LANSDOWNE (GB) contested the early pace between rivals, took back and stalked the dueling pair heading into the turn, bid three wide to upper stretch, confronted CHUCKANUT BAY at the furlong grounds and dueled to the final sixteenth, wore down the stubborn runner-up in deep stretch and edged away late. CHUCKANUT BAY was prominent away from the start, went up to contest the early pace from inside of ALWAYS ON CAY, dueled that rival into the turn then shook free to upper stretch, was confronted by LANSDOWNE (GB) nearing the furlong marker, met that rival's bid to the final sixteenth, grudgingly gave way in deep stretch and was a clear second. RIGHT IN FRONT broke out and crowded an outer rival at the start, settled off of the early pace, saved ground into the turn and maintained a rail trip to the stretch, could not muster the needed late response but kept on in deep stretch and held for third. SCRATCHY APACHE got squeezed at the start and lacked early speed, settled between rivals into the turn, ran in pursuit into the stretch, angled four wide nearing the final sixteenth, lacked the needed late response and just missed for third. SEAS OF NORMANDY rated off of the early pace, tracked four then five wide into the turn, swung to the seven to eight path to upper stretch, could not reel in the top pair late but mounted a mild rally into deep stretch and got up in time for the show honors. COASTAL KID was prominent in the early going, tracked the pace three wide and between foes into the turn, chased from the two path to upper stretch, ran in pursuit of FIFTY CINCO nearing the final sixteenth, was outkicked in deep stretch and just missed for third. HAPPY DANCER settled off of the early pace while never far back, saved ground into the turn, swung four wide to upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and could not muster the needed late response. SIR BREGOVIC showed good early speed, ceded the front to DESPERATE MAN and stalked two then three wide into the turn, chased four wide to upper stretch, was outkicked into the final furlong and weakened in deep stretch. ITS KRACKEN TIME was slow into stride away from the gate and trailed in the early stages, advanced into the stretch, could not find more into the final sixteenth and finished evenly. ADIOS JOJO got shuffled at the start then rushed up early on while between rivals, chased two wide then from the rail nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit from the inside heading

to mid-stretch then gave way in the late stages. DESPERATE MAN hustled away from the start, disputed the early pace then took command, led into the turn, was overtaken leaving the quarter pole and faded in the drive.

FALL MOON was reserved in the early going, crept closer along the backstretch, roused into the far turn and angled five wide to upper stretch, responded well in the drive, surged in the final sixteenth and got up in time for a determined win. VRONSKY FEINT vied for the early lead then took back into the first turn, tracked the leading pair two to three wide along the backstretch, re-bid into the far turn and vied for the lead between rivals nearing the quarter marker, battled into the stretch then led into the final furlong, was caught in deep stretch and was clear of the rest for second. FOREST ACCLAMATION settled in the second flight and three to four wide early on, was well placed to the backstretch and moved closer approaching the second turn, vied for the lead four wide at the quarter marker, was turned away by VRONSKY FEINT into upper stretch, fought on to the final sixteenth but was outkicked late and was clear of the rest for third. LOVELY LOLA allowed to settle early on, advanced three to four wide at the quarter marker, swung five wide to upper stretch, chased to the furlong grounds and could not muster the needed late response. ROSES R BLUE settled in the second flight, tracked the pace between rivals to the half-mile pole, chased three wide to the quarter marker, ran in pursuit four wide into the lane and lacked the needed late response. HURRICAIN HUNTER was unhurried to the backstretch, saved ground heading into the far turn, advanced along the inside into the stretch, could not sustain her run to the final

sixteenth and flattened out. LOOKOUT PASS settled in the early going, saved ground along the backstretch, swung to three path nearing the top of the stretch, was caught a bit in traffic into the final furlong, found room in the drive but could not muster the needed late response. POKER ALICE was forwardly placed to the first turn, went up and prompted the pacesetter along the backstretch, vied for the lead into the far turn, battled to mid-stretch then weakened in the final stages. OH ANGEL showed speed away from the start and vied for the early lead, took command into the first turn and set a prompted pace into the backstretch, was overtaken into the far turn, chased from the rail into upper stretch and faded in the drive. LITTLE BIT TIPSY settled in the second flight and tracked the early pace, was well placed along the backstretch run, chased two wide into the far turn, lacked the needed response into the stretch and tired in the final stages.
