GUS'S DRUMBEET broke sharp loose on the lead down the backside, set an even pace while having mild pressure on the outside in midturn, spurted away when called upon for more in upper stretch and was kept to the task late to hold safe for the front running score. FOG D'ORO had a tracking position in the middle of the pack while on the fence following the leader down the backside, was urged for more around the bend but could not close in on the engaged duo by the quarter pole, moved out slightly to the two path straightening out for home, found his best stride late and closed in smartly in deep stretch on the rail to be second best. BEE ME settled in the second flight inside another foe in the beginning, chased the frontrunner on the turn making gains by the quarter pole, could not quicken with the winner while going four wide in upper stretch and faded slightly in the late going lasting for the show money at the wire. PRINCE ALMASTY had a stalking trip near the rear early on, began to lengthen stride midpoint of the turn in the two path between foes, angled out to be four wide at the head of the lane and won the battle outside to settle on the fringes in the end. BETTERMUSTCOME was checked in tight between foes entering the backstretch, trailed the field by the half, took the short way around inching up through the oval, skimmed the fence improving turning for home and finished up willingly but lost the duel inside for a minor placing. WAITINGFORAHOLIDAY was bumped on the inside leaving the chute, stalked four deep near the rear along the backstretch, travelled four wide throughout the turn under a vigorous ride making little headway, swung out widest in the six path at the top of the lane but had nothing left for the stretch drive. SILENT MORT settled outside another in midfield, regressed in the three path with rivals on either side at the five sixteenths pole and came up empty three wide in upper stretch.

ECHO WITH LAUGHTER was under a snug hold having a slim advantage going down the backside into the headwind, comfortably rolled along on the fence through the turn edging clear of his closest pursuer by the quarter pole, shifted to the two path in control turning for home and had enough left for the drive to hold sway for the gate to wire tally. BIG BABY HENRY kept a close eye on the front duo while isolated in third down the back straight, began to close the gap on the lead twosome on the turn with a quarter mile to go, swung out to the three path posing the only threat to the pacesetter in upper stretch, stayed on the incorrect lead to the wire, determinedly kept on trying to the end but could not get to the winner late. SECRET STORM prompted the issue on the outside, continued to try to apply pressure to the frontrunner chasing in vain around the turn, angled out four wide giving way in the mix up top at the head of the stretch and finished up one paced in the last furlong just saving for the show money inside at the finish line. ALWAYS A WAY co-trailed on the fence in the early stages, began to pick up the bit saving ground passing an outside rival at the quarter pole, moved out to the three path for the stretch run and had good late energy closing in, but just missing for the show award outside at the wire. DIVINE LEADER settled outside another in mid-division, shifted out further in midturn trying to hold position around the oval, angled to the five path for the late going but could not get involved while outside horses through the stretch. JAMIESTA stalked near the rear between foes in the two path, made little progression still just off the fence around the bend, swung out widest in the six path at the top of the lane but failed to menace in the stretch running. PET SOUNDS travelled three deep sharing the rear outside along the back straight, backed away going three wide on the turn at the five sixteenths pole and could not factor just off the rail in the stretch drive.

DAKOTAH BLUE broke outwards in a slight tangle on the start, recouped smartly to have an ideal set up rating kindly on the fence all alone watching the engaged duo at the half, started to commence a rally on the rail with three eighths remaining, shifted outside, pouncing on the frontrunner at the quarter pole, battled in the five path with the stubborn inside rival in upper stretch and gained the advantage edging clear for the win by deep stretch. LAKE LOUISE pressed the issue on the rail in the beginning, seized command inside from the stablemate at the five eighths pole, opened up briefly on the turn at the three furlong marker, had company to fend off on the outside at the quarter pole, fought on determinedly inside in the three path but yielded to the winner in the final sixteenth. TAP MY DESIRE was unhurried outside at the back of the pack, started to reach for more ground passing a runner outside at the five sixteenths pole, swung out gathering more momentum widest in the seven path at the top of the lane and finished up willingly, closing in belatedly to be a distant third at the wire outside. LOTTA GEMS broke outwards on the start settling in mid-pack, offered a mild run four wide in midturn, gained third place three wide turning for home but was caught late on the outside and had to settle on the fringes in the end. GOLDEN HARVEST had a stalking role on the rail close to the rear in the beginning, came under a ride when passed outside to see the field midway around the oval, scraped paint in contention for a piece of the prize turning for home but lacked a finishing kick in the final furlong. DI CAPRI was brushed on the inside at the start, had the early lead leaving the chute, took off the stablemate inside to track the leader by the five eighths marker, was roused for more but could not keep up to rivals at the three furlong pole and was empty for the drive by upper stretch.

