CRUCIAL TAUNT was under a snug hold, slightly eager on the rail behind the pacesetter down the backside, settled into stride smartly waiting for the cue to go behind the contesting duo through the turn, angled out to the three-path pushing through between rivals having a clear run at the top of the lane and drew away convincingly in deep stretch for the win. KNOWING had a tracking role between rivals down the back straight, dropped back slightly into the turn to sit midfield around the oval, skimmed the fence turning for home to be in the mix in upper stretch, shifted out making a late run in the two path with runners on each side at the furlong marker and got up in the shadow of the wire for the runners up share. GLORIOUS REVENGE caught a flyer on the break to be loose up top in the beginning, set an even tempo narrowly up front inside around the bend, was collared outside by the winner at the furlone offered little resistance and faded in the last seventy yards to miss out holding onto the place share at the finish line. REGGIE BOY travelled three deep watching the lead pair in the early going, moved in to prompt the issue outside throughout the turn, was forced out by the winner to be four wide still in the hunt at the top of the stretch and finished up evenly to the wire to settle on the fringes in the end. BLACK THUNDER broke out on the start, co-trailed on the outside along the backside, offered a brief run three wide outside in midturn, shifted out to the five path for the drive but could not offer a closing finish in the late stages. CHIEF LIONHART broke with the field on the start, quickly dropped back while being encouraged for more inside to co-trail inside along the backside, took the short way around the turn but was losing ground to runners and could not be a factor in the stretch running.

EMPTY GESTURE was content to watch the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, crept up shadowing the pacesetter outside through the turn to pose the main threat three wide at the top of the lane, seized control outside at the furlong marker and won quite comfortably when crossing the finish line. CADFAEL had a good spot, alone watching the lead pair in the early going, inched up inside another rival to the front duo in the turn, shifted off the dueling leaders to the four path at the eighth pole, chased the winner in vain home but did show late grit between foes late to save for second money at the finish line. JMR SPEEDY ESCAPE settled in midfield along the back straight, commenced a rally while outside in the second flight around the bend, angled five wide for the stretch drive and finished up willingly outside horses to just miss getting up for the duel for the runners up share at the wire. DISSECTOLOGIST broke a step slow to trail on the start, improved along the backside between runners while under a tight hold, settled in the third flight on the rail waiting for the cue to move on the turn, shifted three wide in upper stretch, then darted back inside at the furlong marker making a good late move, just could not close enough late, lost the three way photo for the place share and settled for a minor share. ORPHAN HALLIE had a stalking trip on the outside ahead of one rival down the backstretch, tried to make a rally four wide around the turn but to no avail, regressed by the quarter pole and could not get involved in the stretch running. ADELAIDE COURT was unhurried down the backstretch to see the field by the half, made no progress while well back in the running around the turn and could only manage to pass the very tired early frontrunner in the final seventy yards. FRAC RIGHT was away alertly for the lead to be loose up top down the backside, continued to roll along unopposed around the turn, was collared outside in mid-stretch by the winner, had nothing left for the late stages inside and folded in the last sixteenth of a mile.

STYLISH GENT seized command from the onset, angled in to be clear up top on the rail by the half, slowed things down slightly still loose up top around the bend, spurted away in the two path under a well rated ride at the top of the stretch and held safe for the front running score at the finish line. UNCAPTURED MOMENT was nudged along watching the top three rivals along the backside, kept pace while under a ride alone in the third flight on the bend, shifted out at the quarter marker, was full of run five wide in upper stretch, closed the gap late but could not get to the winner at the finish line. SWAN LAKE was unhurried, co-trailing outside three wide on the first turn, stayed at the rear outside along the backside, started to make a move when urged for more run three wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path having clear run turning for home, with a quick turn of foot swept past all rivals outside beginning at the furlong marker and impressively won going away at the finish line for the last to first rally down the stretch. ETHNIC SOUL had a stalking role near the rear just sitting off the rail, made little progression along the backside, started to get into gear when roused for more midway around the final turn, shifted out five wide with run at the top of the stretch, rider stood up momentarily when the winner burst on past on the outside at the sixteenth pole but quickly recovered to charge late, capturing the runners up share at the finish line. MY SEA COTTAGE (IRE) rated kindly, in hand outside tracking the pacesetter, moved in to bid outside at the three eighths pole, assumed command with a quarter mile remaining, spurted away briefly in the two path with a furlong from the prize, had no answer when the winner stormed by at the sixteenth pole and faded late to just miss holding for the place share in deep stretch. CAUSIN' MAYHEM had the rail in mid-pack in the first turn, narrowed the margin in the two path between foes by the half, waited for room behind the lead twosome on the far turn, shifted to the three path finding a clear lane in the drive to the wire and finished up willingly for a minor share in the

