PAGEANT QUEEN battled outside, three deep for the lead at the start, was nudged along to clear to the fence up top by the half, was collared outside at the quarter pole relinquishing the lead for a stride or two, rebid in the two path in upper stretch and pulled away by the furlong marker to hold safely for the win at the finish line. MISS MAXINE was hard held between horses in the early going vying up top, opted on letting the outside runner get a clear lead with a half mile to go, tracked on the fence in the second flight waiting for the cue to move through the turn, angled out four wide for the stretch drive and tried to close on the winner but could not get there in time while comfortably besting the rest at the wire for the runners up share. SOUPER SPORTY broke a step slow to be at the rear on the rail in the beginning, shifted out to the two path shortly after, making a quick move into contention by the half, moved in outside around the bend, brief poked its head in front leaving the quarter pole, shifted to the three path dueling up top in upper stretch but faded between rivals in the late running to just miss out holding on for the place share. CLASSIC DISCOVERY was void of early speed to trail the field down the back straight, rallied inside horses at the three furlong marker with a sharp turn of foot, skimmed the fence turning for home and finished up with good energy but was on the losing end of the three way photo for place. WOLFBERRY was antsy in stall before the break, settled between runners in the three path in the early going, improved position going into the bend to sit in a good spot outside watching the engaged duo through the turn, shifted out five wide in the mix for a share at the top of the lane but could only finish up evenly to the wire. NAZE had a stalking role outside while going four deep down the backstretch, made no progression travelling three wide outside foes around the bend and could not find more in the stretch while in the two path trying to get into contention in the late stages of the race. MATHEMATICAL broke sharp, then, was in tight on the fence under steady restraint down the backstretch to be in midfield inside by the half, was at the back group between foes through the turn and could not offer a finish on the fence in the stretch running.

LEONA WHITEBLAZE bobbled on the break to settle in midfield inside along the backside, was forced to move by the inside rival who was commencing a run in midturn, shifted out five wide in the hunt outside straightening for home, was persistent down the lane and began to edge away late for the victory. ANELA KAI stalked near the rear early on, was ridden to maintain position at the half, improved under a vigorous ride in midturn on the fence, shifted out three wide at the quarter pole, pushed her way through four wide making room in upper stretch, ran on gamely to the finish line but was just outkicked late for the win. KEE'S FLATTER was bumped inside to trail at the break, was urged early in the backstretch to get into the race, picked up the bit but had to be throttled down coming up quickly on horses by the half, stalked in last through the turn, made a sharp move at the quarter pole but had no seam when angling out four wide at the top of the lane, shifted back to the two path in mid-stretch and finished up strongly to be a clear but troubled third at the wire. DIRTYLITTLESECRET veered out on the start, pressed the issue outside early down the backstretch, took back when reined in to have a good spot isolated watching the engaged duo at the half mile pole, moved in on the turn to bid three wide with two furlongs still to run, had the lead momentarily in mid-stretch between rivals but faded in the final seventy yards to garner a minor role in the end. GIRL'S NITE OUT vied between horses down the backstretch, shook off the early inside pesky speed foe by the quarter pole, braced for the new challenger outside in upper stretch, had little left with a furlong to go and



flattened out in the late stages inside runners. EM CHAMAS had an outside trip in mid-division down the backside, regressed while going three to five wide throughout the turn and while in the five path lacked a rally in the stretch running. LA BELVA dueled inside in the early stages, was engulfed by the outside flow of rivals making a move at the quarter pole, offered no resistance and emptied out on the fence at the top of the lane.

BOLD RIPASSO broke a step slow on the break to trail on the first turn, ranged up smartly three deep down the backside, lost momentum for a stride or two leaving the half mile marker, advanced three wide moving strong around the last bend to be in the thick of things in the four path turning for home and determinedly wore down the inside rivals to get up just before the finish line for the hard fought win. KEYTOTHEPARK was in hand quite content to watch the loose frontrunner in the early stages, cruised past taking command outside at the three-furlong pole, burst clear opening up in the two path at the top of the stretch, drifted out under left-handed encouragement clinging to the front in the final sixteenth but lost the nod at the wire by the late running winner. TOP OF D MOUNTAIN stalked close to the back on the inside, co-trailed on the fence midway down the backside, kept pace with the leaders midway around the final bend, shifted off the rail with a quarter mile from home starting to uncork a rally and was surging late while in the five path down the lane, got up for the show award in deep stretch but could not get to the lead pair in time. SERENADING KITTEN rated kindly while all alone keeping a close eye on the lead two on the first turn, inched up two path while going with the eventual winner who was on the outside around the far turn, shifted three wide fighting stubbornly between horses in upper stretch, was in tight battling tooth and nail for the lead in the late stages and had to be checked nearing the wire to settle on the firinges in the end. WHAT A COMPLEX travelled in mid-division on the outside, dropped back slightly to co-trail with rivals on either side at the half, made little headway on the far turn, shifted out six wide for the drive but could not factor driving to the wire. JUST LIKE THAT assumed command inside rivals in the first of two turns, continued up top setting an even pace down the backside, was collared having no answer for the outside foe at the three eighths pole and folded

