RED PHARAOH was content isolated tracking the lone speed down the back straight, began to edge up on the frontrunner in the two path at the quarter pole, shifted three wide closing in smartly in mid-stretch and pulled away for the win in the final sixteenth. ISAAC LEO assumed command while in hand setting the pace along the backside, moved well, rolling along unopposed through the turn, still remained in front on the fence holding off rivals in upper stretch, had no answer when the winner swept past at the sixteenth pole but finished up well enough to easily best the rest at the wire. AUDI'S WORLD stalked near the rear in the early going, moved closer for better position outside four deep at the half, continued to narrow the margin on the leader while travelling three wide around the oval, angled out four wide turning for home and finished up mildly outside to capture the show award in deep stretch. SOMEKINDA MISCHIEF had inside position settling in mid-pack down the back straight, took closer order to sit on the rail in the second flight watching the pacesetter at the three eighths pole, came under a ride with two furlongs to go but could not keep up to the lead pair at the top of the lane and ran on evenly to the wire in the two path inside a rival to settle for a minor role. PROFESSOR RELOAD veered out to trail on the start, moved to the fence down the backside, caught up to rivals inside at the half, was roused for more on the bend but could not make any headway and was not a factor running on the rail down the lane. DEMBA was bumped on the inside on the break, recovered to sit in the second flight with runners on each side tracking the contesting duo by the half, was poised waiting to move while watching the embattled pair around the bend, pounced four wide at the top of the stretch and drew away for the win in the final sixteenth. KAIROS MOMENT had a slow start to begin, settled near the rear between foes with a half mile remaining, started to mount a rally inside when scrubbed on in midturn, angled out to the three path straightening for home, quickly darted back to the fence having a lane at the furlong marker and with a late rail surge got up to be second best just before the finish line. WAHEELA chased the pace going three to four deep down the back straight, poked its head in front on the outside four furlongs from the wire, battled outside up front around the oval, dug in, when in the thick of things between runners in the two path at the top of the stretch, could not go with the winner at the furlong marker but finished up with a game effort just missing holding for the place share at the finish line. GLINTINDADDYSEYE broke out on the start, settled on the rail in mid-division along the backside, was hard ridden holding position behind the front trio throughout the turn, shifted out four wide by mid-stretch and finished up mildly late trying to get up for the show award late. GLORIOUS

REVENGE broke sharp for the early lead, had company on the outside down the backstretch, dueled stubbornly on the rail around the entire turn, kept fighting on the fence up top in upper stretch but had little left late and wilted in the two path in the last sixteenth of a mile. LAST RIDE had a stalking role while deepest in the six path down the backstretch early on, settled in mid-pack outside heading into the turn, made a brief move three wide with five sixteenths closing the gap on the leaders, shifted out five wide for the drive to the wire, did not switch leads until in the late stages of the race but could not get involved at the finish line. WESTMORE had the rail while sitting in the middle of the pack in the early going, could not hold rail position when the outside rivals starting to angle inwards down the backstretch, was checked at the five eighths pole, made little progression seeing the field around the turn and managed to pass inside tiring rivals midway down the stretch. BRITISH SEA was in the second tier on the outside watching the lead two at the half, while still having runners on both sides retreated between horses in the two path throughout the turn and showed little while five wide down the lane. BAPTIST BILLY was unhurried on the outside trailing at the start, tried to offer some sort of rally while going three wide at the three eighths pole but to no avail, swung out widest in the seven path for the drive but had nothing to offer in the stretch run.

AMI'S GIRL tossed her head breaking out on the start, was hard held on the rail quite headstrong trailing the field into the first turn, settled down gathering herself smartly getting into stride down the backstretch, had a good position liking the three horse battle for the lead while drafting behind the rivals around the last turn, shifted out in finding a seam in the two path turning for home and with the rider statuesque in mid-stretch bearing down the leader edged away under a hand ride for the victory. REGAL MOMENT broke inwards on the start, used the rail advantage to assume command going into the first of two turns, slackened the tempo while hounded outside by a rival midway down the backstretch, continued up top but by a slim advantage with now two rivals pressing the issue outside through the last turn, under a well rated ride spurted away from the outside challengers in upper stretch, braced for the winner outside at the furlong pole but could not repel that foe late who had an ideal trip through the race. NIKITA'S GEM was content to just sit off the pacesetter going into the first turn, moved in turning up the pressure outside down the backstretch, vied between runners under a ride at the three eighths pole up front, still was in the mix up top in the three path outside foes in upper stretch but had little left for the drive and faded at the eighth pole to be a clear third at the finish line. EXECUTIVE SEARCH came in at the start but was quick to make the lead, set the pace from just off the rail and shadowed by outside foes, edged clear turning into upper stretch, held sway despite drifting out late. MIDNIGHT ARKLE settled off the pace inside, was a bit tentative with an opening along the rail at the three-eighths, was encouraged by the five-sixteenths moving through inside, tapped on the brakes just slightly at the quarter pole, came out three wide at the top of the stretch with room between, ran on and just got the nod for place. ENGLISH ACTOR was allowed to travel five wide heading into the first turn, measured the leader while three deep into the backstretch closing in by the half, crept closer still three wide outside foes in the last bend, posed the main threat between rivals turning for home and grinded away under a left-handed crop to edge clear foe the win in deep stretch. HIGHLY POTENT co-trailed on the inside in the early stages, started to rally on the fence kicking away from a runner at the three eighths pole, shifted outside gathering speed midway on the final turn, angled to the five-path finding his best stride down the lane and closed in smartly to just nab the runners up share at the finish line. RIDEAU HALL flanked the frontrunner on the outside into the first bend, continued outside prompting the pace down the back straight, seized command with three furlongs to go in the two path, was collared outside by the winner in upper stretch, retaliated until the furlong pole but weakened inside late and gave way in deep stretch to just miss saving for the place share at the wire. SWIFTLET was nestled on the fence behind the early leader, settled in midfield inside the eventual winner at the half, edged up in the two path between foes with five sixteenths from home, shifted out four wide in the mix between rivals at the top of the lane but evened out in the final furlong to settle on the fringes in the end. NYCELY had the lead on the fence taking advantage of the inside position into the first turn, had a slim lead slowing the tempo down while hounded outside down the backside, gave way on the fence up top at the three eighths pole, was checked while regressing inside midway around the last bend and emptied out turning for home. ARTIFRAC broke a touch slow between foes on the start, was checked slightly going into the first turn while outside another in the back pair into the first turn, co-trailed on the outside along the backstretch, could not keep up to rivals at the three furlong marker and had nothing to give in the stretch running.

