WHATS THE BUZZ accelerated to the front and led early in the two path, dueled outside a rival up the backstretch, led between runners early on the far turn, put KLINKERBRICK away past the five-sixteenths pole but still had to contend with FACTORY DRIVE to the outside, battled with that rival down the lane holding a slim advantage, took a bump late and got nailed in the closing moments. FACTORY DRIVE stalked the top pair from outside, bid three deep on the far turn, dueled outside WHATS THE BUZZ past the five-sixteenths pole, fought head to head down the lane, drifted in and bumped late and came up short in the end. KLINKERBRICK raced up close along the rail then dueled from inside, fought inside a pair of rivals early on the far turn, failed to keep up around that bend, chased a bit off the rail into the lane and kept on through the final furlong for a minor award. CHASIN A DOLLAR traveled along the inside off the pace, angled off the fence on the far turn, raced outside a pair of rivals in the four path exiting that bend and failed to menace. CAUSE FOR DIVORCE tracked four then three wide early, coaxed along up the backstretch, raced two wide around the far turn while losing ground and faded down the lane. BROWNSTONE stalked in the two path into the first turn, moved to the rail then angled out to the three path around the bend, bid four deep leaving the backstretch, lost touch with the leader around the turn, then challenged again from outside approaching the stretch, drifted out in upper stretch, dueling with FOR A LAUGH (IRE), bumped with that rival at the sixteenth and dug in gamely for the victory. FOR A LAUGH (IRE) raced up close three then two wide between rivals on the first turn, stalked the new leader early on the backstretch, challenged between rivals at the seven-sixteenths pole, quickly took over, cleared for a bit past the three-eighths marker, challenged again by BROWNSTONE nearing the stretch, dueled into the final furlong, drifted out and made contact at the sixteenth pole and was outgamed in the end. ACCIDENTAL GENIUS trailed from inside through both turns, steered out into the lane and gained the show honors. DE LA LUNA stalked briefly in the two path then tipped out and took over three deep late on the first turn, cleared early on the backstretch, took pressure at the halfway point, held a short lead over a pair of rivals leaving the backstretch, lost command early on the far turn, started to weaken around the bend and tired down the lane. WHO IS PAVEL sent between rivals to take control, cleared early on the turn and inched away two wide then near the inside into the lane and held safely under urging to the wire. SHUDDER chased under coaxing along the rail then got put in a bit tight by outer rival, crept closer from the fence then was closest in pursuit two wide turning into the lane, finished well down the stretch but had to settle for second best. THE SCENT stumbled leaving the gate, trailed early then went four deep into the turn, remained wide to the stretch and outfinished OBSIDIAN GOLD for the show honors. OBSIDIAN GOLD tracked between foes into the turn, rounded the bend three then two wide and got outkicked for third. F B I BOB fought for the lead to the turn from outside, chased two to three wide around the bend and weakened in the drive. RAIDER NATION broke alertly and contested the pace for a bit but could not match strides and chased in the two path leaving the backstretch, found the rail around the bend and also weakened down the lane.

CORN POP dueled from outside up the backstretch and around the turn, vied between rivals in upper stretch, was no match for the winner in the furlong grounds and stayed on to secure second. YOU ENJOY MYSELF chased from inside, angled out leaving the bend and top of the stretch, kept trying down the lane and gained third. PEDRO PEREZ dueled from inside, fought inside a pair of rivals around the bend and into the lane, then weakened in the late stages. FED GRANT trailed up the backstretch and moved inside, tipped three wide still at the back on the turn and improved down the lane. HAPPY HOUR BOBBY chased two wide into the turn, three wide exiting the bend and weakened. ROBO WARRIOR unhurried in the opening stages staying well off the inside, chased four to five wide into the lane lane and failed to menace. HERMISTON raced in range three deep into the turn, entered the lane in the four path and weakened in the drive. FIGHT ME dropped back off the pace when having the saddle slip early, went two wide then along the rail on the turn and was not a factor.
