CASSON was content vying between rivals for the front down the backstretch, seized control when let out a notch with rivals on each side with three furlongs to go, had company on the outside turning for home and opened up when encouraged by just the wave of the riders crop to pull away easily in the final furlong for the win. SIPPING HISTORY broke out and was gathered up for a moment at the start, closed in when hustled three deep making a strong move at the half, watched the engaged threesome still three wide around the oval, swung out in the five path gathering momentum to be a menacing presence at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner who had at least another gear left for the drive. JUDY CHOP had an early lead on the rail in the beginning, lost the lead but was still involved up top battling inside travelling around the turn, dropped back for a moment inside rivals turning for home, could not threaten the lead two down the lane but did fight back to capture the show money when crossing the finish line. WET AND WILD was brushed soon after the start when the inside foe stumbled, kept a close eye on the frontrunner while travelling three deep in the second tier outside down the backside, inched up, measuring the pacesetter outside through the turn, pounced to the lead at the quarter pole and in the four path in the drive to the wire comfortably won going away in deep stretch. DISSECTOLOGIST broke a step slow on the start, pulled the rider down the backstretch to sit just behind the pacesetter going into the turn, kept pace while waiting to move behind the leaders on the oval, shifted out three wide having a clear lane turning for home, could not advance on the winner in the stretch but did dig in stubbornly late to save the place share from the oncoming foe outside at the wire. COMMANDER AT SEA settled on the rail near the rear in the early stages, began to edge up on challengers taking the short way around the turn, angled out to be four wide extending his stride smartly and was closing in late but just missed getting up for the place share at the line. STORMIN DAVE had a stalking position on the outside close to the back of the pack, picked up the bit, beginning to pass runners three wide at the quarter pole, swung out further in the six path at the top of the lane but could only finish up mildly down the stretch to be a fringe player in the end. UNDER SURVEILLANCE sat all alone in midfield in the early stages, made no movement on rivals in the running around the bend, shifted to the two path for the stretch drive but had little to show running to the finish line. SPEEDY PAL cleared from the outside to be loose up top by the half, was collared outside at the quarter pole, offered no resistance, folded by the furlong pole and was eased when crossing the finish line appearing to be in distress. DANCIN' DEPUTY stumbled at the start to trail the field down the backside, was urged but made no progress on rivals throughout the turn and galloped down the stretch

STREET PRINCESS used the rail to secure the lead into the first turn, continued up front setting a pedestrian pace down the backside, was nursed along rationing her speed still unopposed through the far turn, travelled well, in control inside straightening out for the drive and in the final seventy yards angled out closer to the late charging foe to hold safe by a diminishing margin at the finish for the front running score. SERENADING KITTEN was tucked in on the rail rating kindly behind the frontrunner under a soft pace in the early stages of the race, was asked for more run at the quarter pole, moved in shifting out three wide posing the only threat turning for home, was inching up through the stretch but could not go by the winner in the late running. MALDINI bobbled slightly at the start, unhurriedly brought up the rear, advanced willingly saving ground on the turn, angled seven wide at the top of the stretch, rallied strongly to drive by seventy yards from home and win going away. SHIFTY set a soft opening quarter unopposed under a snug hold, in hand, quickened the tempo around the turn increase the margin up front and again improved the advantage while never having to "shift" gears down the lane for the impressive front end score. NATA TROUBLE travelled three deep on the outside watching the pacesetter, chased the winner through the turn in vain, continued to fight to good fight in the running to the wire and dug in late to hold for the place share from the oncoming closer outside in deep stretch. READY TO BATTLE had one rival beaten while stalking outside in the early going, commenced a run, extended her stride smartly passing foes outside in midturn, was full of run three wide turning for home and narrowly missed closing in for the runners up share when crossing the finish line. PERIWINKLE rated between rivals in the second grouping watching the pacesetter down the back straight, took the short way around but way losing positions while inside going around the turn, fought on the rail with a chance for the show award in upper stretch but had to settle on the fringes in the end. SPARKLET caught a flyer, clearing from the outer post to be loose up front on the rail down the backside, rolled along with no opposition around the turn and had more to give when set down in upper stretch to pull away for a convincing front end victory. ROAD TO VERSAILLES was nestled on the rail in the second flight content watching the pacesetter down the backside. edged up around the turn seeming to be measuring the frontrunner, loomed the only threat three wide at the top of the lane, switched leads late but could not gain on the winner in deep stretch. PET SOUNDS had a couple of runners beaten while having a stalking role outside along the backside, mounted a rally four wide circling at the quarter pole, angled out in the six path for clear run and had a good sustained rally down the stretch to just win the minor battle for the show award at the finish line. RESTORING ORDER was reluctant loading at the start, settled outside in mid-pack in the early going, began to pick up horses three wide with five sixteenths remaining, shifted out in the five path with good late energy and just missed at the wire losing the nod for third money. SECRET STORM travelled outside in the third flight in the backstretch, offered a brief turn of foot going around foes on the turn, ran on willingly fighting for a small share down the stretch, drifted in while encouraged right handed seizing third money at the furlong pole but faded on the rail in the final sixteenth of a mile. WOLF BEACH settled in midfield along the backside, ran evenly while on the fence around the turn and while between runners made little change finishing up one paced down the lane. MAGIC SLIPS settled on the inside in the third pairing along the backside, kept pace inside through the turn, dueled for the show award inside a rival in the two path in upper stretch, had to be checked losing its path at the furlong marker, lost all momentum and could not recover in deep stretch. BINGO'S GRIND co-trailed on the outside, made no impact outside foes running four wide through the turn, angled to the seven path for the drive to the wire but lacked a rally in the stretch running. MODDASSAH had an inside position while trailing with another rival at the half, showed little while in the three path around the oval, shifted five wide in upper stretch but had little to offer running to the wire. THEFRONTIERSMAN had an outside tracking spot keeping a close eye on the leader in the early going, was hard ridden between horses in the two path at the three furlong marker, backed away through the field around the turn and came up empty on the rail folding in the stretch. I'MANISLANDBOY was tucked in on the fence ahead of a few rivals in the beginning, was urged inside but was going the wrong way throughout the turn, shifted three wide entering the stretch but could not find another get to be involved down to the wire.
