BOB AND JULES veered in on the break, was hustled to force the pace on the rail down the backside, got out slightly on the turn when chasing the pacesetter, slipped up the fence for the lead at the top of the lane and gamely prevailed inside runners to the wire. HOLIDAY SNOOZE was unhurried settling near the rear on the inside in the beginning, waited for the cue to go behind the lead threesome when shifting out at the quarter pole, darted between foes in the two path battling for the lead turning for home, lost its path and was forced to angle out around the furlong marker, surged late but just missed at the finish line. INDY ONE was poised down the back straight all alone watching the dueling pair up front, loomed three wide measuring the lead pair outside on the bend, battled in the four path for the top spot straightening out for the finish but needed more late when fading in deep stretch to hold for the show money. PEOPLE ARE PEOPLE was allowed to settle at the back seeing the field on the outside, took closer order around rivals through the turn, surged to have an early lead between horses down the backside, edged away narrowly midturn setting the pace, was headed on either side clinging to the front entering the stretch, had little left for the drive and wilted at the eighth pole.

WHISKEY N ICE was hustled from the get-go taking command early, improved the advantage in hand through the turn and coasted home with no challenges in sight for the dominant win when crossing the wire. HYPER HOLIDAY rated outside foes in a stalking position down the back straight, made little headway through the turn, began to extend its stride in the four path at the top of the stretch and finished up smartly besting the rest down the lane while a being a distant second. GET OUT THE VOTE had a good set up watching the front two in the early stages, saved ground taking the short way on the bend, edged up for the place share inside at the top of the lane but tired late while just holding for the show award in the end. SLOANS SKY travelled inside runners with a stalking position in the beginning, made little impression actually backing away to be last around the turn, found its best stride in the five path in upper stretch and had a good late kick to just miss at the wire for a late surge for the show. POWAQA was void of early speed trailing the pack down the back straight, commenced a slight rally three wide outside fors midway on the turn, shifted out widest in the six path for the drive but was one paced to the finish line. FEATHERWEIGHT rated kindly in mid-field early on, kept pace with rivals around the bend, fought for the runners up share three wide at the top of the lane but weakened with horses on either side at the furlong marker. LADY WITH ATTITUDE broke outwards on the start, chased the loose pacesetter along the backside, could not keep up to the winner through the turn and backed away stopping by mid-stretch.

BUFF BAY was hard ridden after the start inside a rival to take command down the backside, began to inch away from the pesky other speed foe midturn and while under a vigorous ride in the stretch stubbornly dug in to hold safe for the front running tally. FANNY M prompted the pace scenario on the outside in the early going, chased the winner still on the outside around the bend, fought on determinedly chasing the winner down the lane but could not close the gap at the finish line. NO MALARKEY sat alone keeping a close eye on the front pair watching them go at it to themselves down the backstretch, tried but could not narrow the margin on the lead twosome on the turn and finished up willingly to the wire to hold for the show money in the end. SARATOGA EMPRESS (GB) was situated on the rail near the rear having no early foot in the beginning, lost ground to others and was relegated to the back through the turn, rallied smartly inside foes in the stretch run and was just denied in a tight photo for the show ward at the wire. SULTRY SOPHIE had a stalking trip in the middle of the pack on the outside down the backstretch, made little impact but did keep pace throughout the bend, dueled for a minor role three wide in the drive but gave way in the late stages. HARD TO CAPTURE was reserved off the pace, fanned seven to eight wide turning into upper stretch while gaining willingly, was confidently handled rallying from outside to the lead a sixteenth from home and drove past. CEFALO was strongly urged from the start but lacking early speed, soon picked it up and moved forward chasing three to four wide and still under encouragement, was put to even greater urging nearing the quarter pole, came out a bit for the drive, kept on late to just get up for second. MI TORMENTA stalked the leader taking closer order on the turn, struck the lead at the top of the stretch while lugging in a bit, appeared to lose the cap from the helmet which then blew in the wind through the lane still partly attached, was outkicked for the win and just lost the nod for place at the wire. HOT OMELET settled into stride last early, steadily advanced outside into and on the turn racing four to five wide through that bend, came out a bit for the drive, kept on evenly. MISS BOBBIT tracked from inside on or just off the rail through the turn, failed to rally. GOLDEN SPRING shot clear soon after the start with mild encouragement, set the pace inside, was headed at the top of the stretch and gave way. CREATIVPERFORMANCE raced off the pace and removed from the fence, was encouraged to keep up coming past the three-eighths but had no response and faded.

GO KART MOZART was roused right after the start to seize command a few strides out of the gate, repelled a rival on the outside when hounded with five sixteenths to go, opened up on the field at the top of the lane and was keep to the task to hold comfortably for the win at the wire. DEPUTY DADDY had a stalking trip ahead of only the troubled foe at the start, started to lengthen stride three wide with a quarter mile to run, burst sharply between horses in the four path turning for home, could not get to the winner but did fight on in the stretch drive to win the battle for the runners up share. DARK DANGER settled outside foes in mid-pack, came under a ride three wide making a move by the quarter pole, was no match for the winner who spurted away in upper stretch and fought on for the place share in the lane but just missed that position at the wire. GLINTINDADDYSEYE sat just of the pacesetter on the outside down the back straight, moved in closer to pose a threat on the outside midway around the bend, could not keep up to the winner who had more in reserve by the time they hit the stretch and tired inside rivals in the last furlong to settle on the fringes. LET'S GO LIAM travelled on the rail in midfield, could not keep up to challengers while taking the short way around on the turn and could not offer a late bid to get into contention through the stretch. PRINCE ROYCE missed the break to trail the field by many along the backside, lost touch with the group through the turn and galloping along in the stretch crossing the finish line.

