LEMONCELLA SPRITZ sat alone watching the lead trio after the break, inched up on the fence down the backstretch, started to close the gap when nudged for more at the five sixteenths pole, was looking for a seam while three wide at the top of the lane, had clear run in the two path with a furlong to go and dug in late to get up inside in deep stretch. VRANA (IRE) prompted the pace three deep outside, measured the embattled duo while ranged up three wide around the bend, pounced in the four path by upper stretch to seize control at the furlong marker but could not find more late to fend off the winner outside nearing the wire. LA RONDE had a slow start to trail along the backside, still was at the rear but narrowed the gap with a half mile to go, made a mild run outside, three wide midway around the turn, loomed widest in the five path straightening for home but stalled a furlong from the wire to be a clear third in the end. MARYLAND SPIRIT pressed the issue between foes early on, chased the frontrunner outside along the backstretch, moved in to bid outside at the three furlong pole, fought up top in the two path turning for home, could not continue on late and faded on the fence with an eighth remaining to settle on the fringes. MEDUSA'S GOLD had its head in front down the back straight, edged clear on the rail by the half, battled inside head to head throughout the turn, gave way up top entering the stretch and wilted inside foes down the lane.

LONNY'S GAMBLE was bumped and bobbled on the break to co-trail on the inside, edged up smartly getting better position on the fence at the half, was in a good spot isolated, watching the contesting trio in midturn, shifted out off the leaders four wide having a clear lane for the drive and wore down rivals inside to get up just at the wire for the win. SCUDERIA settled on the outside in midfield, moved in to press three wide at the three eighths marker, battled three wide from the quarter pole to the furlong marker up front, slowly getting the better of the inside rivals down the stretch but just lost the nod the clsoing in winner outside at the finish line. SPIRITUAL MAN broke out on the start, was loose up top down the backside, had company outside at the five sixteenths pole dueling on the rail, stubbornly fought on having the fence run down the stretch but faded ever so slightly nearing the wire to be on the losing end of a three-way finish for the top spot. WILD CARD was pushed out on the start, sat alone contently tracking the pacesetter down the backside, was forced to move in with an outside rival circling at the three furlong pole, battled in the two path in upper stretch between foes but gave way in the four horses duel at the sixteenth pole to settle on the fringes in the end. LAST RIDE travelled four deep in touch with the pacesetter in the early going, was hard held while three wide outside at the back of the pack at the half mile marker, made little headway on the leaders in the turn, passed a rival outside at the quarter pole and had little to offer in the stretch going in the four path. RUNAWAY MAXI was unhurried, co-trailing on the outside, stalked between horses along the back straight under a snug hold, was nudged for more three furlongs out but retreated through the turn and was not a factor inside rivals down the stretch.

NEVER SURPRISED seized the lead between rivals in the beginning, was patiently reined back to let the outside rival who was making an early move, go on with it down the backside, shifted outside on the far turn starting to eat away at the lead the frontrunner had amassed and with aim on the tiring leader, closed in tenaciously and got up in a well timed rally right at the wire for the win. PIPER'S FACTOR sat on the rail in midfield going into the first of two turns,