STERLING HEIGHTS was in a bit tight on heels up the backstretch, switched out at that point, stalked mid-division, waited briefly past the five-sixteenths, came out five wide in upper stretch, bid near the eighth pole, took command and kept on to hold. GATHER unhurriedly brought up the rear, swung eight to nine wide into upper stretch under urging, gained steadily but missed while clearly second best. WORLD SHOWCASE was quick to take the lead, set the pace in the clear from off the rail, asked for run coming to the top of the stretch, had no extra late. KID GIZMO stalked outside just off the leader, went three to four wide through the turn, came wider for the stretch run, needed more. LUPA (IRE) had rail position sitting just behind the pacesetter in the initial turn, rated kindly while settling into a good rhythm down the backside measuring the frontrunner, inched up in the two path on the final turn and when set down in mid-stretch burst up the fence late to win going away at the wire. LADY IONA was loose on the lead in the first of two turns, rolled along smoothly up top with no opposition down the backside, was let out a notch to open up going around the second turn but could not find another gear late to fend off the winner inside in deep stretch. NORTH YORK was in the third tier outside of runners, kept pace with the leaders while asked for more run through the far bend, shifted to the four path turning for home, could not get to the front two who had it to themselves in the late running but did rally sharply in the last sixteenth to just get up for the show award. ONEHOTMESS was brushed outside at the start, tracked in the second flight on the first turn, had a good spot watching the front two down the backside, made a mild move on the fence at the quarter pole, was closing in gradually on the lead duo down the lane but was passed outside late being nabbed for the third money. D'AURUM settled close to the back on the rail, inched up inside runners along the backside, was roused between foes midway around the last turn making a smart move, shifted



gathering some momentum five wide straightening for home and showed some mild energy passing tired rivals. STARSHIP SERENITY stalked near the rear just off the fence, made no progression along the backside, hugged the rail closing the gap in the last bend, shifted three wide between horses weaving through rivals down the lane and finished up with good late interest on the fence coming to the wire. BERTHA was brushed inside on the start, had a tracking role three wide on the outside in the early parts of the race, could no gain on the leader when scrubbed for more at the three furlong pole, began to drop back outside rivals in the far turn and wilted between horses in the two path in the final furlong. SERIOUS LADY travelled in mid-pack in the beginning, made little improvement along the backside, came under a ride but was dropping back in the three path on the final bend and could only pass a tired one in the late running. MOMANDA was fractious prior to the start, settled inside in the third tier in the early running, made a brief move skimming the fence from the quarter pole to upper stretch but could not continue on and weakened at the eighth pole. CANDY LASSIE travelled three wide near the rear, improved three deep along the backside, retreated with moving three to four wide around the last turn and showed little in the stretch drive. LEMON SWEETS trailed on the rail in the early stages, lost touch with the field by the three-furlong pole, cantered down the lane crossing the wire and walked off.

LOVE CERVERE was in the four path, part of the group of five runners keeping an eye on the frontrunner in the early going, separated from the pack to be alone, poised to move in at any time around the turn, pounced three wide in upper stretch seizing command at the eighth pole and won going away at the finish line with an impressive late turn of foot. IT AIN'T TWO (GB) was checked at the eleven sixteenths pole when part of the fivesome tracking the leader down the backside, dropped back slightly more on the turn while saving ground on the fence, had to wait behind a rival briefly at the three furlong pole, angled five wide at the top of the lane having a clear run and chased the winner home, easily besting the rest for the runners up share. FLAUNT pulled the rider to an easy lead down the back straight, cruised along unopposed around the turn, shifted just off the fence in control turning for home, was no match for the for the winner who swept past at the furlong marker and faded in the final sixteenth but did fight on late to save the show award at the wire. PERSONIFY was tucked in on the fence not far off the pacesetter down the back straight, had the rail when being nudged to go after the lead two around the bend, battled for a piece of the prize on the fence in upper stretch and finished up mildly between foes late trying to get up for third money at the wire.



