INDY ONE was away quickly, clearing from the outer post to seize control on the fence by the five eighths marker, rolled along loose up top while quickening the pace on the turn, still maintained a clear advantage in mid-stretch but had to be kept to the task in the late stages to just held on the wire from the late charging rival outside at the wire. TUTTI CONTENTI sat all alone behind the chasing trio down the backstretch in mid-pack, made a sharp move darting up on the rail midway around the turn, shifted out at the quarter pole gathering more speed and was full of run, gaining ground quickly on the winner late but just missed at the finish line. DROP YOUR GLOVES stalked on the fence ahead of only the poor starter in the early stages, rallied on the rail with a quarter mile to go, shifted out five wide between runners turning for home and closed in determinedly in the final furlong to nab the third spot right before the wire with a good late surge. SPRUNG LOOSE rated kindly while three deep isolated down the backside watching the front trio, ranged up smartly three wide circling horses on the turn, loomed boldly in the five path straightening out for the drive, seized the lead while on the wrong lead at the furlong marker and continued to edge away at the wire for the win. JUST JACOBO tracked the frontrunner on the outside in the beginning, was scrubbed on for more, trying to close on the pacesetter between rivals in midturn, shifted to the four path in the hunt between horses turning for home, kept on closing gradually down the lane, lost its path when the seam closed up inside the furlong pole, shifted to the rail late and surged in deep stretch to be second best. SILENT KNIGHT co-trailed on the outside in the beginning, moved in to narrow the gap on the field at the three-furlong pole, could not continue the run, regressing around the bend and managed to pass only a weary foe in mid-stretch outside. EARNING MY EARS drafted behind the frontrunner on the fence down the backside under a hard hold, was roused three eighths from the wire but could not keep up with the outside flow through the turn, tried to fight back briefly while skimming the rail at the top of the lane but faltered inside rivals at the furlong pole.

EVER DANGEROUS was pushed in after the break to track the pacesetter on the fence in the early stages, started to reel in the frontrunner around the final bend, pounced three wide at the top of the lane and pulled away confidently down the stretch for the win.
