ONDINE LADY moved in down the backstretch under restraint to hound the pace by the half, shadowed outside, waiting for the cue to go around the bend, edged clear in the two path in upper stretch and when let out a notch at the eighth pole won going away at the wire. PROUD MISCHIEF drafted on the fence behind the lead twosome, continued to hug the rail watching the lead two duel through the turn, shifted off the leaders at the quarter pole to have a clear lane three wide in upper stretch, was no match for the winner by the furlong marker but did finish up smartly to comfortably best the rest for the runners up share. OLIVIA'S MELODY was unhurried, co-trailing on the fence down the backside, was urged to go on midway around the turn passing a rival, shifted between foes five wide entering the stretch and closed in belatedly under vigorous handling to just get up late, catching the tiring early leader coming to the finish line. WINTERBERRY was hustled to be loose on the lead entering the backstretch, rolled along up top quickening the tempo in the running around the turn, had company right on the outside when straightening out for the drive, switched leads at the furlong pole while encouraged right handed and found more to draw off late for the patient pacesetting score. NATA TROUBLE tracked the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, edged up on the bend to press the issue outside with two furlongs from home, was on even terms three wide outside the winner at the top of the lane, dug in determinedly in the stretch run but was just outkicked in the final furlong. MISS VYVYANNE was roused at the start to have a slim lead on the outside down the backstretch, edged away from the inside speed foe by midturn, opened up at the top of the lane and while kept to the task held safe for the front end victory. CARA CARA was roused on the fence vying up front along the backside, dropped back slightly at the five sixteenths while dueling on the fence around the bend, shifted just outside for the stretch drive and chased the winner to no avail to be second best on this day. ZANA settled at the rear on the rail in this compact group at the half, sat alone in last when shifting out at the three-furlong pole starting to make a run, angled back inside turning for home and with a good late charge, closed in to capture the show money. SOUPER SUNDAY stalked near the rear going five deep along the backstretch, continued to take the overland route closing in mildly four wide through the turn, swung out widest in the six path straightening for home and finished up mildly to settle on the fringes while outside runners. FOREST B had an inside position in mid-division down the back straight, was shuffled back, having no room behind horses at the quarter marker, skimmed the fence to have a rail run into the lane but failed to fire while battling for a minor share in the late stages. GIVE ME THE BOOTS travelled in midfield with rivals on either side, made a brief move in the two path between foes with five sixteenths left to run, dueled three wide for third money when turning for home but could not continue on with others making a rally and folded with an eighth of a mile left to run. RULE THE WAVES tracked the top pair outside in the early going, was nudged for more three wide in midturn but could not keep position between horses by the time they hit the quarter pole and had little for the drive while five wide in upper stretch.

FLASHY MOTOR took control right from the onset, rambled on up top setting a brisk pace while under little pressure through the turn, opened up impressively at the top of the stretch and won by a good margin while increasing the advantage at the wire. RARIFIED (IRE) tracked three wide, keeping a close eye on the lead duo in the beginning, continued three wide creeping closer while outside foes through the turn, shifted to the four path for the drive to the wire, separated herself from the rest of the field trying to get to the winner in the stretch run and with that solid effort was a clear second best at the finish line. SCAT GIRL travelled on the fence in midfield, was roused on the turn to edge up on runners by the top of the lane, angled to the three path for the drive and finished up willingly to the wire to hold on late for the third place award. MEW N ME was in the middle of the pack three deep outside rivals, narrowed the margin in the running around the oval, swung out seven wide with a quarter left to go, drifted under a drive at the three sixteenths pole running greenly in mid-stretch, still finished up with good energy trying to close in for the show award but in the end settled for a minor role. MATTIE'S GIRL broke slow to trail the field, lagged far behind the spread out group around the turn, closed in smartly in the six path turning for home to finally catch up to rivals and had a strong finish, passing many horses outside in the final furlong. MIKELLE was fractious prior to the start, unseating the rider behind the gate, broke inwards

when the inside foe was slow to begin, had to be checked at the eleven sixteenths pole from an inside rival, stalked on the turn while ahead of only a couple of runners, angled out five wide at the quarter pole, darted to the rail with three sixteenths to go, then shifted back out with a furlong to go in the five path again and was one paced late. JUST LIKE THAT was nestled on the rail watching the top two runners along the backside, kept pace with the lead trio while saving ground on the bend, had no finish to offer down the lane and yielded on the rail in mid-stretch. CA BAM drifted out while settling in the third flight in mid-backstretch, made no progression while under a ride on the turn and dropped back tiring in the five path through the stretch running. BARCHESSA tracked the frontrunner outside down the back straight, chased the leader on the turn, was roused for more but could not get to the winner in upper stretch, had little left for the late running and wilted in the three path at the furlong marker. SWEET CASSANOVA broke out filling the void by the slow starter on the start to settle near the rear in the beginning, was checked slightly on the rail at the five eighths pole, made little impression around the oval, emptied out two wide in upper stretch and cantered home while not persevered with in the final furlong.

