CITORI broke sharp clearing from the outer post to get loose on the lead having the rail by the half, opened up impressively in hand around the turn, had a commanding advantage turning for home and got a little tired drifting out in deep stretch but still won by a comforatble margin at the finish line. WILD RED settled in mid-division on the outside down the back straight, had a mild turn of foot three wide outside rivals around the turn, finished with good late energy in the four path in the stretch drive and won the three way photo to best the rest at the finish line. JINX ME had a troubled start to be at the back three deep with company to her inside at the half, advanced around foes going three wide on the turn, swung out widest in the five path having clear run down the stretch and was full of run late to just miss out dueling for the place share at the wire. STUDY BUDDY (GB) broke a step slow from the inner post to be at the back group on the fence with a half mile remaining, made little impact just off the rail running around the bend, was looking for seam behind rivals in the three path at the top of the lane, determinedly battled between runners for the place share coming to the wire but was on the losing end of the poto and settled for a minor share. BLUE'S MOMMY had rail position in the middle of the pack in the early stages, kept pace on the fence around the oval, spurted away from rivals for the runners up share turning for home but could not continue on late and yielded inside horses in the final sixteenth of a mile. WHISKEY N ICE was bumped at the start, moved forward under mild coaxing to take the lead after the opening furlong, set the pace from off the rail pressed by an outside foe, faced an inside challenger leaving the turn, dueled through the stretch, held that rival. MIRAMICHI broke outwardly, tracked from inside, found room to bid up the rail past the quarter pole, drew nearly even by the top of the stretch, dueled through the lane but was denied. WOZNIACKI bumped a rival at the start, stalked from between foes two to three wide on the turn, came out five deep in upper stretch, gained steadily but was not enough. CATCH THE DRIFT bumped with a rival at the start, shifted in up the backstretch, saved ground through the turn, ran on inside.



TANDHONEYWITHANE lacked early speed, was under urging and advanced on the turn four wide, came out six wide in the stretch, kept on but needed more. TOTALLY IN CHARGE bumped with a rival at the start, chased three wide on the turn, went evenly. EPISODE had the brief early lead then pressed the new leader and eventual winner, floated wide leaving the turn, weakened in the stretch. TABEI broke a bit awkwardly and in a tad tight, was outpaced early, raced near but off the rail, was not a factor. MOMUNNYFOR RO dropped back to last heading to the turn, was under urging late on that bend while shifting inside a foe to cut the corner, was never near enough to threaten. SILENT SUNSHINE was reluctant to load, chased from outside four to six wide, faded.

SUIGU BELLE was away alertly taking command right from the get-go, opened up sharply on rivals through the turn and cruised home for the gate to wire score. FLORIDA VACATION stalked on the inside of horses in the early going, made little advance inside rivals on the turn, could not get involved in the two path in upper stretch, figured things out by the eighth pole and was flying home late bursting between foes at the wire to get up for second in a tight photo. FEDOROVA chased the leader on the rail in early backstretch, dropped back positions into the turn to be in midfield, took the short way around the bend keeping up with runners, dueled on the fence for the show award entering the stretch but need later to be a factor at the finish. CHEAT THE DEVIL broke inwards on the start, tracked in the foursome watching the loose winner while in the three path down the backside, separated from some rivals to track the frontrunner outside around the oval, was in the thick of things for a share three wide turning for home but wilted between horses in the final furlong. CALL ME MISSLUCKY was unhurried trailing on the outside down the backstretch, made no improvement going three wide around the turn and could not factor in the stretch running galloping across the finish line in the end.

