FRAC IS THE JUDGE broke a step slow to see the field in the beginning, advanced between runners down the backside to sit in midfield by the half, had a good spot isolated, measuring the engaged duo at the three eighths pole, shifted out in midturn, loomed boldly three wide on the outside of the leader at the top of the stretch and drove by sharply at the furlong marker to cruise home for the win at the finish line. NO MISTAKE had the rail while sitting in the middle of the pack at the half mile marker, was shuffled back a touch on the fence three furlongs out, regained momentum saving ground midturn, shifted out at the quarter pole coming with a good rally to be in the hunt four wide straightening out for home and finished up well enough, unable to get to the overpowering winner but easily besting the rest at the wire for the runners up share. CAPTAIN CLUTCH was under a snug hold contently shadowing the pacesetter on the outside, pulled the rider to the lead midway on the turn, was headed on the outside in the two path at the top of the stretch, offered little resistance when the winner powering past by the furlong marker and faded in the late going while lasting for a clear but distant third. SEEKING MAGIC was bumped on the inside being pushed out to see the field travelling down the backstretch, began to pick up the bit three wide outside of horses passing runners at the quarter marker, moved to the four path turning for home and ran on willingly for a minor placing with the field spread out at the finish line. GIRL'S NITE OUT was away alertly getting the rail and the lead along the back straight, maintained a slim advantage on the fence three eighths out, surrendered the front with five sixteenths to go coming under a ride, backed away by the quarter pole and was empty skimming the rail in upper stretch. EDEY'S VILLAGE broke outwards on the start, travelled three deep in the mix up top in the beginning, was reined back to be outside two others in mid-division with a half mile remaining, dropped back between rivals going two wide midpoint of the oval and could not be a factor in the stretch drive.

VELVET RAGE was brushed by the inside runner on the break, recovered to have a neck advantage on the outside down the back straight, battled outside surrendering the front end briefly at the seven sixteenths marker to the inside foe, dueled outside up top well clear of the rest of the group around the bend, re-took the lead edging away at the furlong marker and cleared off for the win when crossing the finish line. MOBULA forced the issue on the fence in the beginning, poked her head in front going into the turn, continued battling for the front end on the rail bobbing heads throughout the turn, dug in stubbornly against the winner until the furlong marker but yielded for the top spot late, still well ahead of rivals for the place share at the finish line. POETIC AMY was unhurried trailing the field on the fence in the early stages, began to make a rally outside going past a rival midway around the oval, angled out having clear run in the four path in upper stretch fighting for a small share and closed in belatedly for the show money but well behind the front duo at the finish line. NIKITA'S GEM broke outwards on the start but was quickly straightened out to settle in midfield with rivals in each side along the back straight, regressed slightly coming under a ride at the five sixteenths pole, resurged finding another gear between horses three wide at the top of the lane and ran on willingly to be a fringe player in the end. ROCKET RILEY travelled three deep in the second flight down the backside, was isolated in third well behind the contesting pair midway through the oval, shifted just off the fence between horses vying for a minor part in upper stretch but lacked a rally in the late going. SIGHT TO SEE had the rail in mid-division in the early stages, was scrubbed on for more trying to hold position saving ground throughout the turn and had little to offer fighting on the fence for a minor role in the final furlong.

LEMONCELLA SPRITZ was mildly coaxed forward at the start pressing briefly from inside the pacesetter then settling just off that one tracking inside, saved ground on the turn, was urged past the quarter pole drawing closer, took command by the three-sixteenths, spurred clear in upper stretch and held well. CRUMLIN TROUBLE bumped a rival at the start but was quick to take the lead, set the pace from off the rail moving clear after a quarter, was overtaken at the top of the stretch, proved no match for the winner but fought on to hold the place. STERLING HEIGHTS shifted in moving up inside a foe to track in behind the leaders but off the fence, was asked past the quarter moving out four wide turning for home, failed to rally and missed second. ENGLISH JUBILEE was lightly bumped at the start, raced outside a foe heading into the turn two to three wide, raced one-paced and made no bid. MRS. HOT SHOT pursued from outside mid-pack, went three on the turn, ran on but failed to rally. THATSITTHATSALL switched off the rail heading up the backstretch, advanced from between foes then outside on the turn moving out four wide to be within range passing the quarter pole and under urging but weakened in the stretch. SKY RUNNER broke just a tad awkwardly, pulled up early, was transported off the track via equine ambulance.

BLAZING BO broke a touch slow on the start, moved up the fence smartly by the five eighths pole to take control inside by the half getting a head in front, narrowly continued to be the pacesetter while harassed outside by a couple of rivals through the turn, still remained on the front end but by a slight margin on the rail turning for home and was unyielding down the lane gamely prevailing at the wire to just last for the victory in a tight four way finish. FAIRWAY TO HEAVEN had a good trip all alone watching the embattled trio along the backside, shifted out in midturn coming to the lead group by the quarter pole outside, loomed in the four path in upper stretch, closed in late but was denied by the stubborn frontrunner inside at the wire. COHERENCE broke outwards on the break but recovered to have an early lead, settled down to sit in midfield by the half, took the short way around the bend holding position, hugged the fence in with a shot straightening out for the drive, kept on trying determinedly to the end, was gaining in deep stretch but had to settle for the show award in a blanket finish for the top four placings. JMR SPEEDY ESCAPE stalked on the fence near the rear, could not really advance while inside another still close to the back of the pack on the oval, moved out five wide in upper stretch and had a good late sustained rally outside horses down the lane but could not get to the winner in time settling on the fringes instead all the while not that far off for the win in the end. LITTLE RED DOMI could see the field while three deep

