BLESSED ANGEL pushed from the break and vied three wide for the early lead, put a head in front late on the turn, battled on into the stretch then edged clear late. CREME DE MENTHE was close up with the early leaders four wide, launched a bid after the three furlong pole, finished up well, battled with the eventual winner to deep stretch and weakened late. LETS DECLARE PEACE settled three wide outside of the tracking group, was set down near the five-sixteenths marker, bid five wide into the stretch and finished with good energy but was too late. GO GO SADIE raced inside, not far from the pace, tipped out to the four path in upper stretch and finished with some interest but was unable to threaten. GREASE MISSLE hustled from the break and joined the early pace battle on the inside, kept to the inside path through the turn then weakened in the final furlong. ASENA raced between horses with the second flight never far back, became boxed in on the turn then shifted to an inside path turning into the stretch but was unable to mount a late bid. BLUE SPIRIT contested the pace two deep through the early stages, checked out of the pace battle at the five-sixteenths, lost momentum and was unable to recover.

THE GOLDEN EGG showed good early speed from the outside post, launched a bid with three furlongs to run, went three wide around GOLD MAGIC but found that rival resurgent, battled into the stretch then gained an advantage approaching the furlong marker and went clear to the wire under steady handling. OUTOFQUEMADO was last entering the first turn and settled far back early, was put into a drive with three furlongs to run and advanced quickly into contention through the turn, finished well up the rail, was unable to collar the winner but gained second clear of the rest. WINSITWELL raced between horses with the second flight through the early stages, then made a bid for the lead near the three furlong pole, bid four wide under a stiff drive, was racing on the left lead through the stretch but produced a grinding finish to gain the show money. approaching the three furlong marker, faded quickly through the field and was not persevered with in the late stages when hopelessly behind.

JIMMY'S WILD BOY was not pushed early and settled along the rail, moved out to the two path after passing the half, then got a good run through the turn, encountered some traffic in upper stretch but responded when asked to go through an opening, finished well under steady handling and urging and was up in time. WELL IMAGINE THAT broke outward and was a bit slow into stride, tracked mid-pack three wide, bid in earnest from the three furlong marker, loomed passing the quarter pole, finished well under strong handling, gained the lead in the final yards but was tagged at the line by the winner. CAPIAT raced at the back of the main pack, started to move forward after passing the half, then steadied and dropped to the back, started to rally midway on the turn then swung six wide into the stretch and produced a bold rally that just fell a head short. VINNIEBOB three wide into the first turn, pulled the rider up close to the leaders on the backstretch, moved over to the rail after passing the half then steadied repeatedly through the far turn, bid up the rail in the stretch and responded to urging, briefly gained the lead near the finish but could not close the deal and was headed in the final yards. MONGOLIAN FROST pressed the pace three wide, bid for the lead early on the far turn, took a clear lead into the stretch then gave way late. LUKA GRAZIE settled at the back early, steadily advanced into contention four wide on the far turn, ran on willingly in the stretch but was outkicked. DINERO DE LA CASA was slow to exit the gate, spotting the field a head start, lagged through the early stages then circled the field on the far turn, bid three wide into the stretch, had trouble changing

leads and went flat in the latter stages. BIG SWAG was sent from the gate intent on the lead, cut the first corner onto the main course with the lead, then was joined by a pair of rivals for the backstretch run, pulled ahead with MONGOLIAN FROST midway through the turn, tried to fight back when that rival pulled ahead at the top of the stretch then tired under pressure in the late stages. THOMPSON settled mid-pack along the rail, lost some ground on the far turn, finished with some interest but was outkicked to the wire and unable to improve. RAIL TOWN was hustled into the early pace mix, pressed two wide down the backstretch, backed out after passing the half and had nothing to offer in the stretch.

DEFENSE WINS broke well and was close up through the initial stages, pulled back off the speed duel, rebid late on the turn and finished up well to win the battle for the second prize. READY TO STORM settled inside behind the pace, cut the corner into the stretch, finished willingly under strong handling and lost a bob at the wire for second. KANDEREL dropped far off the pace in the early stages, launched a four to five wide bid on the turn then closed stoutly under steady handling and urging but ran out of time. BEDROCK was unable to contend with the early pace and raced in the back half of he field, went five wide into the stretch and finished evenly while never a serious threat. STAR ENTRY broke well but dropped back when unable to keep pace early, went three wide through the turn then ran into some traffic at the top of the stretch, altered course to the inside and finished up well. TOOLITTLETOOLATE broke sharply and was up with the leaders in the initial stages, dropped out of the speed duel then went one-paced late. HEY

BATMAN outrun early, saved ground but was unable to improve despite late urging. GROOVY HUEY broke slow then rushed up to dispute the early pace between horses, gave way near the quarter pole then had little left for the stretch run. LOVE MY JIMMY broke sharply then contested the pace inside and tired in the stretch.
