HOLYMOLYMEOHMY was brushed outside on the break, vied between runners for the top spot along the backside, was nudged midturn starting lengthen stride fighting up top at the quarter pole, drifted inwards slightly when encouraged right-handed at the top of the lane, spurted clear with a furlong remaining and widened the advantage for the win by deep stretch. NOYZEE GIRL had an outside stalking trip going five deep in the early going, tried to circle around horses taking the four wide overland route around the turn, posed the main threat outside in the four path in upper stretch, was no match for the winner who had plenty left for the drive but did fight on stubbornly late to be second best. OUR STELLA was under a snug hold having a slim lead on the fence down the backside, battled on the rail with a trio of outside rivals bearing down through the turn, was checked in tight on the rail when turning for home, re-rallied inside horses at the eighth pole but lost the duel for the place share at the finish line. HER OBSESSION kept a close eye on the lead duo while in the three path down the back straight, was forced to move between rivals, three wide when the outside foe was trying to swoop around the turn, had the lead for a moment at the quarter pole but could not continue in upper stretch and faded with runners on both sides while trying to duel for the place share at the furlong marker. BROWN BUTTER SAGE broke inwards on the break, trailed the tightly bunched group down the backside drafting on the rail behind the leaders, made little headway taking the short way around the bend and had nothing for the drive inside rivals in the stretch running. BLACKMARSH had a stalking role between horses in the four path down the backside, made a brief move going with the outside horse at the three furlong pole, gave way by the time they were in midturn and while three wide for the stretch run came up empty to the wire. THE FIERY ONE (GB) was roused to have its head in front entering the first of two turns, got loose up top getting to the fence with three quarters still to go, set an even pace unopposed along the backside, was let out a notch maintaining the lead around the second bend and under a well rationed ride had more in the lane to increase the winning margin at the finish line. THIS IS GLORIA was jostled between foes on the break to trail on the rail into the first turn, shifted outside three wide at the seven eighths pole to watch the lone frontrunner outside down the backstretch, took closer order by the half, chased through the final bend putting pressure on the winner briefly at the quarter pole but was no match in the drive to the wire and finished up a non threatening runner up in the end. MISS OZEGE dueled up top taking advantage on the inside post into the first turn, was throttled down ceding the lead by the three quarters pole, tracked the loose leader while on the fence down the backside, could not keep up to the top pair by the quarter pole, shifted out four wide at the top of the lane starting a mild rally, switched back to the incorrect lead running greenly at the sixteenth pole and finished up to be a clear third when crossing the wire. ANNIA CORNIFICIA F settled on the outside, three wide going into the first turn near the rear, co-trailed outside a challenger down the backstretch, made no progression on rivals through the running around the far turn and failed to menace in the three path in the stretch run. SUPER SERENADE settled close to the back of the pack between rivals in the early going, had company on the outside while trailing down the backside, lost ground to the leaders around the far turn while saving all the ground and had no rally on the fence in the stretch drive.

BLAZING SKY settled at the back of the pack in the early going, could not make up any ground outside the chasing runner through the turn, shifted out three wide having a clear run straightening out for home, was gaining gradually by mid-stretch, switched leads late and found another gear in the final sixteenth to pull away for the late running victory. SUMMER SNOW caught a flyer from the outside post to quickly be on top comfortably just after the gates opened, set a brisk pace wind aided along the backside loose on the lead, opened up through the turn still rattling alone up front on the turn, had control by a good margin at the top of the stretch, still was in front comfortably but was beginning to get leg weary at the furlong pole and folded inside in the final sixteenth to just save for the place share by a nod at the wire. QUIET MADDELENA chased the pacesetter but was well behind down the backstretch, was roused for more but could not narrow the gap on the frontrunner around the oval, angled out two wide inside a rival for the drive and finished up willingly between horses in deep stretch but was on the losing end of a photo for the place share at the finish line.

LADIES RUM set a pokey pace on the rail with a headwind going into the first turn, dictated terms while hounded outside along the backstretch, stubbornly was holding on inside through the far turn, shifted out dueling three wide inside another in upper stretch, drifted out under the drive at the furlong marker but had more late to prevail in the gate to wire front end win. LAUGHING OUT LOUD was moving to the leader outside, three wide around foes in the first turn, shadowed the leader outside down the back straight, bid in the two path between rivals at the quarter pole putting its head in front for a stride or two, shifted to the four path turning for home, angled out further with the winner drifting out slightly in mid-stretch but could not threaten in the late stages for the win. GHOSTLY PERFECTION settled on the inside at the back of the pack, lagged behind rivals midway along the backstretch still in touch with the field, shifted out at the seven sixteenths marker having no room to the inside to offer a rally, picked up the bit smartly going four wide around foes in the final bend, loomed in the six path at the top of the lane, could not sustain the run, shifted inwards at the eighth pole to be three wide between horses and finished up one paced while not beaten all that far for the runners up share in the end. GABBY SQUARED was under a snug hold