MANSETTI broke outwards on the break, shadowed the pacesetter under a good hold into the first bend, was content to let the leader open up down the backside, moved in confidently between rivals midway on the far turn, seized command in the three-path straightening out for home and was kept to the task down the lane to hold safe for the victory at the finish line. SCORCHING bobbled then was brushed off stride leaving the gate, was hard held nestled on the fence just behind the early leader in the beginning, rated kindly on the rail in midfield along the backstretch, edged up smartly inside rivals through the running on the last turn, angled out in the three path with a good chance in upper stretch, shifted out four wide at the furlong pole under left-handed encouragement and ran on the wire with a solid effort for the runners up share. MEGALODON was pinballed between horses on the break, stalked three wide going into the first turn, improved outside around foes in the initial bend to track the lead two entering the backstretch, took closer order to bid three wide on the outside of the eventual winner midway on the last turn, shifted out five wide in the hunt at the top of the stretch and finished up willingly in the late stages to capture the show award at the wire. SEDBURYS GHOST settled in mid-pack between rivals in the first turn, was shuffled back into the back straight to be ahead of only one runner down the backside, was urged for more going two to three wide with five sixteenths remaining while behind a wall of chasing runners, found a seam in the four path in mid-stretch and ran on mildly with horses on both sides for a minor role in the end. CHURCH AND STATE broke out on the start, had a stalking role three wide into the first bend, made little movement going three deep along the backside, offered a brief turn of foot when roused at the three eighths maker trying to circle around horses four wide on the last turn, shifted out widest in the six path at the top of the lane but finished up evenly and could not get into contention in deep stretch. WAR SIGNAL set the pace unchallenged into the first of two turns, improved the advantage slowing the tempo down slightly along the backside, was headed outside by the winner at the five sixteenths pole, surrendered the front inside at the top of the lane, tried to fight back in mid-stretch but wilted on the rail in the final sixteenth. WATSONVILLE RED was bumped inside at the start, managed to save ground getting to the rail into the first turn while trailing in the early stages, narrowed the gap on the far turn, shifted outside at the quarter pole, had no rally outside in the six path in upper stretch, shifted back inside switching leads and found his best stride late closing in smartly at the wire.

OL' BLONDIE had a stalking role ahead of only the troubled starter at the half, waited to move behind a wall of horses midway on the turn , angled four wide having clear run in upper stretch, was moving well closing



outside for the place share at the eighth pole but stalled slightly in the final seventy yards settling on the fringes in the end. REFLEXIVITY (IRE) had a five deep trip in midfield down the backstretch, tried to circle around horses on the turn travelling five wide, shifted out to the six path straightening out for home and could only pass tired runners inside in mid-stretch. YA MAR tried to prompt the pace in the early going on the fence, was scrubbed on but was going in the wrong direction midway around the bend, retreated on the fence in upper stretch and could not factor in the late running. BLACKFOOT DAISY forced the pace on the outside at the half, was under a ride but could not gain on the leader while going three wide through the turn, still was in the mix three wide at the top of the lane for a share but had little left for the drive and folded by the furlong marker. SHOOTIN' AMY was in the four path in mid-division along the backside, narrowed the gap between foes still remaining four wide on the turn, shifted out some more for the stretch run, finished up on the wrong lead down the lane and failed to menace in the late stages.

PATCHES O'HOULIHAN pulled the rider to the lead down the backstretch, opened up slightly with five furlongs remaining, was hard held on the left rein loose up top but was getting out at the three furlong marker on the turn, drifted out considerably to be in the ten path when clinging up front with a furlong from the prize, lost the lead momentarily with a sixteenth to run, showed his heart late digging back in to prevail in the stretch drive by a photo at the wire, was eased shortly after the race and left via equine ambulance. MY BOY PRINCE pressed the issue on the inside at the start, was then throttled down content on letting the pacesetter go ahead at the five furlong marker, measured the frontrunner edging closer poised through the turn, moved in to bid inside in the three path at the quarter pole, appeared to poke his head in front for a stride or two fighting down the lengthy stretch at the sixteenth pole, switched back to the incorrect lead in the late going at the seventy yard marker and was denied at the wire in a tight finish. DRESDEN ROW travelled at the back going three deep along the back straight, ranged up taking the outside route going five wide around the turn, swung out widest in the seven path having clear run turning for home, could not reel in the lead pair who had a race to themselves in the final furlong but did battle on to capture the show award in deep stretch outside. PLAYMEA TUNE had rail position part of the rear trio in the early going, kept pace inside rivals running just off the fence around the bend, rallied on the rail in mid-stretch, dueled for the show money in the final furlong but was outkicked in the final seventy yards and had to settle for a minor placing in the end. NIAGARA SKYLINE was part of the threesome seeing the field with company on both sides down the backstretch, stubbornly was holding his own between rivals three wide around the bend, shifted just outside in the four path for the drive to the wire but could not get into contention



running one paced to the finish line. OLD CHESTNUT settled in mid-pack watching the front pair down the backside, was hard ridden in the four path trying to hold forward position between rivals throughout the turn, angled out in the six path for the stretch drive but lacked a rally down the stretch.

