JUPITER settled into a good stride soon after the break advanced easily three deep down the back straight to prompt the issue well in hand at the half, cruised around the turn in tandem with the inside runner up top while the rider never moved a muscle and opened up at will under only mild urging at the eighth pole and won going away when crossing the finish line. INSTANT RESPONSE broke sharp having an uncontested lead down the backside early on, dug in through the turn still holding a slim lead on the outside rival, was no match for the outside winner who had plenty for the drive at the furlong pole but did finish up determinedly to be an easy second best on this day. AWESOME CONNECTION was four deep watching the lead trio on the start, took closer order down the backside, watched the front pair up top while driven outside trying to close in through the turn, could not threaten the lead duo in upper stretch but did finish up well enough to be a clear third at the wire. DWIGHT was in the mix for the lead between foes on the break, had a good spot on the inside tracking the contesting duo around the turn, could not quicken with the outside rival fighting for the show award in mid-stretch and settled on the fringes in the end. FOG D'ORO was void of early speed while five deep after the start, could see the field down the backside, offered a mild run passing inside runners at the quarter pole but could not be a factor on the leaders in the stretch running. NOBURU had an outside stalking position in the third pairing in the beginning, made little headway coming under a hard ride through the turn, shifted between foes in the two path in upper stretch but had little offer in the late stages. DIGITAL SECURITY vied up top on the break, shied from the rail soon after the start, dropped back inside runners through the running down the back straight, could not get into gear on the rail around the bend and was empty in the stretch drive.

AGILE DANCER had a stalking role near the rear outside, co-trailed with an inside rival into the turn, began to range forward in the two path around the oval, angled out slightly in the three path for the drive to the wire, shifted out further being six wide having a clear lane at the three sixteenths pole and with a strong late surge drew off in deep stretch for the win. DOADSTER had an ideal spot alone watching the engaged duo down the backside, edged up on the turn with three furlongs from home, shifted out to bid five wide at the top of the lane, seized command at the eighth pole but could not fend off the late surge by the winner outside and was a good second at the finish line. FIELD HOCKEY pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch, chased the loose frontrunner throughout the turn, was in the hunt four wide between foes in upper stretch, faded at the eighth pole but found more late to come back on again to capture third money in the end. SOL DE VERANO had an inside trip running in mid-pack, narrowed the margin on the fence by the three eighths marker, angled to the three path turning for home looking for a seam, moved to the rail at the furlong pole, dueled for third money but was in tight in the late running and had to settle for a minor placing at the finish. CHAIRMAN RAINBOW had the lead on the rail down the backside, continued to roll along unopposed on the turn, shifted just off the fence at the quarter pole straightening out for the drive, was collared outside by mid-stretch and wilted with rivals on both sides in the last furlong. MOST LIKELY settled on the outside in mid-pack in the early stages, made little impression outside through the turn, swung out widest in the seven path for the long stretch drive but had nothing to offer in the stretch running. DADDY SEND MONEY was squeezed on the break to trail in the beginning, co-trailed on the inside going into the turn, rider lost its irons at the half, was then eased through the turn and walked off.

