FOREST ACCLAMATION took over early and set a rated pace towards the inner rail, ceded to a keyed up rival near the five eighths, rated inside foes while close then steadied along from the three eighths to the five sixteenths, picked things back up working outward into the lane, moved to attack soon after, spurted clear under a right handed drive a sixteenth out then held sway while kept to task. FALL MOON settled in the clear and off the inside, angled further out leaving the far turn and ramped up a run, circled five wide into the stretch, advanced outside rivals leaving mid stretch and finished gamely to gain. ORANGE THEORY rated off the pace and just off the inside, raced between runners near the half, idled briefly behind rivals before angling in, snuck through to the inside of runner past mid stretch and kept on willingly. DEFICIT MAJA, firmly rated prompting outside the winner into and around the first turn, pulled her way to command near the five eighths, cleared with a half to go, was re engaged in upper stretch, battled past mid stretch then faded late. JOY IN GRACE, a long way between runners while chasing the pace, came up empty in deep stretch. DELIA, forwardly placed while saving ground, drafted back several lengths off the leaders while under some rating past the three eighths, came out under a ride leaving the three sixteenths and finished with interest. GYPSY WIFE, five then four wide early on, quickly gained outside runners near the half, took dead aim outside the leader near the five sixteenths, chased between near mid stretch and faded. SIZE LORD broke sharply then was sent clear in the opening yards, set the pace under some coaxing, responded to stout encouragement two to three wide nearing the furlong grounds and held firm. CRUEL ENDEAVOR edged up early and stalked the winner, eased out mid turn, gave hard chase from the head of the lead, continued gamely to the inside of THIRSTY FRIEND through the final sixteenth and held down the place. THIRSTY FRIEND rated five wide outside rivals heading to the turn, came under pressure mid turn, advanced into the stretch, pursued outside CRUEL ENDEAVOR inside the sixteenth marker and hung a bit late. EXTREMELY WICKED dropped back early and angled in some, raced three wide leaving the far turn, worked his way four wide

between foes in upper stretch and churned on. GALLOPING MAJOR, off the pace and under a ride while saving ground mid turn, eased out in mid stretch but failed to drum up the needed finish. STREETLIGHT PEOPLE, four wide between runners chasing the pace, shifted out near the quarter pole and came up empty. CHIRAG, hustled along while saving ground, made a mild run into the stretch but failed to sustain. PAKAS SECRET, six wide early, lacked a bid. ARTETA was shuffled back soon after the break, edged up some then steadied off foes into the turn, angled out and failed to menace. BENNIGAN, three wide between runners with early chase, faltered approaching the stretch. BIG BAD BERT, off the pace and between runners leaving the three eighths, shifted in and faded.
