HAPPY QUAD settled in midfield on the rail in the early going, advanced smartly on the rail while in hand midway on the turn, shifted out four wide straightening for home gathering speed and wore down the leader down the stretch to draw off in the last sixteenth. BENNYS JETS broke sharp having the lead at the start, was then content to sit just outside tracking the frontrunner down the backstretch, closed in smartly outside throughout the turn, seized command three wide at the top of the lane, could not find another gear in the late stages and was unable to hold off the late charge by the winner outside in deep stretch. KNOWING broke out bumping a rival on the start, lagged well behind the field down the backside, took closer order taking the short way around the bend and was full of run on the fence down the stretch to close in right at the finish line to be a distant third when crossing the wire. DIVA'S GHOST veered in on the break, travelled three deep on the outside at the back group in the early going, started to reach for more ground swooping around horses commencing at the three eighths pole, gathered even more speed shifting out four wide entering the stretch and cleared past the leader at the furlong pole pulling away for the win at the wire. CASTLE HARBOUR settled four deep watching the front three in the beginning, was roused making an early move around horses at the seven sixteenths pole, took control outside at the three eighths marker, edged away up top when scrubbed for more around the bend from the pesky inside rival, shifted three wide clinging up front trying to hold off winner outside in upper stretch, had no answer by the furlong marker but still finished up well to be a clear second best in the end. HARPER CITY shifted in early, settled off the pace moving up some heading into the turn inside on or just off the rail, was off the fence coming to the quarter pole and steadied ever so slightly past that marker before being guided back to the rail at the top of the stretch, gained steadily inside, bid up the rail seventy yards out taking a narrow lead and prevailed. SOUPER SUNDAY had a good spot nestled on the rail sitting just behind the pacesetter down the backside, was poised watching the embattled duo fight it out through the turn, shifted out four wide off the dueling pair at the top of the stretch, stayed on the left lead down the lane taking command inside the eighth pole and prevailed for the win holding off on-comers on both sides late. SUPER SICILY tossed her head on the break to co-trail inside at the half, waited on the rail three furlongs from home and throughout the turn, shifted out three wide trying to find a seam in upper stretch, found another gear at the sixteenth pole and when clear darted between horses in deep stretch to get up for second money in a photo at the wire while not beaten that far for the win as well. EMPTY GESTURE prompted the pace outside in the early going, moved in to force the issue outside on the turn, took command between foes in the two path straightening out for the drive, could not kick on at the furlong marker with the winner bearing down outside and just lost the nod at the finish line for the runners up share. HAY HAY PAULA co-railed on the outside, started to mount a rally taking the overland route three wide around horses with three furlongs still to run, circled rivals on the turn to loom boldly six wide turning for home, kept on coming in mid-stretch but stalled in the final seventy yards outside foes to settle for a minor role in the end. FOREST B had an outside trip in midfield down the backside, travelled two to three wide around the bend but could not go with others making a move on either side at the quarter pole and could only manage to pass the tiring early leader with a sixteenth to run in the stretch drive. I'M INTO MISCHIEF dictated the pace down the back straight, maintained a slim advantage inside running through the bend, surrendered the front on the fence entering the stretch, folded inside by the furlong pole and was not persevered with late.

FANORE (IRE) was brushed outside on the start, watched the lead three runners outside in the early stages of the race, followed the path of fast closing rival moving in sharply through the far turn, angled out three wide to bid up front at the top of the lane and determinedly won the battle down the entire stretch when inching away in the final seventy yards. MISTER HOLDEN had a good trip sitting on the rail while watching the front duo slug it out in the early stages, moved to the lead easily with the leader softened up by the quarter pole, dueled inside in the two path at the top of the stretch, gamely fought on to the wire but was just outkicked late for the win. HEARD A GHOST had rail position near the back of the pack, made a good middle move splitting rivals at the half, had to be throttled down stuck behind a stopping runner at the three furlong pole, re-rallied at the quarter marker to be in the mix four wide turning for home, could not get to the front pair who had it to themselves in deep stretch but did finish up strong enough to be a clear third at the wire. RED

SNEAKERS had an awkward start to stalk near the rear on the rail, improved smartly on the fence along the backside, was stymied on the rail behind a stopping rival at the quarter pole with runners moving outside in full flight, shifted out three wide having clear run at the furlong marker and got back into gear late to settle on the fringes. UNDER SURVEILLANCE had a stalking role three wide on the initial bend, was part of the cluster of runners tracking the contesting duo at the half while five deep on the outside, continued to be five wide trying to circle around horses in the far turn, shifted out in the six path for the stretch run and still finished up mildly in deep stretch while dueling for a minor placing. LEOPARDI broke in at the start, stalked at the back going four wide around the first turn, trailed the field at the half, made no impression still at the tail on the far turn, shifted out four wide picking up the bit down the lane but still only managed to pass the stopping early leaders who dueled themselves into submission down the backstretch having nothing left. SILVER SMOKE was loose up top going into the first turn, had company outside separating from the field down the backstretch under a brisk pace, edged away from the early speed foe by the midpoint of the far turn, was under a drive but relinquished the lead on the fence with a quarter mile remaining and folded on the rail in the final furlong. FOUR K FORCE pressed the pace inside at the beginning, shifted outside letting the leader get away slightly on the first turn, moved in outside to battle for the lead down the back straight opening up on others, had little left to offer with three eighths still to run, backed through the field between horses around the final bend and was empty inside down the lane.