TWOWAYCROSSING had a good trip rating kindly on the outside in the second flight, inched up on the contesting pair up front down the backside, started to uncork his rally midway on the final bend, shifted out four wide gaining steadily on the embattled duo down the lane and under a well timed move got up just before the finish for the win. JOURNEYMAN tracked outside on the first turn, moved in to prompt the issue outside with five furlongs from home, battled tenaciously outside around the far turn, doggedly kept on coming while between foes in the three path down the entire stretch and held for the place share in a photo at the wire. SPECIAL SESSION was in the middle of the pack going around foes four wide through the first turn, smartly advanced four deep along the backside, travelled confidently three wide on the final bend circling foes, pounced in the four path at the top of the lane and drew away with authority in the closing stages. TRIP ACES was hustled early getting an easy lead around the initial turn, slowed the pace down slightly down the backside still in control, continued up top but was nudged for more at the five sixteenths pole hearing the stablemate closing in outside, offered little resistance in the three path inside when the winner pounced at the eighth pole and was kept to the task in deep stretch to just save for the place share from a fast charging rival at the wire. BOREALIS TRAIL settled in midfield in the three path in the beginning, moved up positions inside runners at the half, waited to move at the three furlong pole behind a trio of chasing horses, shifted outside at the quarter pole gathering momentum, angled five wide in upper stretch and had a good late kick, closing in late to almost get the runners up share at the finish line. COPPER GHOST was off a touch slow from the inside stall at the start, watched the front pair while nestled on the fence on the first turn and through the backside, took closer order on the rail in the second flight at the three furlong pole, was asked for more run at the quarter pole, skimmed the fence to be in the mix turning for home but evened out for a minor role at the wire. SPIRITUAL MAN was under a snug hold, content to let the lone speed go in the beginning, tracked the pacesetter down the backstretch, was scrubbed for more but could not keep up with rivals at the three eighths pole and yielded between horses four wide at the furlong marker. NAUGHTY FROSTY travelled four wide on the first turn to sit in midfield along the backside, was asked to pick up the pace but had little response at the three furlong marker, backed away through the far turn and made little presence in the stretch running. ROYAL ENTRY broke in, stumbling badly to his knees on the start, trailed in the early stages, caught up to

rivals outside at the half, ran on mildly three wide on the last turn and still in the three path had no finish to offer in the stretch drive. SOUPER EFFECT stalked near the rear just off the rail, co-trailed inside at the half, had a small spurt of energy passing a rival at the five sixteenths pole and made little impression driving to the wire.

SIMCOE battled determinedly on the rail down the back straight with an outside opening on the other rivals in the race, slugged it out on the fence under a faster quarter around the bend, drifted out slightly when urged by a left handed crop a sixteenth from home, was quickly gathered up and under a vigorous ride, resurged late to prevail in a gallant stretch drive. WAR STRATEGY hooked up right from the get-go to duel outside for the front end setting a brisk pace along the backside, had a head advantage outside while quickening the tempo around the turn, shifted to the three path between rivals fighting down the lane, was brushed by the winner inside while driving to the finish line around the sixteenth pole and tenaciously fought to the wire, capturing the place share but nosed out at the wire. SWIFT DELIVERY was under a snug hold going three wide in midfield in the first turn, edged up moving confidently three wide down the backside outside runners, was poised moving to the leader three wide on the far turn and while shifting out to the five path showed his dominance to win going away in the stretch running in the final furlong. LAC MACAZA was nestled on the rail watching the lead duo, waited to move on the fence behind runners around the last bend, skimmed the rail having a seam in upper stretch and with a good effort finished up second best. COOL KISS settled in mid-division in the early parts of the race, started to get into gear with five sixteenths from home, angled out to the six path between horses in the stretch drive and was full of run late to close in smartly for the show money. LAST DAWN had the lead while hounded outside on the first turn, maintained a slim advantage down the backside, still as up top in the two path clinging onto the lead in upper stretch, was no match for the top pair by the furlong pole and just missed staying on for the show award in the late stages. ROSCAR was in the second flight on the outside tracking the lead pair, was nudged for more midway around the final bend but could not gain on the leaders, shifted out to the four path but could only finish up mildly to the wire. LEGAL CATCH co-trailed on the outside at the half, made little movement going three wide on the far turn, swung out widest in the eight path at the top of the stretch but had little finish down the lane. CAN GROUP was unhurried at the rear to begin, made little progression on the backside co-trailing inside at the half, saved ground running around the final bend, wandered out slightly in upper stretch inside horses and passed tired rivals driving to the wire. MIDNIGHT MASCOT settled in midfield for the early going, offered a mild run to narrow the margin three wide outside midway around the last turn, angled in the seven path between rivals turning for home but failed to fire down the lane.