SOCIAL CODE co-trailed on the inside of another down the backstretch, closed the gap moving three off the fence in the turn, shifted out in the five path with a quarter mile to run and finished up willingly between challengers dueling for a minor placing. AMERICAN WOMEN tried to maintain forward position in the two path while chasing the leader down the backstretch, had to be checked out in tight between foes at the nine sixteenths pole to sit in midfield into the turn, re-ralled splitting horses at the half to be up in the mix four wide straightening out for the drive but had little left in the lane and yielded with rivals on each side at the furlong pole. BOUND TO BE TRUE was at the back of the pack three deep with an inside foe while going down the backside, could not gain position but narrowed the gap on the leaders moving in four wide around the oval, swung out widest in the eight-path turning for home but failed to fire in the stretch running. ARCTIC VELOCITY was five deep on the outside in the second flight watching the pacester along the backside, travelled four wide on the outside while trying to hold position in mid-pack throughout the turn, shifted out to the seven path for the drive to the wire but faltered in upper stretch. WYOMING BILL was in a hair tight in the early going, eased back and shifted in racing three wide between foes on the first turn, continued unhurriedly into the far turn off the fence, swung out eight wide coming into upper stretch, rallied outside and surged late to get up. SIDE STREET tracked from inside, was given some encouragement three furlongs out, angled seven wide in upper stretch, rallied between runners late but was outfinished. HAMMERHEAD tucked





in to the two path settling mid-pack, moved swiftly between foes about the seven-sixteenths, was guided out three then four wide midway on the far turn, struck the lead at the top of the stretch and soon moved clear, was outfinished but best of the rest. CAPTAIN JUNUH tucked in settled toward the back two to three wide early, rallied inside foes in the stretch splitting rivals to get up and round out the super late. CALL ME SUE moved clear and shifted in, set the pace racing just off the rail, was overtaken at the top of the stretch, continued to chase from inside in pursuit then weakened late. CONNOR hopped at the start, stalked the pacesetter from outside, lacked the needed late kick and was even late. WESTSIDE TIDE was taken back to be reserved at the rear settling near the inside into the first turn, was forced outside foes on the far turn picking up speed while fanning eleven to twelve wide coming into upper stretch and widest of all, gained mildly outside. CITY OF OSCARS settled outside four to five wide early, came out eleven wide for the stretch run, went evenly. THUNDERING was forced wide outside runners five deep in the early going, made a mild early advance up the backstretch shifting in chasing four wide on the far turn and within range, came out nine deep in upper stretch and weakened. SOUTHERN STYLE settled toward the back, saved ground near the inside, failed to rally. GOOD KING SAM was forwardly-placed in pursuit outside the second flight four to five wide, dropped back steadily on the far turn, was a bit tight steadying slightly at that point, was under a hold stalking in behind three to four wide, was asked for more early on the far turn, dropped back late on that bend, came out six to seven wide in upper stretch and faded.

INNISFREE ISLE travelled with runners on each side while three wide in the initial bend, crept closer to the lead group between foes two wide along the backside, made a good rally on the fence in the far turn at the quarter pole, "slingshotted" to the outside gathering more speed four wide turning for home, grinded away while on the incorrect lead coming to the leader in mid-stretch, switched leads with seventy yards to go and was opening up at the wire for the win. WORKOUT AFFAIR tracked just outside early on, travelled smoothly taking aim just behind the pacesetter down the backside, edged up on the outside in the far turn to take over control three wide between foes at the top of the lane, ran on well to the end but could not repel the late charge by the winner in deep stretch. HANDSINTHEAIR broke in at the start filling the void from the slow starter, settled in mid-division four wide on the first bend, moved up smartly while in hand three deep outside down the back straight, was roused to go after the top pair at the three eighths pole, shifted out in the five path for the drive, still could not continue on with the lead pair in upper stretch but did finish up well enough to catch the early leader who was fading late for third place in the final seventy yards. EARENDEL battled outside for the early lead, angled in opening up midway of the first turn to be loose up top along the backside, had company come to her outside at the quarter marker, dug in until the furlong pole inside runners but had nothing left late and faded on the rail in deep stretch holding for a minor share. R CANADIAN APPLE leapt up at the start to be ahead of only the other poor starter in the early stages, edged up between horses under a snug hold in the two path at the half, advanced mildly three wide between rivals on the final turn but was one paced in the four path to the finish line. BELLA CLASSICA broke in the air to trail the field in the early going, caught up to runners going four deep outside by the half, moved five wide in the second turn while urged right handed but could not make any progression taking the overland route but never gave in and kept trying to the finish gradually gaining on fellow rivals to the wire. BEACH CRICKET had a rail spot in mid-division, , backed away to see the field at the half, had no rally going three wide on the far turn and could only manage tp pass a couple of tired runners in the lane. SHE'S PRETTY contested the pace on the rail in the beginning, had to be checked on the fence when having trouble navigating the first turn, recouped to track on the fence sitting just behind the pacesetter down the backside, was roused but offered no response when backing away at the three eighths marker and had little to give just off the rail in the stretch run. DIXIE IS A BREEZE was in the two path near the rear between foes, still remained close to the back of the pack three deep midway down the backside, was hard ridden three wide going in the wrong direction with five sixteenths from home and made little impression shifting out five wide coming up empty in the stretch drive.

