SOUPER SUCCESS pressed the issue on the fence after the break, was checked giving up rail position to the frontrunner that was angling in at the five furlong marker, stalked near the rear due to being shuffled back down the backstretch, glided up to the leader smartly on the rail in midturn, moved outside with momentum to the frontrunner at the top of the lane and under urging drew away comfortably in the final sixteenth for the win. MR. MARSHALL tossed its head at the start, was hustled between foes seizing command getting to the fence by the five eighths marker, opened up on runners by midturn, was collared by the winner outside turning for home, fought on until the sixteenth pole but was no match for the winner late while easily securing the place share. CONFUSING chased the pacesetter outside down the back straight, could not got with the top two finishers who had it to themselves at the quarter pole and finished up willingly in the drive to the wire holding safely for the show award in the end. CANADIAN AVRO lacked early foot seeing the field in the early stages, continued at the rear running around the bend, passed a tired foe inside straightening for home but could not threaten in the stretch running. ABSOLUTE CHAIRMAN stalked outside in mid-pack having the eventual winner inside down the backstretch, came under a ride three wide with five sixteenths to go but was making little headway, shifted out to the four path for the drive but had no finish to offer down the lane outside foes.

HANLAN was brushed outside to begin, tracked in mid-division on the outside, opted for the overland route three wide making a rally in midturn, pounced four wide turning for home with clear run and comfortably held safe to the finish line for the win. ROAD TO VERSAILLES broke out on the start, tracked the contesting leaders on the rail in the third flight, moved quickly to the leaders in midturn, had no room when stuck behind the faltering front end horses at the top of the stretch, finally shifted out for clear run at the eighth pole but by that time the winner was long gone and settled for the runners up share. ATTESTATION had a stalking trip on the inside in the beginning, made little advancement around the turn, started to gather speed in the two path straightening out for the drive and determinedly won the close battle for the show award at the wire. SPARKLET veered in on the break, had a stalking position outside near the back early on, closed the gap smartly outside through the turn, angled out five wide with momentum at the top of the lane, stayed on the left lead to the wire and just missed in the duel for the third spot. IF YOU INSIST battled on the outside with a pesky rival up front setting a fast pace down the backstretch, continued to go head-to-head around the turn for the lead, was just clinging onto the lead in the three path in upper stretch but yielded at the furlong pole from his early speed efforts. BACK RIVER was brushed inside at the start, had a good tactical spot alone watching the contesting co-leaders down the backside, could not go with others on either side when horses were quickening at the quarter pole, was in tight quarters between foes with a sixteenth to run and could not play a role late. ITS JUST MONEY was away slowly trailing down the backside, could not make up any ground to rivals

running around the bend and managed to pass a weary one outside in the last furlong. SEHR SCHOEN was away alertly dueling on the rail setting a quick early pace with another foe, continued to battle on inside through the turn, had little left when engulfed by rivals outside in upper stretch and retreated through the lane.

HALEY'S HONOR quickly burst out of the gate to seize command, was patiently handled up top while hounded outside throughout the turn, spurted away when called upon at the top of the lane to increase the advantage, drifted out under left handed encouragement in deep stretch but was well enough clear to hold safe for the victory. MISS DEMANDING broke out on the start, hounded the front running winner outside down the backside, continued to apply pressure running around the bend, could not get to the leader who had something in reserve when turning for home and determinedly chased in vain all the way down the stretch. FLASHY MOTOR sat on the outside in the second flight keeping a close eye on the lead pair down the back straight, began to edge closer when urged outside at the quarter pole, loomed three wide at the top of the stretch but needed more late when appearing to stall in the final furlong. MO ARGENTO stalked near the rear while situated on the fence, was urged for more three furlongs out but had little response, started to pick up the bit mildly in the three path straightening for home and finished up willingly to get up to be a fringe player in the late stages of the race. SILENT AND SINFUL sat behind the leader on the rail down the backside, was asked for more with five sixteenths to go but was going in the wrong direction around the bend, had little left for the drive to the finish line and faded by mid-stretch. SCAT GIRL lagged at the rear while under encouragement down the back straight, made no impression going around the turn, shifted out in the four path in upper stretch and did show late energy to close the gap on the rivals up front but could not gain any position when crossing the finish line.

