SECRET STORM was void of early speed to see the field in the early going, moved up steadily between foes at the half to sit just behind the leaders, was smartly reined back to watch the lead trio contest the pace through the turn, began to re-engage when scrubbed on for more, four wide at the quarter pole, angled out five wide full of run in upper stretch and swept past coming to the sixteenth pole to win going away at the wire. SOUPER ICONIC pressed the pace on the inside in the beginning, took over control poking his head in front at the half, dueled inside through the bend, stubbornly edged away in the two path from the other speed foe by the furlong marker but could not find more in deep stretch to fend off the winner who had all run on the outside nearing the wire. SOL DE VERANO advanced smartly on the fence along the backside, was nudged on the rail going into the turn trying to maintain inside position, had to tap on the brakes, being shuffled back in midturn, sat just behind the contesting lead trio turning for home and finished with a final late surge to close in to capture the show award. CAUGHT SPEEDING was away alertly for the early lead, tracked the pacesetter between foes with a half mile remaining, moved in to vie between rivals for the front at the three eighths pole, battled outside through the turn, was in the hunt with runners on each side while in the three path throwing in down in the stretch, could not continue on with the lead duo late and faded in the final sixteenth to settle on the fringes. COUNTRY LIVING travelled five deep in midfield down the backside, made a brief move getting better outside position into the turn, tried to go with the lead two while three wide at the three-furlong marker, had little left when retreating in the four path with a quarter mile to run and emptied out five wide outside rivals down the lane. OK SPEEDY could see the tight packed group at mid-backstretch, made little headway travelling three wide around the bend, shifted in to the two path for the stretch

SO DELICIOUS was brushed inside to be at the rear on the break, sharply split runners at the five eighths pole to sit just behind the contesting leaders under a snug hold down the backstretch, waited inside for the cue to move around the oval, shifted out to the two path with two furlongs from the line, angled out five wide having a clear lane straightening out for home and drew off under right handed encouragement in the final furlong. BACKONTHECHAINGANG was throttled down while on the fence after the break to stalk near the rear with a half left to run, shifted out three wide at the three furlong marker, moved back to the fence with a quarter mile remaining, lacked running room stuck behind a wall of runners entering the stretch, angled out in the final furlong baving a clear path while six wide and closed in determinedly late but could not get to the winner. BACKROADSBILLY travelled three deep in the second flight, ranged up closer three wide around the bend to loom boldly in the four path at the top of the lane, seized control briefly with a furlong from home, stayed on the left lead in the stretch and faded late to hold for a clear third at the finish line. HAPPY QUAD settled in mid-division between foes, dropped back a touch at the five sixteenths pole while under a ride, was pushed out in the six path at the top of the lane and finished up mildly on the outside of rivals to settle on the fringes in the end. LET'S GO LIAM was unhurried seeing the field in the early stages, swung out six wide gathering speed and finished with some late interest to pass the tiring early speed leaders through the stretch running. TENTOMIDNIGHT was away quickest out of the gate, battled for the top spot outside with a half mile to go, edged away for a clear lead in midturn, was in the hunt with horses on each side in the trait to poke his head in front by the half, lost the lead at the three furlong pole while being scrubbed for more, countered inside around the turn to be in the thick of things inside rivals two wide turning

RUDE PROCEDURE broke sharp to clear from the outside getting to the fence alone up top by the half, rattled along unopposed through the turn, had a mild challenge outside at the top of the stretch, quickly repelled that rival and drew off with authority late. DELTA FORCE was bumped outside on the start, tracked the pacesetter on the outside down the backside, moved in closer in the running around the oval, posed the only threat three wide at the top of the stretch, was no match for the winner who had plenty left for the drive by the furlong pole and comfortably bested the rest for the runners up share. INSTANT RESPONSE chased the frontrunner on the inside down the backstretch, regressed slightly, losing a position while saving all the ground on the bend and ran on willingly just off the fence to finish up a clear third at the wire. PERFECT SPARKLE broke inwards, hitting the gate on the start, recovered to be in a good position isolated in mid-pack down the backside, ran on mildly while keeping pace with others through the turn and while three wide down the lane, finished up evenly to hold for a minor placing. MAKING HIS MARK stalked on the outside early on, made no movement when roused taking the short way around the turn and did show some late interest trying to get up late on the fence for a minor role in the end. FIRE AND WINE had a stalking trip inside another along the backside, lost ground to the leaders through the turn while scrubbed on for more and had little presence in the three path in the stretch running. HOT POTATO was slow into stride trailing down the back straight, could not find another gear still lagging behind around the bend and could not be a factor in the drive to the wire.