RON'S GIZMO tracked from inside, moved off the rail on the far turn, shifted five wide in upper stretch, set down for the drive, struck the lead late and just held from a fast-closing. FROSTED OVER, who settled at the rear near the inside, crept closer on the far turn beginning to move out, angled seven wide at the top of the stretch bumping a rival in the process while seeking room, finished strongly outside but missed. PARAMOUNT PRINCE settled off the loose leader shifting in nearer the rail, began advancing willing on the far turn now off the rail, came into upper stretch four wide and took the lead, was just clear in mid-stretch, led till inside the sixteenth pole but was outkicked. MCAVOY settled outside about mid-pack three to four wide through both turns advancing with runners on the far turn while fanning six wide into upper stretch, ran on mildly outside for the minor award. TOSEN WISH (IRE) shifted in early, saved ground toward the back, rode the rail into the stretch, rallied mildly but not enough. MALIBU MAMBO settled outside a foe toward the rear, began fanning



out while leaving the far turn beginning to advance, was bumped at the top of the stretch, raced nine wide after and lacked the needed late kick. PIERRE was in the third flight relaxing between rivals down the backside, pulled the rider closer to the lead at the half, moved quickly to the leader when releasing the brakes at the three furlong pole, dueled outside from the quarter pole to the wire and finally got the better of a stubbornly inside rival in deep stretch staying persistent to inch away for the win at the finish line. UNBRIDLED WEATHER was forced in by the outside foe on the break, set the pace just off the rail in the first turn, continued up top down the backside, was headed outside by the eventual winner at the five sixteenths pole, slugged it out never giving way inside through mid-stretch, edged away actually at the sixteenth pole but was denied in the late stages when the winner came back on for the win in the final few jumps. HUMBER RIVER travelled three deep on the outside in mid-pack, started to make a move ranging up four wide on the outside with three eighths to go, took closer order through the final turn, drifted out slightly five wide turning for home, continued to wander out under left handed asking at the eighth pole impeding the outside rivals and still willingly kept on closing on the leaders late but had to settle for the show money in the end. MALDINI broke out to start, was taken a hold off when coming up on runners at the back of the pack into the first turn, co-trailed on the inside down the backstretch, started to mount a rally going with an outside rival at the three furlong pole, angled out widest in the seven path turning for home having a clear lane, had to be checked at the furlong pole, still found his best stride late down the stretch and closed in well to be a fringe player at the finish line. BOWMAN'S RUN broke in at the start, stalked near the rear in the beginning, closed the gap along the backside between foes, just started to commence a rally like many rivals were doing at the three eighths pole between horses in the three path but was in tight clipping heels on the far turn, resurged when darting in from the five path in upper stretch to be three wide at the furlong pole but could not continue the run and stalled between runners in the final seventy vards. LONNY'S GAMBLE settled on the rail in midfield for the early part of this route race, had no room trying to skim the fence at the three furlong pole attempting to make a move, had to be checked inside, briefly backed away on the far turn, shifted out five wide but could not find a seam in upper stretch, shifted to the four path at the furlong marker having a clear run but could only finish up mildly between horses in deep stretch. ADAPTED was in a good spot on the outside under a snug hold watching the frontrunner, could not quicken with the winner at the three eighths pole who was circling around rivals, tried to fight back inside around the last turn but had little left for the stretch run and faltered on the rail in the last sixteenth of a mile. DADDY HAS DIAMONDS was squeezed on the break to co-trail outside going four wide on the first turn, started to make a sharp move circling outside three wide at the three eighths pole, shifted out in the six path in the mix for a share at the top of the lane, had to be steadied when the inside runner drifted out at the furlong pole losing all his momentum and could not recover to factor in the late stages. COMMANDER WORSLEY drafted behind the pacesetter in the early parts of the race, was scrubbed on to keep position inside at the three eighths pole but was overtaken by outside runners commencing a run through the turn and lacked a rally inside in the two path down the stretch.
