SWAMPDRAINER allowed to settle from the break and raced near the back of the second flight, launched a three wide bid with three furlongs to run, then swung five wide into the stretch, duelled briefly with WAR CHEST in upper stretch but could not match strides, kept on to save the place. COCKTAIL PRINCESS was hustled away but unable to go with BABE'S GOT APPEAL early, steadied when put in tight going into the turn, raced inside to the stretch then responded to late urging to cut the margin in the late stages but could not get up. NOEL'S ANGEL squeezed at the start, circled the field then finished with good energy to gain the third spot. ADIOS MUCHACHAS outrun early, stayed in an all-out drive, bid five wide into the stretch and picked off some rivals in the stretch to improve. DISTINCTIVE DEB raced two wide in the middle of the pack and finished evenly while never a threat. GAME TO PLAY broke well but got knocked off stride early by RIVER OF AMBITION and was unable to contest the pace, dropped back to mid-pack, stayed to the inside and ran on some up the rail to improve in the late stages. RIVER OF AMBITION rushed up to join the early pace fray then got put in tight by ADIOS MUCHACHAS and steadied near the seven-sixteenths pole, dropped back but raced close up never made the front then faltered in the stretch. KO OLINA lunged at the start then took a sideswipe from NOEL'S ANGEL, gave the field a head start and chased throughtout. IMA TROUBLE MAKER broke a step slow then was sent hard from the start, raced three wide off the pace and came up empty in the stretch. WELLSWORT (IRE) was hustled to get forward position but unable to vie for the early lead, settled mid-pack then steadily advanced down the backstretch, had to wait for racing room on the far turn then split the leaders at the eighth pole and went clear to prevail. THIRTY FOUR COUPE made the early lead and attempted to temper the pace, kicked on when challenged on the far turn, lost second position in deep stretch but came back on near the wire in a super game effort. TED stalked inside, started to run on through the far turn then responded well when asked to run on up the rail in the stretch, was battling for the lead in mid-stretch kept on well under steady handling to the wire but was outfinished in the final yards. ATHENS MOON was last to cross the main course, chased the main pack down the backstretch, swung seven or eight wide at the top of the stretch and produced a bold rally under steady handing but

was much too late. I'M NOBLE stalked the pace two wide, loomed at the quarter pole but was outkicked in the final furlong. CIBERTRUCK tracked two to three wide in mid-pack and finished with some interest but was. MEDIMPACT held up from the break, was the distant trailer to the turn saved ground throughout and passed tiring rivals in the lane. BERT'S PROSPECT raced close up three wide in the tracking group, launched a bid into the far turn, loomed at the top of the stretch but could not sustain the rally and weakened a bit in the late stages. HOUSE OF LORDS raced inside in the back of the tracking group, made a mild bid on the turn on the inside, tipped four wide into the stretch and came up empty late.
