HOLIDAY WITH AMY had a good trip nestled on the fence in midfield moving well in hand down the backside, was nudged to go after the embattled duo with five sixteenths to go, shifted out four wide looming boldly at the top of the lane and took command leaving the furlong marker to win going away in deep stretch. TABLOID MATERIAL pressed the issue while under a snug hold between foes in the early going, moved in closer to hound the pace on the oval, seized command three wide between rivals entering the stretch, was no match for the winner who had a bit more in the tank in the final eighth but put in a game effort nonetheless to comfortably best the rest at the wire. O WOW had an inside position part of the rear threesome down the backside in the beginning, edged up in the third flight inside midpoint of the turn, angled out four wide gathering momentum and with a good late surge got up between rivals to win the battle for the third place share at the finish line. MAGICAL TRICK stalked at the back while three deep in the beginning, moved in to the rail by the half under a good hold, shifted just outside in the two path starting to lengthen her stride at the quarter pole, darted back to the rail turning for home closing in, angled back out off the fading early leader to be between horses in the three path at the furlong marker, fought to the wire but just missed outside for the show money. MAGIC MODIE had the lead inside setting a soft pace going into the wind down the backstretch, maintained a slim advantage on the rail around the bend, gave way up front on the fence at the top of the stretch, had nothing left in reserve late and wilted in the final furlong. IRON PYRITE travelled three deep outside keeping a close eye on the front two down the backstretch, dropped back slightly to track in the second flight outside with the eventual winner right to her inside through the turn, shifted to the five path between horses turning or home but could not get into contention in the stretch running. I'M TENACIOUS broke inwards and a step slow on the start, settled near the rear in the two path between rivals along the backside, made little run while three wide outside in the third pairing around the turn, swung out widest in the seven path for the drive but had no finish to offer.

ASK IN MY NAME was unhurried on the back of the pack stalking on the inside, advanced smartly having a clear rail run throughout the turn, skimmed the fence to gain control when straightening out for the drive and pulled away with authority in the final furlong for the eye-catching win. LEGAL ATTACK (GB) settled on the rail in the second flight watching the leader, bobbled slightly on the fence when leaving the half mile marker on the rail, shifted to the outside at the three furlong pole starting to reach for more ground, began to pass rivals by the five sixteenths marker, angled five wide in the mix for a share at the top of the lane and had a good late run to best the rest behind the dominant winner. VALYRIAN SKY tracked the lone speed while going three deep on the outside down the back straight, closed the gap on the leader smartly outside on the turn, bid four wide in the thick of things in upper stretch, could not go with the winner who had another gear late and fought on late to win the battle outside for the show position. CLASSIC DANCER was on a mission early, loose up top setting a brisk pace while hampered by the wind along the backside, continued to roll along up front but by a diminishing margin with the running around the turn, was swarmed on both sides while three wide between horses flattening out on the lead at the top of the lane, fought inside for the show money late but had to settle on the fringes in the end. SEA SCOUT stalked inside down the backstretch, offered a mild run three wide between horses

midway around the turn, angled out to the five path straightening out for the wire and could not get involved in the late stages of the race. SARATOGA EMPRESS (GB) bumped a rival lightly at the start, was bumped lightly entering the turn, settled off the pace racing mostly two to three wide, was under urging about the five-sixteenths, rallied between foes to get up late. RELOAD EH moved forward early stalking three wide into and on the first turn, advanced heading into the far turn taking the lead by the three-eighths, moved clear a sixteenth later, extended the advantage heading into upper stretch but by mid-stretch was weakening stride noticeably as rivals slowly but steadily gained, however ran on to save the place. FROGINAPOND bumped a rival early entering the first turn, saved ground on that bend about mid-division, switched out and advanced past a rival heading into the far turn, went two

then three wide on that bend and asked for more by the quarter pole, was guided out a bit further at the top of the stretch then continued to drift, kept on but needed more. SUNNYVILLE was caught four wide into the first turn, settled mid-pack outside foes then between briefly up the backstretch, continued three to four deep through the far turn and put to urging on that bend, came out a bit in the lane, kept on between runners late to improve position. ECLIPTICAL LADYBUG switched out off the inside early, had to steady on heels heading into the first turn, settled thereafter racing near the inside, fanned seven wide leaving the far turn, ran on well but was too late. BLACK GODDESS moved clear and shifted in to set the pace inside, was overtaken three furlongs out, weakened some at that juncture but fought on in the stretch inside racing up in behind the tiring leader but having to steady about seventy yards from home and was not persevered late. SIX FOR A NINE was hard to load, bumped lightly at the start, had to steady early when in tight heading to the first turn racing three wide on that bend, rated under a hold toward the back, failed to rally. SCARY BOO was bumped at the break, switched out and made a moderate early advance outside foes up the backstretch but just as quickly retreated therafter. MISTY EYED bumped a rival and tossed the head at the start and was very slow to get moving, was soon very far back, distanced, crossed the wire and walked off.

