LA BELVA was in the mix on the rail in the beginning, reined back to sit in midfield on the fence by the half mile marker, kept pace taking the short way around the turn, was full of run darting up the fence at the furlong marker and took the lead with seventy yards from home for the rail skimming win. HYPER HOLIDAY had a stalking trip near the rear along the backside, travelled three wide creeping closer on the outside through the turn, shifted out widest in the five path gathering more momentum turning for home and with a solid late charge got up right at the finish line for the runners up share. FEATHERWEIGHT vied between horses in the early going, took back to let the loose speed leader open up at the half, began to reel in the pacesetter by midturn, loomed three wide at the top of the lane, seized command outside by the eighth pole, but could not continue the run and faded deep stretch to just miss holding for the place share at the wire. IMPERIAL TRICK broke in exchanging a bump at the start with the inside rival to trail along the back straight, lagged well behind making no headway on the turn, started to lengthen stride considerably at the top of the lane and surged inside runners in the final seventy yards to be a fringe player in the end. TENTOMIDNIGHT broke out trading a bump with the outside foe on the break, recovered smartly to get a clear lead midway down the backstretch, rolled along unopposed around the bend, was collared outside in the two path in upper stretch, offered mild resistance until the furlong marker and folded between horses in the last sixteenth of a mile. COUNTRY DOLLY improved down the backside to sit in the middle of the pack by the half, could not keep up to the rivals on either side who were starting to make a run while in the four path straightening out for home and could only finish up one paced to the finish line.

PALACE VIEW (IRE) travelled between foes in mid-division down the backstretch, was nudged on along the turn narrowing the margin by the five sixteenths pole, sat behind the embattled trio three wide in upper stretch, had clear run angling inside at the furlong pole, surged to the lead with a sixteenth remaining and held safe for the win. AGILE DANCER had the rail position in mid-pack in the early stages, waited on the fence behind rivals well in hand throughout the bend, shifted out five wide for the drive to the wire, had aim on the leaders in mid-stretch, was closing in on the winner late but it wasn't enough at the finish line. LIL BIT GANGSTA had a good spot three deep tracking the lead duo down the back straight, took closer order to be three wide in the mix up top by the three eighths pole, shifted out in the four path in the hunt between rivals in upper stretch, switched back to the incorrect lead while dueling outside at the furlong marker and held on late to be a non-threatening third in the end. DREAMS AND SCHEMES was bumped outside and crowded between horses finally checking out to trail down the backside, began to pick up runners three wide outside at the half, held his own still going three wide through the turn, angled out widest in the six-path turning for home and ran on evenly to the wire for a minor role. WAR IN CHARGE was bumped a couple of times leaving the gate, pulled the rider to the lead under a snug hold inside a challenger down the backside, had a narrow lead on the rail around the bend, was clinging onto the lead in the two path inside a trio of rivals at the top of the lane, had little left late and yielded between foes in deep stretch. SOONER LUNAR veered in sharply for a few strides before the rider could straighten him out, hounded the leader outside down the backstretch, set the pace going head to

head with the frontrunner outside around the bend, battled three deep between rivals in upper stretch but needed more late when folding with runners on each side in the last sixteenth. CABERNAYDO had one beaten along the backside having a stalking role in the early going, regressed inside a rival to be at the rear midway through the turn, shifted out four wide for the stretch drive but failed to fire down the lane.

SECRET GIZMO settled three deep on the outside of runners by the half while watching the front duo down the backside, was urged for more midturn starting to reel in the front two with a quarter mile remaining, angled out four wide reaching for more ground outside in upper stretch, drove past taking control at the sixteenth pole and safely held for the win when crossing the wire. THATSITTHATSALL had a stalking role ahead of only the troubled starter along the backside, made no progression on the turn to actually be relegated to last by the quarter pole, shifted out four wide by mid-stretch finding another gear late and ran on strongly in the final seventy yards to best the rest for the runners up share at the finish line. LILLZ STAR had rail position in midfield, watched the contesting pair inside in the second flight through the bend, scraped paint straightening out for home and finished up willingly inside foes to capture the show money just at the wire. GAMBLE ON LOVE emerged with the lead on the inside at the five eighths pole, set the pace while pressured outside around the turn, disposed on the early speed rival at the top of the lane opening on horses, had little left in the tank in deep stretch and flattened out in the last seventy yards losing a couple of placings very late. SHAMELESS AFFAIR travelled three deep between runners in the early going keeping an eye on the lead twosome, inched up around the oval to be in the mix for a piece of the prize at the top of the lane, could only finish up one paced to the wire but almost caught a backing up early leader for a minor share in the end. RED MOOD settled in the middle of the pack early on two wide between foes down the backside, dropped back from the tracking group by the half, made little impression around the turn, angled out for trail by many along the backside,

caught up to a rival outside midway on the turn, angled out widest in the six path for the stretch drive and finished up with interest gaining on rivals late even though unable to improve position at the wire. PORSHAS RUN flanked the pacesetter outside midway down the backstretch, moved in to press the issue still outside around the bend, shifted out three wide but was shortening stride when the winner swept past at the furlong pole and emptied out in the final sixteenth of a mile.