end. BRINGER OF RAIN travelled three wide on the first turn in mid-pack, closed the gap on the leaders three deep outside with a half mile left to go, made a brief move going three to four wide around foes through the last turn to be in the hunt four wide entering the stretch but evened out, unable to continue on with others in the final furlong. HEMLO GOLD had a good spot tracking the lead pair on the fence, waited for room behind the contesting duo around the far bend, shifted out four wide looking for a clear path turning for home, continued to try to find a seam down the lane but could not lengthen stride to the wire lacking running room in the entire stretch. ROYAL HUDSON was hard held on the fence to co-trail inside in the early stages of the race, made little improvement inside horses in the two path through the far turn and failed to fire just off the fence in the stretch running. CONTRIVANCE was loose up top on the first of two turns, had company outside by the three eighths marker, was asked for more but relinquished the lead inside at the quarter pole, tried to fight back taking the inside route at the top of the lane but could not go with others in the drive and folded by the furlong pole.

CLIVE CROSS broke out on the start, had a good spot keeping a close eye on the front pair while nestled on the rail down the backside, moved in midturn while shifting just off the fence, pounced three wide outside in upper stretch, stayed on the wrong lead taking over control at the eighth pole but still managed to clear off for a comfortable win at the finish. BLONDINA'S BOY had an inside trip in midfield along the backstretch, took the short way around the turn inside rivals while keeping pace to the leaders, began to pick up the bit in the two path turning for home, gathered speed down the stretch, shifted out five wide battling for second money late and got up in a photo outside at the wire to best the rest. HALCON NEGRO settled on the rail closer to the back then the front with the field spread out along the backside, advanced smartly inside runners just off the rail on the turn, had a good rally still inside foes down the lane, shifted out between rivals dueling for the place share in the last sixteenth but lost the close nod at the wire. BIG LEW had a good position watching the lead trio down the backside, edged up on the inside through the turn with a quarter mile to run, was going to shift outwards but opted for the inside path when straightening for home, shifted outside off the tiring early leader with an eighth still to go, appeared to stay on the left lead to the finish and faded just in the closing stages to lose the three way duel for the runners up placing. BENNYS JETS missed the break on the start, was rushed up inside rivals to take command by the five furlong pole, cruised up front slowing the pace down on the turn, was collared outside by the winner while between foes in the two path the furlong marker and wilted on the fence in the final seventy yards. TRUE SHOT stalked near the back outside horses, moved in closer while three wide in midturn, swung out widest in the seven path entering the stretch, did not change leads until late but had late energy outside and kept on trying to the finish line. BAYTOWN FURY travelled three deep on the outside in mid-division along the back straight, ran on evenly outside going three wide around the oval, shifted out five wide for the stretch drive and finished up gradually between rivals to the wire. J M R TURINO had a slow start, settled at the back ahead of only the other poor starter who hesitated on the break, saved all the ground while narrowing the margin on the leader around the oval but could only finish up one paced on the fence down the lane and could not get into contention late. FEELS LIKE A KYLLA stalked outside having a few beaten along the backside at the half, made little impact between horses around the bend, stayed in the two path when coming up to the stretch and could not get involved with runners on both sides in the late stages. JO JAGR dwelt on the break to be well behind the field going down the backside, could not make any headway at the rear in the running around the turn but did show some run to close in on the outside in deep stretch to pass a straggler late. IM NOT LOST pressed the issue on the outside in the beginning, had a chasing role outside another throughout the turn, shifted four wide at the top of the stretch giving way in the front threesome turning for home and stopped between runners by the furlong marker.