tracking the pacesetter in the two path on the initial turn, was in tight quarters leaving the midway point of the first turn having to be snatched up, eased entering the backstretch and left via equine ambulance. GALLEY HEAD broke sharp while on the fence up front in the beginning, was reined back under a snug hold on the rail to sit in midfield at the half, crept up saving ground through the turn, rallied up the fence in upper stretch, had a seam darting inside rivals to bid for the lead at the sixteenth pole and edged away for the win coming up to the finish line. HOME FOR A REST pressed the pace between foes early on, was content to lead the frontrunner go while tracking inside down the backstretch, waited for the cue while inside another behind the embattled duo around the bend, shifted out four wide looming boldly at the furlong marker, poked a nose in front briefly in deep stretch but just missed late with the winner getting through on the inside in the late stages. KATHERINE'S GEM had a stalking trip ahead of a couple of runners along the backside, moved in through the turn to track the contesting pair outside, shifted out four wide in the mix for a share in upper stretch, stayed on the incorrect lead to the wire but still managed to fight on determinedly to capture the show award between rivals at the wire. HARD TO CAPTURE was under a tight hold to co-trail on the fence down the backside, was checked ever so slightly to see the field entering the turn, rallied inside horses at the quarter marker, carried the momentum swinging out six wide gathering more speed in mid-stretch and got up for a minor role at the finish outside. STOLEN rated kindly galloping along outside in mid-pack early on, pulled the rider to the leader by the half, pressed the issue outside by midturn, dueled in the three path outside at the top of the lane, could not fend of closing rivals on both sides late and flattened out with a sixteenth of a mile still to go. ADDENDUM broke in on the start, recovered to have the advantage soon after the break, opened up at the half to be loose up top, had pressure to the outside battling for the front around the bend, was clinging onto the lead inside another while two wide straightening out for the drive, had little left in deep stretch and wilted in the final sixteenth. KAVALA co-trailed on the outside down the back straight, made

little headway throughout the turn, shifted out five wide for the drive but had little to show in the late stages.

JUST MAGNIFICENT was unhurried on the outside close to the back of the pack in the beginning, took closer order by the half, was asked to go with three eighths from the finish, made a strong move sweeping past rivals outside in midturn, shifted three wide with its sights set on the softened up lead twosome by mid-stretch and went right on by on the outside for the win in the final sixteenth of a mile. SPELLCHECK broke out on the start, forced the issue outside in the early stages of the race, determinedly dug in outside still fighting up front two wide at the top of the lane, got the better of the inside speed rival just at the wire but was no match for the winner who had a nice set up in the race and stormed by on the outside in deep stretch. MOBULA had a slim advantage

on the fence after the start, dueled inside while setting a fast pace around the oval, continued to fight on up front inside the pesky other speed rival midway down the lane but faded late losing the nod for the place share just at the wire. ABINO BAY had an inside stalking trip in the third flight while paired up with the eventual winner at the half, had to wait when stuck behind tiring foes at the five sixteenths pole, shifted outside finding a seam at the quarter pole, angled to the four path with clear run and had good late energy to finish up with intent settling on the fringes in the end. DESIGN DIVA trailed the field with company outside down the backstretch, picked up the bit smartly on the fence coming to the quarter pole and had good late interest just off the fence in mid-stretch. BABY LALA was brushed on the outside at the start, settled at the rear with a fellow rival to the inside in the early going, started to commence a mild run three wide with a quarter mile from home, swung out widest in the six path turning for home but could only manage to pass a couple weary foes outside at the furlong marker. PAT'S HOLIDAY settled near the rear on the inside, made little movement through the running around the oval, shifted out to be three wide between foes in upper stretch but failed to fire in the late stages. VRANA (IRE) was brushed inside on the break, recovered to sit outside in the second flight tracking the lead duo along the backside, was urged for more but was going the wrong way between foes in midturn with the winner sweeping past outside at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out to the four path for the drive but had little to give in the final furlong. MISS BOUJEE broke in at the start, had a good trip while settled on the rail watching the lead duo contest up front, was roused to go after the front pair with three eighths to go, offered little response on the turn, retreated inside by the quarter pole and was empty in the two path at the top of the lane.