HANLAN was forwardly placed on the outside at the start, contently sat just off the pace on the outside down the backstretch, moved in outside around the turn to force the issue at the quarter pole, battled determinedly outside down the entire lane and just got the better of the stubborn frontrunner in deep stretch when inching away in the final seventy yards for the victory. WALTER ME LAD comfortably lead on the rail in the beginning, moved well along the turn, was headed outside at the quarter pole, slugged it out never wavering inside down the stretch and gave way ever so slightly in the final seventy yards to just miss out on the gate to wire score. JAMIESTA had a stalking role ahead of one rival down the backside, progressed smartly inside saving all the ground around the turn, rallied on the fence to be in the hunt up top in briefly upper stretch but was no match for the front duo by the furlong pole and

finished up well enough still to safely hold for the show money at the wire. ENCHANT ME stalked near the rear on the outside in the beginning, narrowed the gap but could not improve position while outside in the two path around the bend, found more when encouraged between foes at the eighth pole and ran on willingly to settle on the fringes at the finish line. SOUPER SUCCESS had a good spot all alone watching the front pair at the half, chased the engaged duo through the turn making little gain, shifted out to the three path for the drive and finished up evenly in deep stretch losing out for the duel for a minor share in the end. HEAT MERCHANT was isolated in mid-pack at the half, held outside position while going two to three wide around the oval, drifted out to be widest in the six-path turning for home and could not get involved having no rally in the final furlong. LILLZ STAR had the rail position while stalking close to the back of the pack in the early stages, edged up taking the short way around in midturn, shifted out with a quarter mile from the prize, found a seam six wide between runners straightening out for home, was full of run through the lane and under a well-timed stretch rally got up in the last couple of jumps for the win. EASTER SUNDAY GIRL co-trailed on the inside of two others at the half, had to wait on the fence looking for room at the three furlong pole, advanced inside with five sixteenths from home, scraped paint having run at the top of the stretch,

shifted just outside off the tiring early leader at the furlong pole, took control with seventy yards to go but could not withstand the late charge by the winner in the final few strides. DAISYCREST prompted on the rail in the beginning, tracked in the second flight on the fence when the winner opened up at the half, moved up inside rivals on the turn, angled out three wide vying for the lead in upper stretch, poked her head in front in mid-stretch briefly but needed more late and had to settle for the third money in a four way photo for the win at the wire. HYPER HOLIDAY stalked in the third flight on the outside under a tight hold along the backstretch, was closing the gap three wide lengthening stride in midturn between rivals, angled out further with a quarter mile from home to be in with a chance seven wide in upper stretch gathering momentum, was gaining steadily on runners to the finish line but could not just quite get to the leaders in time and settled for a minor role while not that far off for the win in the end. IMPECCABLE TIMING was bumped outside on the start to co-trail with others on either side with a half mile remaining, could not quicken in the turn still seeing the field at the quarter pole, shifted out four wide for the stretch drive and finished with energy in the two path in the last furlong inside another. RIGHT BRIGHTLY was bumped inside on the break, co-trailed outside three deep at the half, made a brief move three wide in midturn, was floated out at the quarter pole to be eight wide at the top of the stretch, willingly kept on coming and finished with good interest moving well in the three path in the late stages. HOULIHAN travelled three deep under a hold watching the lead trio in the backstretch, moved in closer outside rivals going three wide part of the trio chasing the pacesetter around the bend, was in the mix in the five path between foes turning for home, shortened stride down the lane and yielded by the furlong marker. IMPERIAL TRICK had a narrow lead between foes at the start, shook clear to be loose up top by the half, continued on the front end but by a diminishing margin around the bend, was collared outside at the top of the lane, tried to offer some resistance until the furlong marker and folded on the fence in deep stretch. DANISH BELLE broke out on the start, recovered quickly to press the pace outside in the early going, chased the frontrunner with rivals on each side at the three eighths pole, backed away between horses through the turn, had nothing left in the stretch drive and galloped home.
