MR FABRICATOR stalked the top pair to the turn, challenged three deep with a quarter mile remaining, kicked clear at the top of the lane and drew off under urging. BRAINIAC dueled for the lead from outside up the backstretch and around the turn, fought between rivals coming into the lane, was no match for the winner in upper stretch, then stayed on to hold second. EL SIETE LEGUAS broke a step slow, chased from off the pace, took the turn three then four wide, showed a mild response but could not get by BRAINIAC for second. ROYAL CURLIN traveled in mid-pack early, rounded the bend two then three wide, kept trying down the lane but needed to find more. GOLDEN AFFAIR lacked early speed, went two wide into the turn, made some progress while angling to the rail, moved off the fence a bit in the drive and could not threaten. BRINSON became fractious in the gate, went up to duel from inside, fought along the rail with outer rivals turning for home, yielded in upper stretch and gave way in the furlong grounds. SHAKE THE DUST was fractious in the gate, chased in the five path into the turn, crept closer while remaining wide around the bend, then flattened out in the stretch run. I'M MR. SHENANIGAN was antsy in the gate, came away well and was hustled early between rivals but began to drop back quickly, trailed along the rail then two wide into the lane and was outrun. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

MY INDY got crowded between rivals leaving the gate, raced outside a rival well off the early speed, picked up stride on the backstretch, traveled three deep leaving the backstretch, angled to the inside around the far turn, asked left handed at the top of the lane and finished well to gain second and close the gap on the winner late. SYNTACTIC traveled two wide well off the pace, gained three then four wide on the far turn, rallied widest in the lane and got up three deep on the wire while taking a bump. NATIONAL GENERAUX (IRE) stalked from inside, bid two wide with three furlongs remaining, took over near the quarter pole, resisted through the drive, drifted late and got nailed on the wire. LEVON was off slow to begin, was a bit rank into the first turn in the two path trailing the field, drew closer outside rivals in the middle stages, was on the move through the far turn, loomed three wide turning for home, drew alongside the leader, battled down the stretch and got forced into outer rival at the wire to narrowly miss. MONGOLIAN SPRING laid off the pace in the two path, moved to the inside, checked off heels at the three-eighths pole, traveled along the rail then two wide around the far turn, kept trying down the lane and was along for minor award. ECHO CANYON tracked two wide early, drew closer three deep on the backstretch, went two then three wide on the far turn and lacked a bid. KEEP IT COMING raced near the back on the inside, trailed up the backstretch and improved position. BENNY BUCKETS tracked along the inside, tipped two

wide at the quarter pole, ran into traffic in upper stretch, moved out into the clear and weakened. MR INSENSITIVE raced three wide off the pace outside a rival, went between foes on the backstretch, steadied a bit at the three-eighths pole, saved ground to the stretch and failed to rally. ROSENQUIST showed the way early on the inside, took pressure with three furlongs remaining, dueled around the far turn, lost command with a quarter mile left to run, yielded shortly after and gave way in the lane. K R RULES stalked in the two path, between rivals at the seven-sixteenths pole, got crowded entering the far turn, fell back to last around the bend and tired. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE TOP THREE FINISHERS LATE IN THE RACE AND RULED THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.

CRYSTALIZED SECRET went to the front dueling from inside then lost command to LOTA SALITA in the early going, stayed inside that rival to the turn, regained command near the quarter pole, inched ahead in upper stretch and drew clear to prove best. SOCIAL PROMISE broke out and bumped then shifted in at the start, coaxed along early chasing well off the rail, rounded the bend four then three wide, brushed with inner rival past the eighth pole, put in a late run and got up for second. LOTSALITA went up to challenge CRYSTALIZED SECRET from outside and inched ahead up the backstretch, was headed by that rival again around the bend, lost command with a quarter mile remaining, fought to midstretch, yielded in the final sixteenth and got edged for second. HEARTS FANTASY stalked from inside into the, tipped out at the quarter pole, took aim three wide entering the stretch, came out at the eighth

pole and finished evenly. HULA PRANCER bumped leaving the gate, forwardly placed three deep between rivals then lost ground leaving the backstretch, chased in the two path through the turn, angled out at the top of the lane, brushed with outer rival and took up past the eighth pole and could not recover from the trouble. BETTY RYANO broke out, bumped with a rival and bobbled leaving the gate, chased from off the pace, traveled along the rail around the bend and could not make an impact. HARBOR STRIKE bumped with HULA PRANCER leaving the gate, chased four then three deep to the turn, got floated out at the quarter pole and weakened. SPAGHETTI TREE took a bump at the start, stalked the top pair outside a rival to the turn, got floated out at the quarter pole, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. SLEW CITY TIZ stumbled badly and took a bump from outer rival at the start, trailed up the backstretch, exited the backstretch in the five path, angled to the two path around the bend and was never a factor.