LIGHT THE LAMP patiently drafted behind the lead two rivals while on the rail, continued to bide his time on the fence waiting to move around the turn, scraped paint saving ground at the top of the lane and tenaciously grinded away through the lane to get up under urging in the last few jumps inside for the win. SILENT RESERVE was hustled on the rail to emerge from the group getting the lead outright leaving the half mile marker, opened up through the turn, drifted out slightly in the two path leaving the rail open turning for home, stayed on the left lead until late while clinging up front but could not fend off the inside winner late who had all the momentum. ARMSTRONG tracked outside in midfield along the backside, dropped back slightly on the turn between runners in the three path, angled out five wide with foes on both sides at the top of the stretch and with a good late charge, got up just before the wire to capture the show money. FOREST BUZZ had position on the rail in mid-pack, shifted out off the fence with a quarter mile from the finish to be in the mix for a share in the four path in upper stretch, evened out by the furlong marker and just lost the battle for third at the wire. FORESTER'S FORTUNE was at the rear going four deep along the backside, made little impact continuing a four wide journey around the oval, shifted out widest in the six path straightening out for home and finished up gradually to pass a couple of runners down the lane. COTTON prompted the pace on the outside in the beginning, chased the frontrunner travelling two to three wide around the bend, was no match for the top two rivals when asked for more at the top of the lane and wilted between foes in the two path in the final sixteenth of a mile. KINETIC STONE had a stalking role, ahead of one runner in the early going, kept pace with rivals while two wide throughout the turn and while still just off the fence in the drive to the wire lacked a rally inside horses in the stretch running.

WITHOUT CAUSE travelled well, hounded the pace on the outside down the back straight under a snug hold, ranged up confidently, measuring the pacesetter around the oval, seized command at the three sixteenths marker outside and was kept to the task to hold safely for the win at the wire. HOSHIANA (FR) broke in at the start, co-trailed on the outside in the early running, started to reach for more ground smartly moving in by midturn, shifted out five wide at the quarter pole having a good rally, drifted inwards down the stretch even while encouraged with a left handed crop but still determinedly chased the winner home offering a good late surge. SHOTGUN WEDDING brushed the inside of the gate on the start to co-trail inside another down the backside, lagged well behind the field in the running around the bend, shifted out widest in the six path for the drive to the wire and was full of run in the final furlong to close in sharply to be a clear third at the finish line. PARTY ON tracked the lead pair while on the outside of a challenger in the early stages, angled to the four path having a clear running late turning for home but could only finish up one paced late and lost the battle for the third money in deep stretch. MISS DEMANDING was nestled on the rail in the second flight, kept pace behind the contesting twosome saving all the ground on the turn, shifted outside just off the rail behind the leader in the mix for a piece of the prize at the quarter pole but lacked a finish down the stretch. HALEY'S HONOR was nudged along having a slim advantage on the rail in the beginning, maintained a narrow lead inside through the turn, was collared outside by the winner at the head of the stretch, offered little resistance by the three sixteenths pole and faltered inside of foes in the final sixteenth of a mile.

WOZNIACKI was away quickest from the gate while breaking in at the start, opted to let the inside runner eager for the lead go ahead down the backside while contently tracking on the outside, edged up by the quarter pole, pounced when straightening out for the drive to the wire seizing control, opened up a commanding lead with a furlong to go and held safe by a diminishing margin at the finish line for the win. TANZANITE LILY broke a step slow at the start to trail on the outside at the half, caught up to runners outside by the quarter pole, swung out widest in the seven path when full of run missing the turn for home, burst between horses three wide at the furlong pole lengthening stride and closed in sharply late to get up for the runners up share. MONTY'S INN stalked, ahead of only one runner in mid-backstretch, shifted out at the five sixteenths pole beginning to pick up runners outside, angled to the four path having good energy, darted to the fence at the furlong marker closing in late but just lost the battle inside for second money. JUST PRAY was reluctant to load at the start, tracked three deep on the outside watching the front two runners in the backstretch, moved in closer, going three wide around the bend,

drifted out to the five path turning for home and finished up mildly for a minor share. EM CHAMAS had a stalking trip on the rail close to the back, made little progression inside giving way to rivals through the turn but did show some late interest to come back on and pass tired horses down the stretch. CITORI was loose on the lead down the backside setting a quick pace on the fence, continued to freewheel up top on the turn, was collared outside by the winner with a quarter mile remaining, had no answer when the winner swept past in upper stretch, shifted outside with an eighth left to go beginning to shorten stride and emptied out in deep stretch. ADORABLE ANGEL travelled in the third flight on the rail with the field stretched out at the half, came under a ride but could not quicken with the lead trio by the quarter pole and yielded on the fence in upper stretch. SHE'S SO CROATIAN settled between horses keeping tabs on the lead pair down the back straight, was going in the wrong direction under a ride midway through the turn, shifted out three wide with rivals on either side for the stretch drive but had nothing left to offer and weakened down the lane.
