NAPA SPIRIT (IRE) broke a step slow on the start, darted between foes to seize command at the five eighths pole, cruised along unchallenged up top around the bend, had company closing in one either side at the top of the stretch, was asked for more with a furlong remaining and held on for the win when crossing the wire. BANKER'S HOURS was nestled on the rail watching the top two runners in the early going, inched up, taking the short way around the bend, skimmed the fence looking like the main opposition turning for home, was gradually getting the winner in deep stretch but could not get there in the end. CANADIAN AVRO was situated four deep, tracking in the second flight outside, made an early move getting position to force the issue into the turn, chased the winner to no avail through the bend, still was in the hunt four wide in upper stretch though but could not threaten the top two in deep stretch and captured the show money being a clear third at the wire. COMMANDER AT SEA was void of early speed to see the field down the backstretch, edged closer on the fence around the turn, shifted out to the five path for the drive and passed tiring runners while moving to the rail in the last sixteenth to settle on the fringes. DANCIN' DEPUTY was hustled on the break having the early lead, relinquished the front at the five furlong pole, continued to drop back further along the backside, made little impression through the turn and played no factor outside in the three path in the late stages. BLAME J D travelled in the three path between foes in the second flight in the beginning, kept pace three wide outside horses on the turn but was under a ride, angled to the five path at the top of the lane and yielded outside to other rivals in the last sixteenth while dueling for a minor placing late.

SCORED battled outside along the backstretch, still fought outside with a determined front-end foe throughout the turn, shifted out four wide for the stretch run, edged clear of the early speed rival while drifting in slightly coming to the sixteenth pole and under a busy ride late just held safe for the win. WORLD SHOWCASE was in the two path tracking the lead pair with runners on both sides, moved up in mid-turn when nudged for more, shifted to the three path behind the leaders at the top of the lane, angled out five wide making a rally posing the main threat at the furlong marker but came up just shy of the winner when gaining at the wire. SLOANS SKY had the rail position while tracking the twosome in the early going, held her own just behind the front two around the oval, skimmed the fence to be in the thick of things at the top of the stretch, had to alter course, shifting to the outside off a weary early leader at the furlong marker and finished up willingly in the later stages to capture he show award. TATOOSONMYSOUL dueled on the rail for the lead down the back straight, under a vigorous ride continued to go head-to-head up top around the bend, began to shorten stride while inside winner in the two path by mid-stretch, did not switch leads down the lane and tired late but did hold for a minor role in the end. STORMY OCEAN hit the gate inside on the start, shifted out in the seven path for the straightening out for home and was one paced in the stretch drive. WILD QUEENIE lagged behind the field by many along the backside while encouraged to keep up, made little headway around the turn but did mange to pick up a weary straggler in deep stretch. BEAUMONT DRIVE was in the second flight in the three path with runners on each side watching the contesting front pair in the early stages, retreated between horses at the five sixteenths pole not able to keep up to runners making a move on the turn and emptied on down the stretch.

STRIKE A CHORD dictated the pace moving comfortably loose up top on the fence down the backside, rolled along through the bend with no challengers in sight, opened up when encouraged right-handed at the furlong pole and kept on going for the dominant front-end score. SECRET BUTTERFLY broke in at the start, was isolated in midfield ahead of a couple of rivals along the backside, was spurned on for more when an outside rival came alongside at the three eighths pole, shifted out at the quarter pole and with clear run between foes in the four path in the stretch drive, could not get to the winner who was long gone but did show grit late just winning the battle for the runners up share in the final few strides. APRIL DE VELP was jostled slightly between foes, being brushed on both sides leaving the gate, chased the frontrunning winner in vain around the turn, was no match for the leader who had it all her own way down the lane, fought on inside for the place share but gave way grudgingly late and settled for third money at the wire. MISS BOBBIT was unhurried, co-trailing on the inside with a half mile remaining, made little progression seeing the field while saving ground on the turn, finished with intent inside rivals down the lane and got up to win the nod for the minors at the finish line. ENGLISH BISCUIT broke out on the start, co-trailed on the outside at the half, made a brief move outside at the three eighths marker, was floated out to the four path at the quarter pole having run and while widest in the five path for the drive lacked a rally down the stretch. SILENT TRIBUTE had a tracking inside position down the backside, could not keep up to others making a move on the turn, regressing at the quarter pole and had no late energy to offer in the stretch running.



