evenly

through the stretch. DADDY'S GIRL chased the main pack down the backstretch then went three wide through the turn and lacked a rally in the stretch. ASPIRATIONAL four to five wide down the backstretch, went eight wide into the stretch and was unable to threaten. VHAGAR pressed three wide to the turn, made a strong move for the lead leaving the quarter pole but could not go on in the stretch and weakened. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT AT THE SEVEN-SIXTEENTHS POLE AND ALSO THE JOCKEY ON #2 BANGO'S HEAT LOGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST #4 PRINCESS K ALLGING INTERFERENCE IN THAT SAME INCIDENT. AFTER A REVIEW IT WAS DETERMINED THAT #7 SAPADILLA HAD CAUSED THE INTERFERENCE. #7 SAPADILLA WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM THE WIN AND PLACED THIRD. THE JOCKEYS OBJECTION WAS DISMISSED.