TAKEMYBOURBONNEAT broke with the field, then was allowed to drop back finding her stride down the backstretch only ahead of the poor starter, edged up on the rail by the half, waited for room under a tight hold midway around the turn inside rivals, shifted out having clear run three wide in upper stretch, cruised on past for the lead at the furlong pole and pulled away with ease in the late running. WORRY LESS dictated the pace unopposed down the backside, slowed the tempo down slightly still comfortably up top around the bend, drifted just off the fence clinging onto the lead in the two path turning for home, offered no resistance inside when the winner blew by at the furlong pole but did fight on late to save the place share at the wire. HYMN TO HER had a stalking role ahead of only the poor starter running down the backside, made little impact around the oval, looked for a lane when making a run with a quarter mile from the prize, rallied up the inside at the top of the stretch, weaved between foes late with a good kick and almost closed in to get the second placing at the finish line. SAVE THE DATE had an inside trip in the second flight keeping a close eye on the pacesetter early on, came under a ride but could not gain on the frontrunner around the turn, shifted four wide in the hunt for a piece of the prize between foes in upper stretch and finished up one paced late to settle for a minor role at the wire. WHERE'S SAMNBAILEY tracked the lead three while four deep on the backside, ranged closer three wide outside foes through the turn, shifted out five wide in the mix turning for home, could not continue the sustained rally and stalled in the final furlong outside. BRIGHT SUNSHINE settled in midfield with horses on either side, was roused three to four wide on the turn, had enough by the quarter pole backing away

DOLCE FORTUNA set the pace while unopposed down the backside, comfortably set an even tempo up top rolling along through the turn, spurted away from the chasing runners by mid-stretch looking strong but was then all out in the final seventy yards to just hold off the late charge by the outside rival to win in a very tight photo at the finish line. SWEET PASSIONS was sandwiched at the start, trailed the field while allowed to gather herself down the backside, took the short way around the turn, started to pick up horses inside with a quarter mile to go, swung out to the three path gathering more momentum at the top of the lane and with a strong late charge just missed getting to the winner by a nostril at the wire. FOURFIFTYFOUR tracked inside keeping in touch with the leaders in the early going, followed the path of the winner inside taking closer order around the bend, kept on coming on the fence down the stretch, could not get to the front two at the wire but did finish up willingly to be a clear third in the end. BRENGUNGIRL was content to track the pacesetter outside down the back straight, chased the leader in the turn, narrowed the gap slightly by the quarter pole, was set down for more in the two path straightening for home but could only finish up evenly down the lane for a minor role. GENIUS OF LOVE broke out on the start, had inside position in midfield down the back straight, was reined back into the turn to shift out three wide with five sixteenths to go, made a brief move four wide at the guarter marker, continued to shift out to the six path for the drive to the wire but lacked a rally outside. ENCHANTED FOREST had a stalking role ahead of only the troubled starter in the early going, shifted out going four wide making little impression outside in the running around the bend, angled to the six path turning for home but could not be a factor in the stretch drive, lagging behind runners to the finish. PRIMA broke in at the start, travelled in midfield on the outside in the beginning, was roused midturn but could not get to the leaders while outside by the quarter pole and weakened in the five path between horses at the top of the stretch.

