WAGSTAFF settled on the outside in midfield in the early stages, began to lengthen stride three furlongs from the prize, had a sharp turn of foot at the quarter pole outside to move in quickly dueling four wide at the top of the lane and won drawing off in the last sixteenth of a mile. PRIVATE LABEL forced the issue on the outside in the initial turn, took even closer order to bob heads up top still outside along the backstretch, edged clear from the early pace rival with a quarter mile to go, braced for the outside challenge by the winner in the three path between horses in upper stretch but gave way grudgingly in the last sixteenth while clearly besting the rest for the runners up share. TWISTING PISTONS was reined back to have an ideal spot, isolated behind the contesting pair in the early stages, rated kindly measuring the lead pair through the turn, pounced four wide in upper stretch to edge clear taking over control with an eighth left to run and was kept to the task late to hold sway at the finish line. CHERVONARUTA was under restraint close to the rear inside horses down the backstretch, started to reach for more ground on the fence by the three-furlong pole, lacked running room three wide in upper stretch, finally had clear run in the late stages and finished up smartly to get the runners up share in the final seventy yards. BUTTERFLY BILLIE was allowed to settle of the back of the pack down the backside, inched up between runners under a snug hold at the three furlong pole, was looking for a seam in the three path behind the lead trio at the top of the lane, shifted out to the five path getting clear run with three sixteenths to go, switched back to the incorrect lead while taking over the second position at the sixteenth pole and lost the duel for the place share late. ROCK HARD ROSE was content to track the pacesetter outside in the beginning, moved in closer to force the issue outside through the running around the oval, rallied three wide between horses in upper stretch, tried to dig in for more while clinging up top coming up to the furlong marker but evened out in deep stretch to garner a minor role in the end. DANCIN MARY MARIE was reluctant to load, had rivals on either side settling in mid-pack with a half mile to run, made little movement on the turn, angled to the four path in the stretch drive but lacked a rally down the lane. OUT OF POVERTY stalked outside near the back of the pack of the pack of the pack down the lane. DUBLE TAP was urged on the rail keeping inside position to assume command by the three quarters pole, maintained a slim advantage on the rail throughout the turn, tried to keep up in the



lead pack inside foes in the two path turning for home, had little left for the drive and folded while shortening stride on the wrong lead in the final furlong.

MIZZEN ASH was pushed out on the break to patiently settle into stride at the rear into the first turn, took closer order in the two path along the backside, shuffled back to last again with three eighths remaining, started to uncork a rally three wide midway around the final bend and was full of run widest in the six path for the stretch drive to storm past rivals taking command at the furlong marker. ASHBURY kept a close eye on the frontrunner outside on the first turn, inched up to shadow the leader outside along the backstretch, poked its head in front between horses with five sixteenths to go, briefly edged clear three wide in upper stretch, ran on to the wire but just could not fend off the winner who had all the momentum outside in deep stretch. ARTEMUS CITYLIMITS had a tracking role inside a rival in the early going, was checked on the fence in tight quarters with two furlongs from home, shifted out to be three wide at the top of the lane and while staying on the incorrect lead between foes to the wire still fought on stubbornly to be a clear but non-threatening third. ROI SOLEIL was void of early speed to trail the field along the backstretch, caught up to rivals on the outside with two furlongs from the prize, swung out widest in the seven path turning for home and finished up mildly in the late stages to catch the tiring early leader right at the finish line for a minor role. SPEED FIGURES was hustled from the outer post to get to the fence setting a brisk pace on the lead, continued to rattle on under a rapid pace unchallenged around the bend, still maintained a clear lead at the top of the stretch, started to get leg weary by the

furlong marker from his early efforts and wilted on the rail in the last sixteenth. NOT SO SWIFT was away alertly getting the early lead from the gate, patiently was reined back to let the inside rival who was wanting the front to go ahead at the five eighths pole, contently sat off the leader outside down the backstretch, shadowed the pacesetter outside throughout the turn, moved in three wide in upper stretch, switched leads taking command leaving the furlong marker and won impressively, going away in the late stages. AMI'S CRY travelled on

the outside of a rival watching the lead pair along the backside, continued outside three wide holding her own through the turn, shifted to the four path appearing to have stalled slightly in upper stretch and with an outside rallying rival closing in found another gear late and dug back between horses in deep stretch to nail the place share right at the finish line. LET'S BE FIRST was away slowly on the break, quickly recovered under a hustling ride to take command on the fence by the five furlong marker, rolled along up top through the turn, fought on stubbornly with the winner bearing down outside at the top of the lane, could not go on at the furlong marker giving way up top and faded between rivals in deep stretch to just save for the show money in a tight picture. EASTER SUNDAY GIRL stalked near the rear three wide along the backstretch, began to smartly pick up runners three wide moving well outside at the quarter pole, shifted out having a clear run in the six path at the top of the lane and was closing in strongly late but was just denied for the place share when losing a tight three way runners up photo at the wire. IMPERIAL TRICK was nestled on the rail keeping a close eye on the top two rivals in the early stages, kept pace under a vigorous ride on the fence around the oval, was in the hunt scraping paint at the top of the stretch but had little left for the drive and yielded inside runners at the furlong pole. RIGHT BRIGHTLY veered in sharply at the start, had a stalking role ahead of only another poor starter along the backside, made little impact going around the turn and while six wide managed to show some interest to the wire passing tired runners late on the outside. CLOSING APPEAL was settled on the fence in mid-pack down the back straight, came under a ride inside horses but made little progress around the turn, angled out to the four path for the drive to the wire but showed little in the stretch running. BLAZE OF MISCHIEF was fractious prior to the start, settled in midfield three deep outside foes in the early going, shifted to the fence saving ground midway around the turn, angled to the two path straightening for home but had no finish to offer in the stretch drive. FROMTHEWONDERLAND was away slowly on the break, trailed the field when entering the backstretch, lost touch with the group running around the bend and galloped down the lane to cross the finish line well behind the others.
