REACH FOR THE TOP was in the mix between horses at the start, poked her head in front with a half mile left to go, dueled head to head on the outside through the turn and got the better of the early speed foe at the eighth pole to edge away in the three path in deep stretch. TENTOMIDNIGHT had a slim lead on the rail after the break, relinquished the lead inside at the half, countered to regain a short lead by the three furlong pole, battled on the rail inside the winner until the furlong marker and just had enough late to save for the second place prize at the finish line. KIMBERLINA prompted three deep on the start, dropped back to have an ideal spot, isolated, watching the engaged duo at the half, could not reel in the contesting pair when roused in midturn, angled out four wide for the drive and closed in belatedly almost getting the runners up share in the final jump outside. LA BELVA settled on the rail in midfield, tracked the front twosome in the second flight with an outside rival through the bend, dueled for the show spot on the fence in upper stretch, shifted out three wide at the furlong marker and finished up well enough for a minor placing in the end. CONFUSING was loose on the lead after the break, battled inside with another foe quickening the tempo around the turn and had more to give at the furlong pole when edging away for the win in deep stretch. MASTER SPY had a tracking role outside after the break, moved in to battle outside setting a brisk pace around the turn, stubbornly fought on outside the winner down the stretch, could not keep up by the eighth pole but did dig in between foes late to save the place share in a tight finish. WILBERFORCE broke in the air to see the field after the start, moved closer three deep on the outside down the backstretch when roused for run, had a good set-up isolated watching the engaged duo throughout the turn, grinded away determinedly in the two path in the stretch drive and just missed surging at the wire for second money. MANNIX (IRE) had a good spot on the fence watching the lead pair down the back straight, dropped back into the turn to be in the third tier inside rivals on the bend, shifted out three wide in upper stretch and was gaining gradually in the late stages but could not close quick enough late and lost the three-way photo outside for the runners up share. TOURIST'S DREAM was void of early speed seeing the field in the early stages, swung out widest in the seven path catching up to rivals outside with a quarter mile remaining, found his best stride late and passed some rivals outside in the final furlong. I HAVE AN IDEA was nestled on the fence near the rear in the early going, look group to the leaders while taking the short way around the turn, continued an inside trip straightening out for home but lacked a rally in deep stretch. BET N WIN settled

in mid-pack along the backside, stalked in the third flight with runners on either side around the bend, angled five wide turning for home but could not factor in the drive to the wire. BIG BOLD AND FIRST was hustled from the outer post to get loose up top on the rail with a half mile remaining, moved well in command through the turn, was kept to the task under a vigorous ride down the stretch and just had enough left in the tank late to held narrowly at the wire for the win. BANK ON BIG WINNER was roused inside chasing the lone speed down the backstretch, whittled away at the leader around the oval, never wavered down the lane, kept on coming late and was just shy of catching the stablemate at the finish line. DEPUTY GHOST tracked the lead pair while nestled on the rail down the back straight, rallied on the fence smartly at the quarter pole taking closer order and ran on willingly inside through the stretch to be a clear but non-threatening third in the end. TIME ZAPPER was away slowly on the start, stalked ahead of one runner down the backstretch, co-trailed inside around the bend, shifted just off the fence at the top of the lane and finished up with intent to be a fringe player when crossing the wire. ALLEY OOP JOHNNY broke in just a bit, was prominent early but ceded the lead before the first turn content to stalk, switched out and was in behind the leader up the backstretch racing off the rail, advanced three wide on the far turn, struck the lead in upper stretch, led till late when challenged by foes inside and out and just failed to last. CLASSY WAR contently shadowed the pacesetter outside down the backstretch, cruised outside going head to head for the lead around the bend, edged away in the three path in mid-stretch seizing command and had more left to stave off the outside challenger in the late running as well. SO DELICIOUS had an ideal trip, all alone watching the contesting duo down the backside, inched up on the turn, shifted outside off the lead pair at the quarter pole, loomed the main threat in the four path at the top of the lane but could not get to the winner who had something left for the drive. KOKOMO was urged from the get-go having a slim head in front on the inside in the early going, maintained the lead but was scrubbed on to just hold the advantage around the bend, could not match strides with the winner outside that was going by at the furlong pole and faded inside late to hold for the show award. DONTGOBACKONURWORD travelled four deep in midfield along the backside, mildly ranged up outside rivals three wide on the turn, shifted to the four path at the top of the stretch and finished up evenly for a minor role. CATCH A TIGER stalked near the rear between horses, could not keep pace with others through the turn and could only manage to pick up a tired contestant in mid-stretch. HAWKESBURY broke a step slow from the inner post to see the field on the break, moved up on the fence at the half, tracked the lead duo inside into the turn, had nothing left retreating on the rail at the five sixteenths pole and emptied out inside rivals turning for home.

