KENNEBEC was allowed to settle along the inside, moved out to be two wide entering the far turn, made a three wide bid leaving the turn and was clear by the furlong marker and drew off to prove much the best under right handed crop urging. AMERICAN BLAZE tracked the early pace, moved to the inside and saved ground on the far turn, swung out four wide leaving the turn for racing room and ran on willingly while no match to the winner but clearly second best. SO I'M TOLD vied for the lead on the inside and weakened in the final furlong, bested rest. COTTONWOOD vied for the lead in between rivals and then came up empty in the final furlong. TEXTHELEGEND was taken back early and void of any speed, then found best stride late while being no factor. WELLSWORT (IRE) vied for the lead on the outside and was four wide into the lane and tired.
