THAT GIRL ARTEMUS patiently settled into stride seeing the field down the backstretch, still lagged behind while saving ground around the turn, commenced a good rally on the fence reaching for more ground with three sixteenths from home and burst inside rivals in the final seventy yards in a well timed late charge to get up in the final strides for the win. SO CALLED VACATION had a slim lead on the inside on the first turn, continued up top while hounded outside down the backside, still had control in the two path but by a narrow margin from the pesky outside rival who would not give way throughout, drifted out at the sixteenth pole under left handed encouragement and edged away for the win in deep stretch. AUDAX MINOR prompted the pace on the outside in the first bend, still pressed the frontrunner outside down the back straight, may have poked his head in front for a brief stint at the quarter pole and chased in vain outside while being pushed out by the winner in the final sixteenth. ARRAKASTA IZAN had rail position close to the back of the pack, edged up on the fence by the half, made a smart rally gaining on the inside through the far turn, shifted off the front pair up top to be four wide at the furlong marker but evened out late to be anon threaten third at the wire. MATICULANT settled off the pace near the rail, bided time through the turn, came out a bit leaving that bend then shifted back in to the rail for room, bid up the inside taking the lead about the eighth pole, drew clear. JMR SPEEDY ESCAPE stalked from outside about four wide, was shuffled back a bit in behind a runner leaving the backstretch, continued three to four wide through the turn swinging nine deep into upper stretch, kicked on well to get up for place. SAMMY STONE exchanged a light bump at the start and was in a bit tight, settled in behind runners toward the rear off the rail, moved nearer the inside in upper stretch, rallied near the rail, missed the place. TOURIST'S DREAM broke outwardly a bit exchanging minor contact with a foe, was unhurried and far back, moved out ten wide near mid-stretch advancing, finished well but too late. ROYAL QUALITY was guided forward inside just off the rail chasing in behind, shifted five wide leaving the turn, was carried out a bit in mid-stretch exchanging light contact with the outside foe and altered in at that juncture, kept on for minors. JO DADDY was forwardly-positioned three wide between foes heading up the backstretch, continued to press from outside on the turn in hand, moved willingly to the lead at the top of the stretch still under a hold, was asked past the three-sixteenths as an inside foe came up but lacked the needed late kick. SPARKLET was urged forward from the break and made the lead outside but was short-lived, pressed briefly then dropped back outside three to four wide pursuing from just off the leading pair and still outside, floated seven deep turning for home, was carried out a bit in mid- to late-stretch, lacked the needed rally. QUIET INTENT stalked from between runners in the second flight going into the turn three wide, floated six deep turning for home, was carried out a bit and lightly bumped nearing the sixteenth pole, lacked the needed late kick. UNDER SURVEILLANCE moved forward under some coaxing to soon take the lead, set a pressured pace inside just off the rail, gave way in the stretch.

GOTME GOOD cleared from the outer post to get loose up front on the fence going into the first turn, moved well in hand down the backside, still had no challengers while rolling along comfortably in the far turn and was kept to the task down the lane to hold sway at the finish. CONN SMYTHE (GB) had a tracking position, alone while content on letting the lone speed go into the first turn, edged up a little closer down the backside, moved in for a brief moment posing a threat outside with a quarter mile to go, could not quicken with the winner who had more in reserve by the furlong pole but did show grit inside to fight back to capture the runners up position in deep stretch. STRATUS travelled three wide in midfield, closed the gap on the leader while three deep outside down the back straight, rallied three wide midway on the last turn, angled out in the five path full of run late and closed in sharply to just miss second money in a photo at the finish. SIGNATURE SIR had a good position on the rail watching the front two runners for the first part of the race, narrowed the margin shifting out by the quarter pole, was in the mix three wide between foes turning for home, could not get to the winner with a furlong remaining, faded in the two path with rivals on both sides closing with a sixteenth to go and settled for a minor role in the end. WILD CARD had rail position near the rear in the beginning, could see the field along the backside, offered a mild rally splitting horses at the quarter pole and in the two path, finished with interest between rivals in the final eighth of a mile. CAPTIVATING NAME was under a snug hold in midfield in the early going, ranged up in the two path with horses on each side at the half, kept pace with others through the last bend while scrubbed on between foes, shifted out four wide having a chance for a piece of

the prize in upper stretch but flattened out late between horses. PROCEEDWITHCAUTION was close to the back of the pack having challengers on either side in the early parts, shifted just off the fence but could not advance running around the final bend, shifted back inwards to the rail for the stretch run but made little impression driving to the wire. HIGHLAND PEAK had a poor start when tossing its head on the break, settled at the back going four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep outside ahead of one runner along the backside, could not get into gear when asked for more run three wide through the far turn and was empty in the four path turning for home.