SHADOW REALM stalked from outside, moved out from three to five wide on the turn, was asked for more by the quarter pole, came into upper stretch six wide with aim and momentum, struck the lead past the furlong marker, edged past and was kept to the task. YOU BE THE JUDGE settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn near the inside at the back but advancing, came out three to four wide in the stretch, rallied between foes to get the place. FOUR STRONG WINDS moved forward inside up the backstretch, tracked the leaders while saving ground, came out at the top of the stretch, bid late but was outfinished. SILENT RESERVE had a slim advantage on the outside down the backside, shook clear under a brisk pace throughout the turn, stayed on the left lead but continued to open up down the lane and won comfortably in front running fashion. READY TO COLLECT tracked on the fence in the second flight watching the lead two at the half, continued inside staying even with the leader around the turn, shifted out at the quarter pole gathering momentum, angled to the four path closing on the outside down the lane and finished up smartly to best the rest at the finish line for the runners up share. SPLIT STRIKE dueled on the fence up front along the backside, was checked in tight on the rail at the three eighths pole, recovered to chase the pacesetter just off the fence around the oval, could not close the gap on the winner by mid-stretch and faded slightly in the last sixteenth getting caught for the second placing late. HE SHOOTS HE WINS had an outside track position on the backstretch, moved in closer three wide in midturn, angled to the three path for the drive but lacked a finish between runners in the final furlong to finish up on the fringes. CADFAEL had a stalking trip near the rear along the backside, saved ground but could not get involved in the running around the bend, shifted just off the rail fir the drive to the wire but had no rally in the late stages. ONE TRUE GENTLEMAN hit the gate, stumbling badly at the start to trail the field by many and could not recover to be involved in the sprint race.

JUNIOR HOT SHOT bumped a rival at the start then steadied soon after when a rival came in, settled at the back in behind runners, lacked room coming past the quarter pole, angled out at the top of the stretch five wide forcing rivals out and bumping one in the process, straightened out and took aim in upper stretch, ground on steadily to strike the lead about seventy yards out and drive past. ITS TIME TO SHINE got away well, stalked the early leader then moved up alongside that one to press, bid at the quarter pole, moved clear while drifting in a bit in upper stretch, was overtaken near the seventy-yard marker and was outkicked but held place. PAINTTHETOWNSILVER settled inside foes off the pace, moved off the rail late on the turn, was asked for run about the quarter pole, came into upper stretch four deep, kept on late but needed more. OSCAR JOY settled between foes in the second group, was forced out leaving the turn and bumped into a rival at the top of the stretch now six wide, recovered and ran on. RAPID GREY was bumped at the start, settled outside runners off the pace, was carried out and bumped coming to the top of the stretch nine wide, needed more in the lane. SPEED FIGURES got away sharply, moved clear and shifted in, set the pace inside, was challenged on the turn, overtaken late on that bend, gave way in the stretch. MAAKWA was forced in a bit after the start, made a swift early move outside soon after to get within range of the leader chasing briefly from outside, began dropping back while encouraged some about three furlongs out, was bumped into a rival at the top of the stretch and continued to weaken.

LIGHT THE LAMP pulled the rider to clear for the lead on the fence by the five eighths marker, rolled along with little pressure outside through the turn and under a savvy ride had plenty left for the drive to pull away again for the win in the final furlong. FIGHTER IN THE WIN moved comfortably tracking the leader on the outside, continued to sit just off the fence on the outside flank off the leader around the bend, shifted out to the four path in upper stretch and determinedly chased the winner in vain to the wire easily saving for the runners up share. FORESTER'S FORTUNE had a stalking role close to the back of the pack on the rail, edged up on the fence through the running on the oval, shifted to the six path between foes in the drive and had good energy to rally late to be a distant but clear third at the finish line. MOON LANDING co-trailed on the inside in the early going, took the short way around the turn closing the gap on runners, shifted out to be three wide with a furlong from home and closed in late for a minor role in the end. FOREST BUZZ co-trailed on the outside, travelled three to four wide around the bend making little movement outside, swung out widest in the eight path straightening out for home and had his best run late picking up rivals in the final furlong. INDIAN PEAK had an outside spot in the second flight in the early stages watching the lead two, had a brief turn of foot five wide at the quarter pole, dueled for the place or show share in upper stretch but flattened out in the final eighth of mile. ARMSTRONG was away alertly for the lead at the start, drafted behind the frontrunner midway along the backside, continued to sit just back from the pacesetter on the

turn, had little to offer in the stretch run and wilted at the furlong pole. KINETIC STONE stalked near the rear between horses, made little headway going three wide around the bend, shifted to the seven path in upper stretch but folded midway down the lane.

FIGHTING THE WARS broke a bit awkwardly, stalked from outside, went mostly four to five wide on the turn shifting in a bit while advancing on the leader, bid at the top of the stretch drawing even, dueled but was ultimately denied while second bets. VELOCIRAPTOR settled outside a foe off the pace racing about three to four wide into the turn, swung out six to seven wide turning for home, rallied in upper- to mid-stretch to get into third, was no match for the top pair but held show honors. PAYNES SPIRIT lacked early speed trailing the field, swung eight to nine wide turning for home, rallied outside and was gaining late but just missed third. ALZADO settled outside off the pace, was mostly four to five wide, exchanged a light bump with a rival near the sixteenth pole, kept on evenly. RED WEAVER bumped with a foe at the start, contended inside till the top of the stretch, weakened and came out off the rail in upper stretch, faded. DEVIL'S TONGUE settled inside a foe off the pace, angled out in the stretch and improved position. SUNDAY'S WELL was forwardly-placed between foes contending then chasing three to four wide, dropped back on the turn, exchanged a bump near the sixteenth pole, failed to rally. FINE STYLE chased from between runners and exchanged some brushing while being shuffled back when in tight leaving the backstretch, went two to three wide on the turn, failed to menace. SPRINGER chased from inside, exchanged incidental contact up the backstretch, came out a bit in the stretch, faded.