ARAMI'S FACTOR broke out trading bumps with the outer rival on the start, had a clear lead uncontested lead along the back straight, continued moving well in hand loose up top throughout the turn and was kept busy by the rider in the final furlong to hold comfortably for the front-running score. BOSSY CANDY exchanged bumps with inside foe on the break, tracked the leader inside another in the early going, chased gamely through the turn, still never wavered trying to get the winner three wide in the lane, closed the gap slightly late unable to get to the winner but was well ahead of the rest of the field at the finish line. PROPHETIC DEBBY (IRE) broke outwards at the start, settled outside a runner in mid-division, travelled outside still in the third tier around the bend, angled out seven wide for the stretch drive and showed good late energy to win the four way duel for the show money in the final sixteenth. Z TRAIN (IRE) traded brushes with the outside foe on the break, trailed in the beginning, improved on the fence by the half, shared the rear inside another on the turn, swung out widest in the eight path for clear run at the top of the stretch and ran on willingly in the final furlong to be a fringe player in the end. KATIE'S GRACE was pushed out by the inside foe on the break, recouped to track the frontrunner outside another down the back straightaway, closed the gap on the winner outside a rival at the quarter pole, shifted to the four path between horses in chance for a small share but could not continue on late and faded in the final sixteenth of a mile. YOU BE THE JUDGE broke outwards to begin but was quickly corrected by the rider, had the rail in midfield by the half, stalked in the third flight inside another through the bend, battled inside just off the fence for the show award with the front pair having it to themselves with a furlong to go but had little to give late when wilting in deep stretch. SMUDGE was brushed on the inside to begin, stalked outside down the backside, co-trailed outside another under a ride making little headway through the bend, moved to the seven path for the drive but showed little in the stretch running.

GALLEY HEAD stalked near the rear going four wide on the first bend, travelled three deep advancing outside foes down the backside, started to make a strong rally three wide outside horses three furlongs out, moved to the four path in the stretch run, stayed on the incorrect lead to the finish but still kept grinding away under left handed encouragement and got up in the shadow of the wire for the win. POWER OF DESTINY (GB) had her ears pricked loose on the lead early on, continued up top along the backside quickening the wind aided pace, was collared outside on the far turn with a quarter mile remaining, battled inside losing the lead at the furlong pole but did come back on late showing good grit to capture the place share. VAZHI tracked the pacesetter outside on the initial turn, moved in even closer to shadow outside down the backstretch, closed in to bid for the lead with a quarter mile still to go, had a head in front now battling between horses at the furlong marker and was ever so slightly outkicked in deep stretch in a tight finish for the top three positions. BEAUTIFUL SKY was restless in the starting gate prior to the start, settled into stride under a long hold sitting behind the pacesetter on the rail in the early stages, could not quicken with the lead trio on the final turn at the quarter pole, shifted out five wide in upper stretch and finished up one paced for a minor share in the end. ELLA IT IS settled on the outside in mid-pack to begin, remained between foes watching the front twosome along the backside, tried to make a rally at the three eighths pole moving with the eventual winner who was on the outside, had to be checked in tight quarters between foes leaving the five sixteenths losing all its run and cantered home in the lane unable to get involved again. PEACE POSEY was void of early foot seeing the field into the first of two turns, still remained at the rear down the backside, lagged well behind on the final bend and could not be a factor in the stretch drive.