shifted out in the two path headstrong bullying his way through horses around the three quarter pole, darted between foes quickening the tempo down the backstretch considerably loose up top having the wind at its back, continued to freewheel unchallenged on the last bend, began to get leg weary hold on in mid-stretch and just got caught right at the wire for the win. SOCIETY'S THUNDER settled in the three path in mid-pack in the first turn, was in tight between rivals when bounced around trying to hold position midway around the bend, recovered smartly to watch the top pair on the inside of a rival down the backstretch, edged up on the fence around the last turn, was no match for the front pair who had it to themselves down the stretch but did fight on stubbornly until the end to win the duel for the third place. NIAGARA SKYLINE was in the mix four wide on the outside up top, holding position around the first turn, was taken back into the backstretch to watch the lead two while outside a rival down the backstretch, inched up outside on the far turn to be in the hunt four wide in upper stretch, could not match strides with the lead duo in the lane, battled for the show award at the eighth pole but just missed out at the finish. WOLFIE'S DYNAGHOST stumbled on the break to co-trail outside another, could see the pack along the back straight, began to pick up runners outside with three furlongs to go, shifted to the five path at the top of the lane and finished with intent in the final furlong. MCAVOY co-trailed on the inside in the early going, stalked close to the back making little progress along the backside, regressed on the fence around the last bend and showed some late interest passing a few tired runners outside driving to the finish line. MALIBU MAMBO was pushed out by the inside rival going into the first turn, improved three deep on the outside down the backstretch, ran on mildly in mid-division outside foes on the far turn and evened out in the three path in the stretch drive. CRUMLIN LAD pressed the pace inside trying to keep the rail position, had to be checked on the fence at the three quarter pole to be shuffled back to midfield in the backstretch, had little to offer saving ground on the final turn and could not get involved inside down the lane. SECRET RESERVE travelled behind horses in the four path in mid-pack in the beginning, shifted out off runners seven wide going into the first, stalked inside ahead of a couple of runners down the backside, made no headway on the far turn and was empty for the stretch drive. TRAINERS CLAIM OF FOUL #4 SOCIETYS THUNDER AGAINST #2 PIPERS FACTOR AT THE THREE QUARTER POLE RESULTED IN NO CHANGE. The half-mile fraction was omitted due to a possible timing malfunction.

NO TIME was hustled, clearing off up top getting to the rail around the first turn, dictated the pace unchallenged along the backside, continued up front with no pressure around on the last turn and was kept to the task while still quite in control down the lane, coasted home in the late stages. SMUDGE was unhurried at the back of the pack in the beginning, continued to see the field patiently galloping along down the backstretch, started to mount a rally three wide at the three furlong pole quickly circling rivals, posed the only threat outside, four wide at the top of the lane but could not get to the stablemate in the stretch running. MY GIRL DELLA was close to the back of the pack three wide on the initial bend, stalked outside in the third pairing down the back straight, moved closer three wide with three furlongs remaining, battled for a piece of the prize down the lane and got up in deep stretch for the show placing. A LITTLE FRISKY travelled in mid-pack on the first turn, made little progression down the backside, offered a mild run between foes midway on the last turn, shifted inwards, skimming the fence to be in the hunt turning for home, stalled by the furlong marker and was caught for the show money. PEACE POSEY broke out on the start, stalked near the rear on the rail, travelled inside in the third flight down the back straight, could not keep up to others who were making a move at the three eighths marker but did show some late interest to fight back and pass a couple of tiring foes down the lane. SALT tracked the loose leader outside, made little headway along the backside, chased the winner but to no avail at the quarter pole, dueled for the place share between foes in the three path turning for home but folded by the furlong marker. DOUBLE VELOCITY was brushed inside on the break, tracked the pacesetter on the inside in the early stages of the race, dropped back abruptly inside foes, had nothing left to offer around the far turn and emptied out in the stretch drive. HUNT MASTER brushed lightly with the outside runner at the start, stalked just off the early leader, advanced willingly on the second turn taking the lead outside the quarter pole, moved clear heading into upper stretch and was put to urging, was kept busy to the wire and held. BAIL US OUT exchanged a bump at the start, settled near mid-pack along the inside, saved ground both turns, was niggled along three furlongs out, put to more stout urging by the top of the stretch, rallied inside and got the nod for place. SWIFT DELIVERY settled last but one in the early going, switched out racing outside a rival up the

backstretch, began to advance while fanning seven wide into upper stretch, was forced out a further path, rallied widest and just missed second. BREAKING ALONE trailed, saved ground on the turns, saw them all coming to the top of the stretch, angled out six then seven wide in upper stretch, rallied between foes but was too little too late. GAS ME UP settled outside a foe mid-pack two to three wide, was encouraged along past the three-eighths, floated five wide into upper stretch, ran on evenly. LAST DAWN exchanged a bump at the start, was inside a foe in the second flight off the leading pair, shifted out past the quarter pole coming into upper stretch four wide and within range of the lead but lacked the needed late kick. NO MORE OPTIONS had incidental contact at the start, stalked from outside a foe in the second flight two to three wide, failed to rally. MAAKWA was quick to take the lead, moved clear and shifted in, dictated terms near the rail, was overtaken late on the far turn, gave way in the stretch.