REACH FOR THE TOP settled off the leading pair stalking outside a rival, went about three wide on the turn advancing while getting mild encouragement at the five-sixteenths, struck the lead at the three-sixteenths, drew clear in mid-stretch under urging, came out a bit late while weakening but held. WHERE'S SAMNBAILEY settled toward the rear off the inside racing in the three to four path into and on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch, was gaining steadily on the leader but too late. LOVE YOU LIPPY pressed the pacesetter up the backstretch well in hand and rated, drew even and took a narrow lead past the five-sixteenths, was overtaken narrowly in upper stretch, weakened the final furlong. MASTER ARAGORN broke just a step slowly, lacked early speed despite encouragement, switched out heading up the backstretch, went two to three wide on the turn, came out a bit further in the stretch and improved position past tiring rivals. JIMMY'S AFFAIR broke a step slowly, was encouraged along inside, saved ground on the turn, came out for the drive, failed to menace. KITTY'SSPEEDYSTARR broke inwardly, soon went to the lead inside, set a pressured pace, gave way. LET'S BE FIRST chased from inside mid-pack, came out four to five wide in upper stretch, faded.

SKY DIVINE saved ground through the turn racing off the leaders, finished with mild late interest. MIGHT BEE TROUBLE was lightly bumped at the start, settled off the pace outside, went four to five wide and was under some urging past the seven-sixteenths, went evenly throughout and did not threaten. FEDOROVA was prominent very early but taken back and switched out coming past the half stalking the leader from outside, went two to three wide on the turn, drifted about in the stretch and faded. WEAPONS MASTER steadied at he start, was subsequently outrun.

SNATCHED settled close to the back of the pack inside, made little advancement between rivals by the half, patiently waited inside runners midway on the last bend, found a seam in the two path turning for home to split horses by mid-stretch for the lead and edged away to increase the winning margin at the wire. JUST MAGNIFICENT stalked outside into the first turn, improved four deep with a half mile left to run, made a big sweeping move four wide around the last oval to pose the main threat in the five path in upper stretch, ran on well enough to the wire but was no match late for the winner who was going away for the win at the finish line. NEENAH settled on the outside of another watching the lead duo contest the early pace, moved well in hand measuring the front two by the half, took closer order in the three path between horses on the far turn to be four wide in the thick of things at the top of the lane and stalled slightly in the late running saving for the show award but no match for the top two at the finish line. HIGHLAND SOCIETY was hard held on the rail not giving the inside position away to the frontrunner down the backstretch, drafted in the second flight on the fence at the three eighths pole poised to move on the turn, shifted out looking for a seam off the tiring early leader three wide with a furlong to go while full of run and under a savvy ride had another gear late bursting between horses coming up to the wire to get up for the well timed win. DETERMINED FURY sat alone watching the lead twosome down the backside, travelled on the outside in the second flight having the eventual winner pinned in through the bend, shifted out three wide to be in the conversation outside rivals at the top of the lane, was finding more in the four path under right handed urging at the sixteenth pole but just lost the nod for the win at the finish line. MASTER SPY settled in midfield all by himself down the back straight, made an early move three deep at the half outside rivals to bid for the lead by the three eighths marker, battled outside going head-to-head through the turn, got the advantage in the two path outside at the top of the stretch, was moving well appearing to be quite in control at the sixteenth pole but weakened very late and was caught in the shadow of the wire while on the losing end of a three win win photo inside the other two challengers. VALYRIAN SKY was away quickly from the outer post to have the lead in the two path down the backstretch, dueled determinedly on the fence with outside company quickening the pace

around the bend, tried to come back on when relinquishing the lead at the top of the stretch but faded with a sixteenth to run inside horses to hold for a minor share in the end. BACKONTHECHAINGANG settled near the rear on the rail in the beginning, advanced smartly inside rivals by the half, rallied on the fence in midturn, shifted out at the quarter pole with a full head of steam, pounced three wide at the top of the lane to seize command with a furlong to go and won going away by a good margin at the finish. SPRINGER angled in entering the backstretch while dueling outside in the early stages, battled outside with another foe separating themselves from the next closest competitor around the bend, had no answer for the winner who stormed on by outside at the eighth pole but did dig in stubbornly late to hold for the place share in a photo at the wire. DROGON had a good trip isolated watching the embattled lead duo down the

backstretch, could not quicken with the eventual winner inside at the quarter pole but did keep on coming four wide down the stretch gaining on the early lead pair at the furlong marker and just missed getting up outside for the place share at the finish line. TEMPLE HALL was slammed on the outside being knocked off stride leaving the chute, recovered quickly to contest the pace inside along the backstretch, slugged it out well ahead of the rest of the pack dueling on the rail up top through the turn, could not continue on from his early efforts and gave way on the rail in the final furlong. WOODGLEN COURT had a stalking role in the two path between horses down the back straight, was roused at the three eighths pole but was losing ground to the lead foursome around the turn, shifted out four wide at the top of the stretch but could only manage to finish up evenly to the wire posing little threat in the end. PROCEEDWITHCAUTION stalked three deep in the early going, had little impact taking the short way around the bend while scrubbed on for more at the five sixteenths pole and made little presence on the fence in the late running. MIKEY BOY stalked near the rear ahead of only the troubled starter down the backstretch, lost touch to the rest of the field around the bend and could not improve down the lane to factor in the late running.
