

VRONSKY FEINT hopped at the break, was nudged up to contention soon after then taken to rate, edged up three to four wide into the far turn, bid four wide outside the leader leaving the three eighths, forged clear under a rider entering the stretch, switched leads multiple times while wandering but held firm while kept to task. CHAMAVILLE settled off the pace while saving ground, eased out advancing past the five sixteenths, knifed her way between runners three wide in upper stretch and finished gamely towards the inside of foes. FALL MOON, off the pace and off the inside, gained well wide past the five sixteenths, came six wide into the lane, ranged up past mid stretch but was out kicked. MARQUETTE WARRIOR settled off the leaders, edged up saving ground into the far turn, angled out four wide to make a run between runners into the stretch, shifted back in a bit, chased past mid stretch and flattened out. FOREST ACCLAMATION, off slow and very rank through the opening three sixteenths, lagged far back through the backstretch run, came four wide for the drive and churned on to the inside of rivals. LOVELY LOLA, unhurried early while saving ground, angled three wide into the stretch but came up empty.

LOOKOUT PASS, three to four wide, made a mild run nearing the quarter pole, failed to sustain past the three sixteenths and faded. PROOF OF JAZZ cleared around the first turn, set the pace towards the inside, failed to deny the winner past the five sixteenths and faltered. ROUBAIX, three then two wide in close attendance, failed to kick on under pressure around the final turn and tired. SHE'S SO SHINY had speed then rated off the leaders, stalked inside, lacked a punch leaving the five sixteenths and faltered.

XTREME MAYHEM drafted back off the pace and off the inside, edged up behind a host of rivals past the five sixteenths, swung out to the seven path entering the lane, closed steadly under left handed asking, forged to a slim lead outside SAINT PIO with about seventy yards remaining, switched back to his correct lead in the final yards and prevailed. SAINT PIO, five wide outside runners leaving the far turn, circled six wide with progress into the stretch, ranged up to engage the leader past mid stretch, battled on near even terms inside the winner through the final sixteenth, kept on gamely and just missed. COASTAL FOG, away alertly and led for a couple strides, was overtaken then chased four to five wide between rivals, churned on through the final furlong and just got the show over an inner foe. BIG DON'S SMILING, three to four wide between horses, angled in with a furlong to go and kept on with effort. MISTER K, away well, was hung out six wide outside runners heading to the turn, angled out extremely wide for the drive and had belated action. CLOUD BLITZ was loaded without the rider, broke a step slow, recovered and rushed up inside to chase, raced two wide then between foes near mid stretch and came up empty. TOO TALL TO CALL, balked loading, was sent up between rivals to take command after about a furlong, went clear into the turn, opened up a lengthy advantage while under some asking mid turn, began to shorten stride near mid stretch, was overwhelmed by outer foes soon after and faltered through the final sixteenth. ROPER, two wide and to the inside pursuing early, dropped back some leaving the far turn, came back on a bit while saving ground into the stretch then tired through the final furlong.
