SPICY RIDE rated three then four deep on the clubhouse turn, coaxed forward on the backstretch, latched onto the leader at the three-eighths pole, dueled from outside around the bend, put a head in front in upper stretch, led into closing moments and held over the late charge from the runner-up. CHAMAVILLE stumbled badly and had the rider lose their right iron for a bit before regaining his footing, trailed from inside to the far turn, passed rivals entering the lane, angled off the fence in upper stretch, rallied between rivals in deep stretch and just missed. TALLIS dueled into the first turn from outside, pressed around the bend, moved up on even terms on the backstretch, inched ahead around the far turn, cleared shook free at the top of the lane and drew away under right handed urging and strong handling. UNCHARTED reserved along the inside then moved into the two path for the first turn, trailed from the fence into the far turn, entered the lane in the two path, paused behind a rival at the eighth pole and continued on determinedly to gain second. BY DECREED settled inside, drew closer between foes on the backstretch, followed the top pair from the two path into the lane, lacked a bid in the stretch run but managed to save third. SEAHORSE STAMPEDE unhurried in the beginning, trailed two wide around the first turn, picked up stride on the backstretch, made progress while angling four wide around the second bend and kept on to earn a minor award. LIMITED HEATWAVE tracked in the two path around the first turn, drew closer and moved inside in the middle stages, saved ground through the far turn and could not rally when called upon. HIT SCENE dueled from inside into the first turn then inched ahead around the bend, headed again by outer rival on the backstretch, lost command battling around the far turn, yielded to the winner at the three-sixteenths pole and weakened.