TIZ HER MONEY was allowed to settle at the back of the pack in the early running, began to lengthen stride shifting out four wide at the three furlong pole, swooped five wide around the field at the quarter marker with a sharp turn of foot, seized control outside entering the stretch and kept on to the wire to hold off a pesky rival inside at the finish line. CRYSTAL VISIONS moved up early along the backstretch to have a good spot tucked in on the fence in midfield waiting to move around the turn, shifted out just off the rail having a strong kick in upper stretch, challenged the winner inside late but just could not get by at the finish line. THREAD stalked in the second to last position down the backstretch, started to make a move sliding between foes three wide with a quarter mile to go, shifted to the six path at the top of the lane and finished up with energy to be a clear but non-threatening third at the wire. GOOD AS GONE vied between horses at the start, closed in the turn when roused at the three eighths marker, rallied between foes three wide in the hunt at the top of the lane, could not continue on with the lead group at the furlong marker and faded late to hold for a minor role in the end. COMPLEX SECRET prompted the pace three deep outside foes in the early going, was scrubbed on for more four wide trying to get to the leaders around the turn, battled in the four path for a small share in upper stretch but needed more late to be a factor. FAMILY had a slim lead on the inside down the back straight, continued up top narrowly in front throughout the turn, was engulfed by outside rivals at the top of the stretch, offered no resistance, folded on the rail at the eighth pole and was not persevered with late. BIT OF MUSIC travelled on the outside, three deep in mid-division along the backstretch, came under a vigorous ride but was going the wrong way around the bend outside rivals, angled out six wide straightening for the drive but could not get involved. AMBITIOUS LASS settled between horses in mid-pack, was hard ridden three wide with runners on both sides but regressed through the turn, shifted out five wide turning for home but had little presence in the stretch drive.

ZO LEE got away alertly, set the pace inside on or just off the rail shadowed by numerous foes, moved just clear in upper stretch after being put to urging, was overtaken inside the final furlong but second best. MISS BODACIOUS (GB) broke inwardly, was close in the very early stages but taken back to track in behind from inside, saved ground on the turn, came out in mid-stretch, ran on without threatening the top pair. UPHILL DANCE stalked from outside four to six wide, kept on evenly. SILENT SKY settled last but one, saved some ground near the rail on the turn, improved position inside. PRINCESS ANASTASIA had a slow start to begin to sit at the back under a snug hold, moved up smartly on the fence three furlongs from home, had a quick turn of foot to advance by the quarter pole still on the rail, shifted out three wide finding a seam in upper stretch and drove past on the outside at the sixteenth pole for the win. XARABELLA was squeezed on the break, recouped to battle outside down the backstretch for the top spot, edged away outside for the lead by the quarter pole, still was clinging onto the lead at the furlong pole by a slim margin with rivals on either side but was no match for the late charge by the winner in deep stretch. PRINCESS JADE dueled on the rail for the lead down the backside, began to give way up top midway on the turn, fought back stubbornly inside in mid-stretch still in the conversation for the win share at the furlong marker but just faded at the end to be a clear third at the wire. CLEARWATER BEACH settled on the rail in the third group midway through the backstretch, made a smart move on the rail gaining position at the three eighths pole, closed in further when roused inside at the quarter marker to be in with a chance shifting four wide in upper stretch, faded slightly with a furlong remaining but then did rebid late to get back up for a minor share at the wire. HIBISCUS was five deep on the outside in the third group down the back straight, made a good rally circling outside four wide from the three eighths pole to the quarter pole, angled out in the six path in the mix for a share turning for home but stalled at the furlong marker battling for a minor placing. ORION BEACH was away alertly having the lead on the start, dropped back to sit in midfield in the four path between rivals by the half, had to be throttled down lacking running room midway around the bend, angled out to the six path in upper stretch and showed good late energy closing down the lane while shifting inwards to the fence in the late stages of the race. TAP MY DESIRE broke inwards on the start, tracked the lead pair on the outside in the early stages, regressed between foes three wide at the three furlong pole while roused for more through the turn, shifted out five wide for the stretch run but could not get involved to the wire. SUNLIT travelled in the two path in mid-division with rivals on both sides down the back straight, was holding her own when scrubbed for more midway around the oval, shifted out to the three path turning for home but showed little down the lane. YORKTON ROSE settled in the three path between horses in midfield down the backside, was checked hard between foes in tight at the half, dropped back into the turn, could not recover through the bend and did not play a role in the two path the drive to the wire. FORE FIVE BUCKS was five deep on the outside near the rear, made a mild move getting a better forward position heading into the turn, took the short way around the bend but had no finish to offer in the stretch running inside rivals. ICE ČREAM BOAT broke in at the start, had a good spot early on, sitting on the fence tracking the lead pair down the backside, chased the leaders on the turn, retreated between foes while under encouragement by the quarter pole and had no rally down the lane. MAGICCREST settled in midfield in the beginning, was hard held being shuffled back between runners midway along the backside, made little headway outside in the early part of the turn, got the rail with a quarter mile to go but had no finish on the fence through the stretch. RAGS TO DIAMONDS was away slowly to be at the back of the pack with a few others along the backside, made no progression in the two path early in the turn, shifted to the rail by the quarter pole but had nothing to give inside in the stretch drive.