SEDBURYS GHOST traveled three deep in midfield, started to commence a rally three wide with three furlongs still to go, shifted just out to be four wide having clear run outside turning for home in the hunt up top and found another gear when asked at the furlong marker to storm past inside rivals in the last sixteenth for the victory. SHADOW REALM was part of the pair at the back taking the inside route down the backside, continued to gallop along making little movement on the turn, shifted to the three path for the drive, burst between rivals at the furlong marker full of run and closed in smartly in the late stages to get up at the wire for the runners up placing. BANKINGONAMIRACLE forced the pace on the outside in the early going, continued to prompt the pace outside in the running around the turn, began to edge away from the other speed foe at the furlong pole between horses but could not find more late and faded when the winner swept past, as well just missed holding for the place share too at the finish line. SPEEDY BEAR had a slim lead on the inside down the back straight, determinedly dueled up front inside throughout the turn setting the pace, stayed on the left lead down the lane never wavering inside rivals but faded slightly late to be on the losing end of the three-way photo for second money. CRIMINAL INTENT settled in mid-division with runners on either side along the backstretch, regressed between foes in midturn, shifted out five wide for the drive to the wire and finished up gradually, while not switching leads down the lane to the wire. TAKE CHARGE SOUSI co-trailed on the outside in the early parts of the race, opted to outside in the six-path entering the lane and when encouraged still lacked a rally down the stretch. AWESOME RAINBOW settled on the rail in mid-pack along the backside, drafted inside behind the leaders around the bend, could not keep up to the front threesome by the quarter pole and faltered on the fence in upper stretch.

WESTERN WHIRL comfortably cleared from the outer post to get the lead on the rail while setting a moderate opening quarter, rolled along loose on the lead on the turn while quickening the tempo and had plenty left for the drive to spurt away even more at the furlong pole to increase the winning margin at the finish. PINE KNOLL broke out on the start, settled on the rail watching the pacesetter in the beginning, made little gain in the two path through the oval, posed the main threat in the three path straightening for home, tried valiantly but just could not get to the frontrunning winner down the lane. SOUPER DORMY was at the back three deep on the outside of two other rivals down the back straight, closed in but then had to be checked briefly at the five sixteenths pole coming up quickly to runners, shifted four wide with a chance in upper stretch and could only manage to finish up mildly to the wire for the show money. ONE TRUE GENTLEMAN was on the rail, part of the back threesome in the early stages, edged up on the fence on the turn, skimmed the rail to be in the conversation at the top of the stretch but was outkicked in the last eighth, dueling foe second and settled on the fringes in the end. POSEIDON STEEL kept a close eye on the leader while going three deep outside horses down the backside, ran evenly four wide travelling around the bend, shifted to the five path but had no punch in the stretch running. KHALI'S DREAM was brushed outside on the start, tracked the pacesetter under a snug hold between horses in the early going, travelled in the three path under a ride trying to just hold position around the turn, shifted four wide in upper stretch but could not

get in contention down the lane. HIGHLAND LIFE had a stalking role with rivals on either side in the trialing trio at the start, was checked repeatedly between runners going down the backside, could see the field making little progression around the bend and in the two path could not get involved in the stretch running.

NOTORIOUS GANGSTER bumped a rival at the start, settled in behind the pace shifting in, saved ground on the turn, tipped out a bit in upper stretch with aim on the leader, steadily ground on in the lane and edged past late. REGAL GUEST soon led, set the pace from just off the rail, was clear leading them into upper stretch but was outfinished and second best. DEWOLF dropped back off the leader and switched outside of that one heading up the backstretch, was within range three wide coming past the quarter pole, lacked the needed late kick. LUCKY GUEST was bumped into a rival at the start, allowed to settle, went four to five wide on the turn fanning eight deep into upper stretch, ran on late but needed more. MANSETTI was bumped and nearly lost the had no extra. FLIRTING WITH FIRE was outpaced, dropped back on the turn and failed to menace. FORTY N FIVE steadied slightly nearing the five-eighths dropping back off the pace, continued to chase from off the inside, failed to rally.

DONTGOBACKONURWORD was unhurried in last at the start, moved in getting better inside position by the half, continued to edge up inside foes through the turn, skimmed the fence to be a menacing presence at the top of the stretch, darted past inside at the furlong marker and won going away in an impressive debut. HOLIDAY SNOOZE broke in at the start to co-trail between runners with a half mile to run, started to mount a rally four wide between foes at the quarter pole, shifted out in the five-path having clear run at the top of the lane and closed in belatedly to get up for the place award. PERFECTWORKS settled in mid-pack between rivals in the beginning, dropped back three deep on the outside having company at rear with four furlongs to go, tried to swoop around rivals while going three to seven wide on the turn, stayed on the left lead for the drive but did show tenacity, kept trying to the finish line and got up late for the show money. BEE ME pressed the pace holding inside position down the backside, closed in to poke its head in front by the three-furlong marker, rambled on up top to have a clear advantage three wide straightening for home, had no answer when the winner flew by on the rail at the eighth pole and faded late losing a couple more positions. EL DIABLITO sat just off the top two while between horses in the early going, took closer order three wide at the three eighths marker, continued to move in to be in the hunt in the four-path turning for home, could not sustain the run and stalled between foes in deep stretch. RHUMBABA settled three deep in midfield rating kindly along the backside, kept pace but was travelling four wide around the



turn, shifted out in the six path turning for home and failed to fire in the lane. VIDEO EVIDENCE veered on the break, was hustled moving three deep on the outside taking the lead shortly after the start, could not get to the fence along the backstretch having pressure inside, gave way up top between rivals by the three eighths pole, backed away through the field at the quarter pole and shortened stride when emptying out in upper stretch.