FUNTASTIC AGAIN was nudged on after the start to seize command under the wire for the first time, increased the advantage moving comfortably in control around the first turn, dictated the pace along the backside with little pressure, had company on the outside with a quarter mile from the prize, was set down in the two path inside the challenger turning for home, had more in reserve under a well rationed ride, spurted clear again at the furlong pole and was kept to the task to hold sway by a diminishing margin at the wire for the win. STANLEY HOUSE travelled on the fence in midfield on the first turn, continued in the middle of the pack waiting for the cue along the backside, made a sharp move bursting between horses in the two path at the three-furlong pole reaching for more ground, shifted out five wide posing the main threat in upper stretch, kept on coming down the stretch never giving in, closed the gap on the winner late but could not get there in time. BAIL US OUT had a good position nestled on the fence behind the pacesetter, settled into stride in the second flight inside down the backstretch, saved ground while roused on the far turn, inched up at the quarter pole to be in the hunt on the fence in upper stretch, could not threaten the lead duo by the sixteenth pole but still ran on end to the first and captured the show award by winning the nod at the finish line. ESSEX SERPENT tracked three wide into the first bend, hounded the pacesetter rating kindly along the backside, moved in to bid for the lead outside



at the quarter pole, could not match strides with the winner in mid-stretch and faded slightly between foes late to lose the duel for third money at the wire. FLY THE W co-trailed on the inside for the for early part of this route race, remained at the rear taking the shortest way around the final bend and finished up mildly on the fence but could not get into contention in the late running. CLASSIC MO TOWN travelled three wide on the outside close to the back of the pack, made no movement three deep along the back straight, made a brief move four wide at the three eighths marker circling around foes, was floated out in the six path, widest of runners turning for home but could not offer a finish in the stretch drive. DANCIN IN DA'NILE travelled just off the fence outside another, co-trailing in the early going, made little headway along the backside, was asked for more offering little response on the far turn and failed to fire in the two path down the lane. FASHIONABLY FAB tracked on the outside in the second flight in the early stages, was roused in the three path midway on the far turn but could not quicken with others at the quarter pole, angled to the four path for the stretch drive but gave way by mid-stretch.

OCEAN CLUB had a narrow lead with runners on both sides in the early going, quickened the tempo up top with only mild pressure from the outside foe around the bend, travelled well dictating terms in the two path straightening for home, shot clear when urged for more at the furlong marker and held off all closing rivals at the wire for the front-end tally. READY FOR SHIRL stalked close to the back of the pack between runners in the two path, made little movement position wise but did close the gap on the leader around the bend, lacked running room in the four path turning for home, weaved through traffic in and out at the three sixteenths pole, had a clear lane five wide with a furlong remaining, was full of run late but just could not get to the winner in time. BLUEBERRY FIELDS had an inside trip for the most part stalking near the back in the beginning, edged up closer saving all the ground throughout the turn, scraped paint mounting a rally in upper stretch, shifted to the three path off a tiring rival in mid-stretch and with a strong late surge just missed for the runners up share at the wire. AUSTERE travelled three deep on the outside in mid-division along the backside, continued three wide running evenly through the bend, shifted out seven wide starting to make a run at the quarter pole, was gaining gradually down the stretch to be in the conversation with a furlong still to go and finished up with intent late to settle on the fringes in the end. READY TO JAM was in the second flight between runners along the backside, ranged up three wide on the turn keeping a close eye on the lead trio outside, was in the four path straightening out for home, moved in smartly into second chasing the frontrunner at the eighth pole but evened out late losing some positions at the wire. MISSION OF JOY stalked on the outside three deep near the rear, made little progression going three wide outside horses on the bend, swung out widest in the eight path for the stretch drive, rallied smartly outside foes until the furlong pole, switched back to the incorrect lead down the long stretch losing momentum and stalled in the final seventy yards. CREVALLE D'ORO was allowed to settle at the back of the pack in the early stages, continued at the rear around the bend while narrowing the margin, angled out five wide looking for running room in upper stretch, shifted to the eight path having clear run at the furlong pole and finished up with good energy passing many in the late running. CAITLINHERGRTNESS had good position on the inside watching the engaged trio down the backside, took closer order in the turn drafting behind the frontrunner, skimmed the fence turning for home with aim on the leader, had no kick to offer by the furlong pole and steadily retreated in the late stages. METAPHYSICAL settled in the middle of the pack three deep on the outside along the back straight, kept pace between rivals in the running around the bend, made a brief move in the six path from the top of the lane to mid-stretch, stayed on the left lead to the finish line and yielded by the sixteenth pole. MS. TART forced the issue inside in the early going, was in tight having to be checked out on the fence at the half mile pole, recouped to rate inside runners in the third flight by midturn, shifted to the five path at the quarter pole, bobbled between foes with an eighth of a mile to run and could not factor in deep stretch. SWEET REBECCA prompted the pace three deep on the outside tossing her head down the backstretch, settled down to shadow the front runner outside around the turn, was in the mix three wide between rivals at the top of the lane, had little left to give and backed away through the field in the final furlong.
