HYPER HOLIDAY settled alone in mid-division with a half mile remaining, started to commence a rally, lengthening stride in midturn, swung out widest in the five path gathering speed outside foes turning for home and closed in belatedly to be a distant second behind the winner who got away at the top of the stretch. EASTER SUNDAY GIRL was nestled on the rail watching the frontrunner down the back straight, battled on the fence in second around the bend taking the short way, was trying to hold while inside horses for the place share in mid-stretch but weakened late to settle for third at the wire. FROST BITTEN was slow intro stride trailing down the backstretch while being nudged along, started to pick up runners taking the short way around the bend at the three eighths marker, kicked into high gear on the fence straightening for home and closed with a rush late to take over the from leader who was softened up by an early speed duel. FORTY N FIVE was nestled on the rail behind the leader, watched the lead trio battle up front in midturn while just starting to rally, closed in taking the short way around in upper stretch and grinded away stubbornly on the fence through the lane just getting up in a tight photo for the win inside at the finish line. WYOMING BILL had a stalking position near the back in the early stages, began to pick up the bit outside midpoint through the turn taking aim on the lead threesome, shifted out four wide with run in upper stretch and fought on between rivals to the wire just losing the nod in a very close finish.