LOIS LEN bumped with a rival at the start, soon made the lead moving through inside, set the pace shadowed by a foe, edged clear late on the turn, drew off when roused in upper- to mid-stretch, held sway. CEFALO began to advance late up the backstretch racing outside foes, went four to five wide, was no match for the winner but secured the place. EMERALD LAKE settled off the pace near but off the rail, began moving out late on the turn, was guided out six wide turning for home, ran on outside but needed more to get second. FOREST VIXEN was bumped hard between runners at the start, brought up the rear inside, moved out for room past the furlong marker, ran on mildly. MI TORMENTA stalked the leading pair in behind from off the rail, lacked the needed late kick. ALBERTA BE MINE bumped with a rival at the start, moved up a bit outside a rival into the turn, fanned seven wide into upper stretch, ran on without threatening. OLD SECRETS chased in behind, was encouraged along between runners coming to the five-sixteenths, failed to rally. ROYAL BLUSH got away well with a brief early lead, continued to press outside the eventual winner, was asked for more coming past the quarter pole and drifted out a bit turning for home, faltered and faded.

SECRET STORM had a good spot drafting behind the pacesetter down the backside, continued to be nestled on the fence waiting for the cue to move through the turn, shifted out off the freewheeling frontrunner three wide in upper stretch and with relentless pursuit wore the leader in the shadow of the wire for the win. FRAC RIGHT was going comfortably up top with only mild pressure to its outside along the backstretch, dictated the pace inside with a rival trying to keep up through the turn, spurted away still quite in control at the top of the lane, remained in charge with a furlong to go inside but could not stave off the tenacious winner in deep stretch and was caught just before the finish line. CATHOLIC JACKIE had a stalking trip ahead of one runner along the back straight, travelled outside in the third flight tracking through the turn, swung out widest in the seven path for the long drive, was no match for the lead pair who had it to themselves but kept on trying to the finish line and got up right at the wire to capture third money outside. SUGAR IT'S ELI was away a step slow to begin, settled in mid-division between horses, had an inside trip in the third tier around the bend, rallied up the fence dueling for a piece of the prize in upper stretch, could not go with the front duo by the furlong pole and weakened late, nabbed right at the wire to settle on the fringes in the end. MIDNIGHT TEMPESTA was void of early speed trailing down the backside, co-trailed with an inside rival around the bend, shifted out five wide with a

quarter mile to run and could only manage to pass some weary rivals outside down the lane. PASSTHEPUDDINPLEAZ had a slow start to begin, moved up quickly five deep down the back straight, watched the lead duo while outside the eventual winner midway around the turn, shifted to the five path straightening for home, dueled for a minor placing in mid-stretch but gave way in the final seventy yards. SNOOKERED had a trail trip in mid-pack down the backstretch, was throttled down slightly on the fence at the half, co-trailed inside at the top of the lane and could not play a factor inside runners in the stretch drive. GUARD OF HONOUR prompted the pace on the outside, continue to flank the leader outside while being scrubbed on to keep up through the turn, angled to the four path between foes for the stretch drive between rivals but had little left and folded by the furlong marker.

PENNER ASH (IRE) was nestled on the rail keeping a close eye on the leader in the early parts of the race, began to inch up on the fence by the quarter pole, shifted out three wide making a bid with a furlong from home, grinded away at the frontrunner in deep stretch and got up late for the win in the final few strides. KING ELVIS was loose on the lead on the first of two turns, relaxed the tempo down slightly up front down the backside, was still in command

slowing the third split down again on the last turn, began to get leg weary with a furlong remaining clinging onto the lead on the fence but was caught late in a soft time for the stretch run albeit into a headwind. PALACE VIEW (IRE) had an inside position in mid-pack, settled on the rail in the third flight through the backside with the field strung out, kept pace saving ground around the final bend, shifted just off the rail in the two path closing in for the stretch drive and finished up willingly between foes to just miss out on getting up at the wire for the place share. BEDAZZLE ME tracked between foes in the two path while watching the lone speed in the first turn, settled into stride on the outside in the third tier along the backside, made a mild run three wide at the quarter pole to have a chance for a share in the five path turning for home and gradually battled on outside in deep stretch for a minor role at the finish line. KEKOA tracked the pacesetter going three wide outside two others on the first bend, chased the leader outside along the backstretch, came under a ride but could not gain on the frontrunner with a quarter mile to go, angled four wide in the hunt at the top of the stretch but could only finish up one paced with others on either side and faded in the final seventy yards. CABERNAYDO had an outside trip in mid-pack in the beginning, dropped back a position down the backside, offered no response to the riders urging just off the fence through the far turn and in the three path could not get into contention in the late stages. MOTION GRANTED stalked four wide going into the initial turn, was ahead of only one rival in the run down the backstretch, made a mild run outside three wide passing a runner on the final bend and in the four path showed little in the drive to the wire. PROUD RONIN was at the rear travelling three wide around the first turn, lagged behind the group along the backside, took the short way around the final oval and could only manage to pass a straggler while running
