REAL GOOD MAGIC broke well, tracked close up inside down the backstretch then sent after the leaders approaching the quarter pole swung three wide into the stretch, had some trouble changing leads but surged ahead late to prevail. WINNING BIG raced three wide between horses in the tracking group, took a four wide path into the stretch, finished up well to gain the place. IN VRONSKY STYLE pressed BEAU'S CHARM to the quarter pole, went clear in the stretch then shortened strides in the late stages and could not hold on. COMMUNITY SERVICE raced in mid-pack to the turn, was going nowhere then drifted out a path in mid-stretch under left handed urging, putting J C'S A LEGEND in tight and forcing that one to have to check, then finished evenly to the wire. J C'S A LEGEND settled inside well behind the pace, started to run on through the turn, angled out to the four path, was mildly gaining then had to check in tight quarters mid-stretch when COMMUNITY SERVICE came over and was too late to recover. MONGOLIAN MASTER was unable to keep up early despite the best efforts of the rider, was second to last into the turn, kept on trying through the stretch and improved. MARSH CREEK was under a drive and unable to keep up from the start, saved ground through the turn and kept to task but was unable to threaten. OCASEK chased four wide down the backstretch, got floated five wide on the last turn and went flat. BEAU'S CHARM was quickest to break and went to the front, was confronted by IN VRONSKY STYLE passing the quarter pole, gave way readily and faded in the stretch. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN. AFTER A REVIEW #5 COMMUNITY SERIVCE WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM 4TH POSITION FOR INTERFERENCE AND PLACED 5TH.
