LADY ATHENA rushed to the lead heading into the turn then opened up a clear advantage approaching the quarter pole, opened up in the stretch under steady handling and easily held off a late bid on the outside. CONFIDENCE BUILDER outrun from the break chased through the turn then came five wide into the stretch and rallied for the place. HOT LAVA CAKE was near the back of the main pack then steadied just past the half losing some ground, re-bid on the turn then had to wait for room approaching the quarter pole, got a seam in the two path in upper stretch, split horses and ran on to grab the third prize. HEY BARMAID was being pushed into the early pace battle then took up sharply near the seven-sixteenths pole, lost ground, switched to the outside then tried to rally four wide into the stretch but was outfinished. CAPITAL HEAT hustled from the break and got inside position early, took up sharply heading into the turn, came back with a three wide rally into the stretch but was out-kicked in the late stages. MET AT THE DANCE was pushed on from the start and vied three wide early on the turn, was unable go with LADY ATHENA but vied for the second spot in upper stretch before weakening in the final furlong. CONQUEST SECRET was quickest from the gate but beaten to the turn by LADY ATHENA, ceded the lead while holding the rail then faltered in the stretch.

SOCIAL STATUS was last of the main pack through the early stages, launched a four wide bid on the turn and staged a big rally to just miss. HARRY'S BIG DREAM chased three wide with the second flight, launched a bid from the three furlong pole and finished with good energy but was not good enough o threaten while finishing clear of he next horse. IT'S NOT THE LAW chased ADA THORNE from the inside, dropped back on the turn then tried to re-bid late on the turn, drifted out a bit turning not the stretch and finished evenly. DIVINE GIFT hustled from the break but unable to join the early pace battle, dropped back to the back of the main pack then keep to task and passed a couple of tired ones. WHAT A JOKE was close up three wide early, went to press ADA THORNE approaching the three-furlong pole only to have that rival quicken away, kept trying late despite racing on the left

lead and faltered in the final furlong. LOVELY BRIDE sent hard from the start but was unable to keep close to the pace, stayed inside then lacked a late bid. KNOW BARAA walked away from the gate, dropped far behind and chased throughout.