JUNIOR HOT SHOT was away well to have a slim lead on the inside down the backstretch, set the fractions on the turn while hounded outside throughout, spurted clear when encouraged at the top of the lane, drifted out late when asked left handed but was clear enough at the finish line to garner the victory. GIANT TEDDY was content to sit outside flanking the frontrunner along the backside, continued in hand pressuring on the outside on the turn, was set down looking to be the only one to threaten at the top of the lane, could not go with the winner by mid-stretch and managed to hold for the runners up share by a diminishing margin at the wire. MANSETTI rated kindly inside while watching the top two leaders contest down the backside, patiently waited on the rail under a snug hold behind the front duo in midturn, shifted out bullying his way through four wide to have clear run straightening out for home and found another gear at the furlong marker to pull away with authority in deep stretch for the impressive late running victory. BIG VINCE had a slim lead all the while drifting out soon after the break, continued to get out travelling up top moving down the backside, dueled inside for the front around the turn, edged away for a clear advantage by upper stretch but did not have enough left late to fend off the charge by the winner in the last seventy yards. NOTORIOUS GANGSTER was unhurried finding his stride at the rear with a half mile to run, began to pick up the bit inside foes at the quarter pole, angled out gathering more speed in the eight path between runners turning for home, had to alter course slightly when coming up to tired foes at the sixteenth pole and surged with a late rush to just miss out on being the runner up. INCOMING was taken up at the start with the inside foe getting out on the break, tracked between horses in the two path along the backside in the second flight waiting for the cue to go, was pushed out by the eventual winner to be in the five path entering the lane and finished up willingly to

garner a minor role in the end. WAR OF DESTINY travelled on the rail in the middle of the pack, shifted outside to commence a run with five sixteenths from home, was forced out by the inside runner to be widest in the nine path straightening out for the stretch run, could not recover and was one paced to the wire. KOKOMO was carried out while forcing the pace outside down the backstretch, took closer aim on the leader to actually poke his head in front at the midpoint of the turn, continued to be still in the mix while in the three path at the top of the lane but yielded while inside rivals in deep stretch. THUNDERING was four deep on the outside with a stalking position, lost ground to others while still outside in the three to four wide around the bend, shifted inside to the rail for the drive to the finish line but could only manage to pass a tired runner to the wire. MOST LIKELY was in tight at the break having to be checked when leaving the chute, settled in midfield between foes along the backstretch, offered a brief rally three to four wide in the second flight outside foes on the turn, shifted out to the five path for the drive but had no finish to offer in the stretch running. POULIN IN O T battled outside six deep for the lead after the break, cleared the field to seize command when entering the turn, opened up on the pack while in hand around the bend and cruised home unchallenged to the wire. CRUMLIN LAD prompted the pace on the inside in the two path down the

backside, continued moving well on the fence holding third saving ground on the turn, moved in to take the place share in upper stretch and finished up with intent to just still hold for the place share at the wire. LUCKY SCORE was unhurried only ahead of one rival down the backside, began to extend his stride four wide circling horses at the quarter pole, angled out widest in the eight path gathering more speed and closed sharply to just miss the runners up share. OLD CHESTNUT was reined back on the rail soon after the break to watch the contesting front pack down the backside, came under a ride on the turn but made little impression, shifted out four wide for the drive and finished mildly between horses to play a minor role in the end. ARMSTRONG was part of the early group vying for the lead in the three path at the start, dropped back by the half, kept pace with others through the turn but could not put in a rally to be a factor in the stretch running. MIDNIGHT MASCOT was void early speed to trail down the backside, made no advance running around the bend and could not rally in the lane to be involved when crossing the finish. HUNT MASTER had rivals on either side sitting just behind the pacesetter at the half, was snatched up by the rider in tight between horses at the three eighths pole, backed away around the bend and could not play a role in the stretch running. ROI SOLEIL was in the five path in the mix between foes at the start, chased the frontrunning winner throughout the turn, was trying to hold on for the place share outside at the top of the lane, had little left late and wilted in deep stretch.