on the outside in the early stages, travelled three wide but could not make any headway through the turn, swung out widest in the six path for the stretch drive and finished up with some interest in the late going. FORESTER HUMOR prompted the pace between foes down the backside, continued to slug it out with rivals on either side in the running around the turn, continued to be in the thick of things between runners two wide at the top of the stretch but tired in the last furlong. CRUCIAL TAUNT had a stalking role with runners on each side down the backstretch, improved mildly outside horses at the five sixteenths pole, remained in with a chance for a piece of the prize just off the rail behind the leaders in upper stretch but failed to fire in the last eighth of a mile. ABSOLUTE CHAIRMAN argued for the front going three deep outside of foes, was the first in the scramble up top to give away three wide at the quarter pole and folded inside of rivals by mid-stretch.

PURRFECT GIRL had a nice set-up drafting behind the pacesetter down the backside and through the turn, moved out at the quarter pole making her presence felt, pounced between foes four wide straightening out for the drive, easily seized control at the furlong pole and proved much the best, geared down for the win by deep stretch. TALENT SHOW hopped on the break to settle into stride in the back trio between runners, moved well looking for room just off the rail midway around the turn behind the chasing trio, angled out in the four path following the winner in upper stretch, finished up well enough but could not handle the winner who had plenty left on the late going. HARD TO CAPTURE was hard held in the middle of the pack, dropped back to the rear under restraint at the half mile marker, lagged behind on the turn, rallied up the fence at the top of the lane and picked up the pieces late to win the third place share in the final seventy yards. FOUNDER'S DAY broke out on the start, took this field down the backside while going into a headwind, shook loose from the pack at the midpoint of the turn, was collared outside by the winner just holding on up top in the three path entering the stretch, had no response by the furlong pole and faded in later stages when nabbed by the charging inside runner for the show money. VOICE FROM ABOVE broke inwards on the break, travelled three deep in the middle of the field down the backstretch, crept up three wide around horses at the five sixteenths pole, posed a threat outside foes in the five path in the stretch drive but flattened out by the furlong marker. BUILT DIFFERENT veered out on the break to trail in the beginning, improved slightly going three wide around rivals at the three eighths marker, closed the gap angling out widest in the six path turning for home but failed to menace in the last eighth of a mile. TWISTING PISTONS was bounced around somewhat between horses on the break, prompted the pace on the outside along the backside, chased between foes under a hustling ride holding her ground in midturn, faltered four wide at the top of the lane and was empty by the furlong pole.

EARENDEL broke alertly, set the pace from off the rail, edged away from rivals leaving the backstretch, was well clear coming into upper stretch, asked a bit nearing the furlong grounds, held safe under moderate urging. BELLA CLASSICA pursued the eventual winner from outside, raced three to four wide through the turn, was asked at the quarter pole, proved no match for the winner but held the place. MAXINE MAGIC was encouraged a bit racing toward the rear inside up the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and improved position. AUSSIE HYPER was coaxed at the start, chased from between foes heading into the turn, ridden along passing the three-eighths, moved out from three to five wide leaving the bend, needed more in the stretch. OLIVIA'S MELODY bumped the outside rival at the start, raced up close to the eventual winner tracking from inside along or just off the rail, faded in the stretch. JAPONKA was about mid-pack tracking inside early, switched out off the rail passing the half, went two to three wide on the turn, failed to rally. RELOAD EH was bumped at the start, raced at the back outside mostly three wide, was ridden three furlongs out and was never near enough to threaten. ECLIPTICAL LADYBUG pursued from outside four wide into the turn, was asked for more by the three-eighths but failed to menace.

MOONLIGHT PROMISES travelled smoothly moving three deep to take over the lead midway down the backside, while under a snug hold opened up into the turn, slowed the pace down unopposed around the bend, shifted just off the fence in command in upper stretch and was kept to the task and had just enough in the late drive to hold off an outside rival who was edging closer late. ALLURING AMY assumed command on the fence breaking the sharpest, was then content to sit back off the new leader nestled on the fence into and throughout the turn, moved off the rail beginning to rally at the quarter pole, had aim on the pacesetter outside, looking the part three wide turning for home, grinded to the finish line but could only inch up late being held off by the winner in deep stretch. SIL'S GAMBLE was in a stalking position on the fence ahead of only one runner in the beginning, saved all the ground on the rail through the turn but was relegated to the rear by the five sixteenths pole, made a sharp rally scraping paint straightening out for the drive, could not threaten the top two finishers late but rallied to be a decisive third at the finish line with a solid effort inside. ARYA'S QUEST had the four path outside of runners in mid-division down the back straight, advanced three wide around horses in midturn, drifted out to the six path coming to the stretch and evened out in the drive to the wire for a minor placing in the end. PRETTY LIZA was in the mix up top between horses at the start, dropped back at the five sixteenths pole

under a rousing ride with runners on either side, angled three wide at the head of the lane but could not factor inside rivals in the stretch run. WUNHAPPY WABBIT was void of early foot, lagging well behind the rest of the group down the backside, offered a brief run trying to circle three wide around runners in midturn, moved out widest in the seven-path turning for home, could not sustain the rally and stalled outside of horses in upper stretch. ATLANTIC PASSAGE settled in the second tier between horses, made an early move getting into second going three deep on the outside of two others at the seven sixteenths pole, chased the winner who was slowing the pace but to no avail throughout the turndown and wilted in the four path by the top of the stretch.