NO VISOR settled, between at the rear, went two wide on the turn, advanced in upper stretch while being guided out, surged late and prevailed. KOZY BABE was briefly prominent outside the early leader, steadily dropped back continuing to retreat three to four wide on the turn, came out seven to eight wide in the stretch, offered no late bid. GIZMO'S B F F was under a snug hold loose up top along the backside, repelled a mild challenge from the outside to open up again in midturn while quickening the tempo and under a well rated ride had more left in the lane to win going away at the wire. ALBERTA BE MINE had an inside position sitting in mid-pack, kept pace while on the fence through the oval, skimmed the rail to be in the mix in upper stretch, could not threaten the winner who was long gone but did dig in late to secure the runners up share at the wire. VERY SAVVY was allowed to settle at the back in the early going, dropped back even further through the running around the turn, shifted out widest in the six path turning for home finding its best stride and closed in sharply late to win the nod for show right on the bob at the finish line. CEFALO was content to track outside down the backstretch, moved in closer to apply some pressure outside at the three eighths pole, weakened slightly between runners in the two path with a quarter mile to run, came back under encouragement to duel three wide for the place share in upper stretch but was nosed out in a tight photo for third money at the finish line. LADY MOONSHINE was part of the group at the rear with runners on either side stalking the leader, advanced smartly, making a three wide run around the bend, shifted to the five path for the stretch run in the conversation for second money down the stretch but faded late to be on the losing end of a close three way photo for the show award. HOLIDAY ROSE had a stalking role, deepest in the four path outside foes along the backside, began to pick up runners taking the short way on the turn at the quarter pole, was full of run having a clear path two wide inside the dueling front pair at the furlong marker and stormed past in deep stretch for the late running victory. LEONA WHITEBLAZE dueled inside with a pesky rival in the early stages, shifted to the three path between runners straightening out for home, stubbornly kept finding more down the lane clinging onto the lead but could not fend off the late charge by the winner inside in the final furlong. BROWN BUTTER SAGE battled outside for the lead down the backside, continued outside to go nose to nose up front never wavering around the bend,

angled four wide in the hunt at the top of the stretch, kept on running until the wire and finished up with that solid effort to be good third at the wire. OUR STELLA tracked in the second flight outside the contesting leaders, inched closer, measuring the front duo while angling five wide turning for home but could only manage to run on gradually down the lane, closing the gap but could not improve position in deep stretch to settle on the fringes in the end. SWEET VALENTINE was slow into stride trailing on the break, made an early move on the rail at the three eighths pole reaching for more ground, closed in quickly shifting out at the quarter pole to be between foes seven wide for the drive but could not continue all that momentum and stalled in the final furlong. NOYZEE GIRL broke in at the start, had a good forward position watching the embattled duo while drafting on the fence, shifted out in the two path while on hold lacking running room behind the leaders at the quarter pole, angled to the rail with a chance at the top of the lane but had no finish to give running down the stretch. LILLZ STAR was bumped outside on the break, travelled in mid-pack inside in the early going, crept closer when roused in midturn, was pushed out by the inside of another in the backstretch, was going the wrong way while three wide on the turn, shifted to the four path entering the stretch but could not get into contention running down the lane. HOLYMOLYMEOHMY stalked between rivals near the rear along the backside, was checked slightly at the nine sixteenths marker to trail the field on the runners through the turn, shifted from the five path in upper stretch to the rail for the drive but could not factor in the late stages.