PARTY ON showed good early speed clearing from the outer post to have the lead alone while in hand at the half, got a breather uncontested up top through the turn and had more in the tank down the lane while kept to the task to the finish line. ORDEROFTHEPHOENIX (IRE) chased the pace outside three deep down the backside, tried to close in on the leader with runners on either side midturn, kept on running in the four path between horses at the top of the lane, could not get to the winner who had it all her way through out but did finish up well to be second best on this day. SHOTGUN WEDDING broke sharp at the start for early command, then rated between foes watching the frontrunner along the backside, came under a ride holding the inside position battling for second money around the turn and finished up willingly down the stretch but just lost the battle for the runners up share late. NATA TROUBLE settled on the inside near the back of the pack, had to be steadied when in tight with rivals on both sides at the three-furlong marker losing momentum, trailed around the turn and finished up mildly for a minor role in the end. BOUND TO BE TRUE was allowed to settle early on trailing the field, started to mount a rally three wide outside horses at the three eighths pole, battled in the five path with rivals inside for the place share turning for home, had little left late and yielded in the final furlong. FRENCH HORN sat behind the pacesetter on the rail in the beginning, backed away on the fence entering the turn, could not make any impact inside at the quarter pole and had little to offer in the stretch drive.

LITTLE TEDDY had an outside trip in midfield in the early stages, inched up while well in hand in the three path around the turn, loomed a menacing presence four wide at the three sixteenths pole and with relentless pursuit got the better of the frontrunner in deep stretch for the win. MISS VYVYANNE was quick out of the gate to clear for the lead getting to the fence easily down the backside under a fast wind aided pace, opened up in midturn, continued moving well still in control in upper stretch, fought on to the finish but could not with withstand the late charge by the winner in deep stretch. BREEZERO settled in mid-division on the fence along the backside, took closer order into the turn, was in the mix for a small share in upper stretch but was no match for the top two late and finished up well being a clear third at the wire. ANAM CARA was unhurried down the backside having only the poor starter beaten in the beginning, made no impression while travelling outside foes around the bend, shifted out in the four path for the drive to the line and finished up one paced to garner a minor role in the end. BRINDI (IRE) was quick to make the lead, set the pace inside while hounded throughout, met the challenge of WINTERBERRY past the quarter pole, regained command in upper stretch, kicked just clear and held gamely while being kept to the task. LISTEN AND LEARN chased mid-pack early, steadily dropped back between foes early on the turn, angled five wide turning for home, floated a bit wider, rallied outside runners to just get up for second. SOCIAL CODE broke just a half-step slowly and a tad awkwardly, was encouraged along shifting in and advanced inside, saved some ground on the turn, came out four wide in mid-stretch, got the nod for show. CHARLOTTE'S HEART settled into stride outside off the leaders, raced mostly four to six wide throughout, rallied some but was outkicked from between runners late. WINTERBERRY pressed the eventual winner from the outset, applied further pressure willingly drawing even coming to the quarter pole, loomed a threat heading to the top of the stretch but could not kick on and flattened out. SALT broke a step slowly, settled at the rear, made no impact.

SINCLAIRITY forced the issue while having runners on either side down the backstretch, poked her head in front fighting between foes with five sixteenths to go, continued to duel for the front end at the top of the lane, under a patient ride had something more to offer edging away for a clear lead at the eighth pole when asked for run and just held off the charge by the late closer outside for the narrow win. ONEJABTOOMANY travelled in midfield slightly bobbling around the five eighths marker, make no improvement even though roused for more midway around the bend, angled out five wide at the top of the lane and was full of run, moving best at the furlong marker but was on the losing end of the nod when crossing the wire. ARYA'S QUEST was allowed to settle on the outside co-trailing at the half mile marker, settled still at the back of the pack entering the turn, swung out widest in the six path gathering speed at the three sixteenths pole and came running on end late to just miss getting up for the show award at the finish line. MIRAMICHI was away alertly for the early lead, took back sitting in a good spot nestled off the embattled trio waiting to move around the bend, shifted out three wide looking for a seam to run turning for





home, had clear run at the furlong marker but lacked a finishing kick to threaten in deep stretch. ONDINE LADY hounded the pace while three deep outside rivals in the early stages, moved in closer to be in the fray up front throughout the turn, poked her head in front briefly four wide at the top of the stretch but could not match strides with the winner in the final eighth of a mile. KITTY'SSPEEDYSTARR had a narrow advantage inside foes along the backside, continued to stubbornly battle on the fence up top around the turn, was still in the hunt just off the rail at the top of the lane but wilted in deep stretch inside of horses. PEGGY was slow into stride when leaving the gate, trailed down the back straight, made little headway through the turn and could not rally in the lane to get into contention in the late stages. HELANA had a stalking role on the outside near the back in the beginning, had little rally on the outside of rivals midway around the bend, shifted out to the five path for the stretch run but had little to give in the drive to the wire.