G T FIVE HUNDRED stalked the dueling leaders several lengths back of that pair and having switched outside those, began advancing leaving the turn, was asked in upper stretch coming into the lane four to five wide, gained steadily and got up late. SCORCHING forced the pace inside, dueled for the lead taking a narrow advantage in upper stretch, appeared to exchange light brushes in the lane under strong urging, held the dueling partner but was outkicked by the winner. POULIN IN O T was outspurred early, continued to duel outside a rival in a spirited battle, was just in arrears of the inside foe in upper stretch, appeared to exchange minor brushing, was outkicked. DREAMING OF KONA broke a step slowly, trailed early racing off the inside, gained well but too late shifting nearer the fence in deep stretch to close on the leaders. ROI SOLEIL was last but one early lacking speed and racing near the inside, received some encouragement at the five-sixteenths, came out past the furlong marker drifting a few paths in the process, ran on evenly. DARK SCREEN chased from mid-pack from off the fence racing in the two to four path through the turn, was encouraged past the three-eighths, floated out a bit coming into upper stretch, was unable to threaten. FOLLOWING AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF POULIN IN O T AGAINST SCORCHING ALLEGING INTERFERENCE, STEWARDS DETERMINED THERE WAS INSUFFICIENT EVIDENCE WARRANTING A CHANGE AND NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

GIVEMEMYTHEMEMUSIC rated kindly under a confident hold in the third tier inside another along the backside, was forced to move with the outside rival making a run in midturn, bid for the lead three wide at the quarter pole, assumed control in the four path straightening out for home, opened up at the furlong marker but just prevailed in the end from a quickly approaching late runner. PARADISE PERFECT was ahead of only one runner with the field spread out by many down the backside at the half, started to reach for more ground in midturn with a smart turn of foot three wide, shifted to the seven path at the top of the lane, was full of run staying on the incorrect lead through the stretch but kept on coming to the winner at the wire but could not get there in time. STARVIN was bumped by the inside runner on the break, lagged far back of the pack down the backstretch gathering himself, caught up to rivals circling around horses four wide on the turn, moved out further to the eight path for the drive, continued with a strong sustained rally and closed in belatedly for a solid effort getting the show money. YOU AND ME BABY was under a busy ride chasing the pacesetter along the backside and throughout the turn, moved in at the quarter pole to claim the lead in the two path between horses, surrendered the front to the winner when two wide at the top of the stretch and faded in the final furlong, holding for a minor role inside in the end. LUMBERYARD had an outside position watching the runaway early leader down the backside, started to reel in the frontrunner midway on the turn to bid for the lead four wide with runners on either side at the quarter pole, could not quicken through the stretch and evened out in the final furlong. BLONDINA'S BOY settled between horses in the middle of the pack at the half, ran on evenly keeping pace around the oval and plugged away one paced just off the rail in the stretch drive but could not get involved late. SOL DE VERANO settled outside the eventual winner in the third flight at the half, closed in smartly on the turn to bid five abreast on the outside in a scramble for the lead at the quarter pole, remained in the mix in the six path in upper stretch but tailed off in the final furlong. PRIME PLUS ONE veered out sharply on the break, was nudged along to stay interested in the latter part of the field along the backside, came under a ride making no progression between horses in the two path around the turn at the three eighths marker, shifted to the four path turning for home and passed a few weary runners in the stretch run. YOU'RE SO LUCKY exchanged bumps with the inside horse on the break, stalked close to the rear on the rail in the beginning stages, took the short way around the bend but had little to show for, moved just off the rail at the top of the lane but failed to menace in the drive to the wire. LET'S GO LIAM trading bumps with the outside runner on the start to be near the back, improved on the fence down the backside to be in mid-pack at the half, continued to be scrubbed on at the three furlong pole making very little gain, angled to the four path for the drive and folded in the final furlong. ALFRED BELLOWS was quite headstrong loose on the front end down the backside, continued to roll along on the turn but was collared by many rivals outside at the quarter pole offering little resistance, shortened stride in upper stretch on the fence and stopped by the furlong marker.
