BACK RIVER was allowed to settle into stride at the back of the pack in the early going, started to make a strong rally at the three eighths pole circling around rivals three wide to bid for the lead in the four path outside by the quarter pole, was full of run six wide at the top of the lane and powered past at the furlong marker to win going away at the wire. CLIVE CROSS had an outside position in the middle of the pack along the backstretch, took closer order with a half mile remaining, edged up three wide around the bend to be in the hunt between foes two furlongs from home, shifted out in the five path in tight quarters in upper stretch battling for the lead, could not continue on with the outside winner who had more at the eighth pole but did finish up smartly to win the runners up share in the end. GUARD OF HONOUR was hustled at the break angling in down the backstretch to be the sole leader on the fence by the half, was clinging onto the lead on the rail with three outside runners bearing down with a quarter mile to run, veered out sharply to the four path when inside rivals driving at the top of the stretch, was no match for the winner at the eighth pole and lost the duel for third in the final seventy yards. GOLDEN TEST was checked when crowded between foes entering the backstretch to sit in midfield on the rail by the half, took the short way around on the bend inching up on the fence turning for home, had a chance inside for a share of the prize in upper stretch but could not find more late unable to threaten in the final furlong. GET OUT THE VOTE pressed the pace on the rail early on, was reined in giving inside position to the leader midway down the backside, shifted to the outside by the half, hounded the pace outside through the turn, continued to fight on when in the mix between foes in the two path at the quarter pole, was steadied sharply losing his path four wide at the top of the stretch and could not recover in time to play a role in the late running. STEWARDS INQUIRY DOWN THE STRETCH, RIDERS CLAIM OF FOUL #2 GET OUT AND VOTE AGAINST #5 GUARD OF HONOUR AS WELL AS #6 CLIVE CROSS AGAINST #3 BACK RIVER ALL IN THE VICINITY OF THE THREE SIXTEENTHS POLE RESULTED IN #5 GUARD OF HONOUR BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SIXTH FOR INTERFERENCE

BENNY'S JETS had a slim advantage on the outside in the early going, bobbled heads up front with the rider statuesque outside through the turn, bid four wide up top entering the stretch and when set down for more at the eighth pole drew away smartly to win going away in the late stages. LIVININTHEFASTLANE was pinched on the break, travelled on the rail watching the front two down the backside, narrowed the gap by the quarter pole, angled out three wide looking for a seam turning for home, shifted out in the four path with a furlong from home and rallied late to be a non threatening runner up when crossing the finish line. KNOWING settled near the rear on the outside down the backstretch, closed in while just off the rail behind the lead duo at the quarter pole, shifted three wide for the drive to the wire and ran on willingly with horses on both sides to get the nod for the show money at the wire. STEPHEN B GOOD was in tight at the break, stalked with a fellow rival outside in the beginning, edged up slightly saving all the ground around the bend and could only finish up mildly between foes in deep stretch losing the show photo at the finish. ALZADO bobbled then broke outwards on the start, recouped to sit in midfield on the outside of another down the backside, was under a ride but could not gain on the engaged duo through the turn, angled out widest in the five path straightening for home and finished up gradually outside trying to close for a minor placing. EARNING MY EARS broke out on the start, prompted the pace on the rail in the beginning, dueled inside through the turn, stayed on the incorrect lead inside rivals at the top of the lane still fighting up front but folded on the fence in the final furlong. KERR had a slow then erratic start on the break to trail by many along the backside, lost touch with the field around the turn, cantered down the lane, was eased soon after crossing the finish line and left via equine ambulance.

RUTHLESS ACTION was under a snug hold tracking the pacesetter while having foes on either side, was poised just off the fence keeping a close eye on the leader around the oval, loomed outside in the four path turning for home, never switched leads down the lane but still determinedly wore down the frontrunner in the last seventy yards for the gritty win. WILD RED was unhurried trailing the field with a half mile to run, still was at the rear in the two path by the quarter pole but was not all that far off from the frontrunner, burst between rivals two wide having a good run in upper stretch and with one final late surge in deep stretch timed the wire perfectly to get up for the runners up share right at the finish line. JINX ME settled near the back of the pack going four deep along the backside, continued the overland route trying to circle the field still four wide around the bend, shifted out to the five path still giving it her all outside foes down the lane and was just denied by the nod at the wire for the runners up share. BALLS IN UR COURT set a brisk pace loose on the lead but in hand down the backside, rolled along up top through the turn slowing the tempo down slightly, began to shorten stride while staying on the wrong lead clinging onto the lead with a furlong to go but could not find much more resolve late and wilted in the final seventy yards to lose a couple of placing at the finish line. ADORABLE ANGEL had an outside position in mid-division down the back straight, crept closer between horses three wide on the bend, shifted out four wide straightening out for the drive but could only finish up one paced making little impression in the late running. FLORIDA VACATION stumbled soon after the break, was then rushed up on the inside along the backstretch under a tight hold eager behind the leader at the half, waited on the rail in mid-pack on the turn inside foes, skimmed the fence head cocked outside turning for home in with a chance for a minor share, lugged in through the stretch, had little left to give by the furlong marker emptying out and was not persevered with late.

BRITTANY'S WAY was keen loose on the lead down the backside, increased the margin midway on the turn, was collard outside while in the two path turning for home, played coy when relinquishing the front briefly at the furlong pole and under a crafty ride resurged having more in the final sixteenth to come back on for the win on the rail in deep stretch. TEQUILASOUPERNOVA was content to let the frontrunner go ahead with it down the backside, started to reel in the pacesetter commencing a run with five sixteenths to go, bid for the front posing the only threat outside in the three path turning for home, poked her head in front for a moment around the furlong pole but could not find another gear late when the winner had a final surge in the late stages to reclaim the lead and the win at the wire. GIVE ME THE BOOTS was unopposed on the rail up top down the backside, freewheeled loose up top on the turn setting an even pace, had a clear advantage straightening out for home on the fence, began to get leg weary while kept to the task at the furlong pole, had a wall of runners closing in sharply but dug in late to just hold on at the wire for the frontrunning tally. PURR FACTOR let the lone speed foe go on with it down the backside, was roused midturn making little gain on the leader, started to whittle away on the pacesetters lead three wide in mid-stretch, was coming on strongly just outside in the late running but just missed getting to the winner at the wire. I'M INTO MISCHIEF was reluctant to load at the start, stalked close to the rear outside horses early on, made little progression outside foes on the oval, shifted four wide for the stretch drive, rallied between rivals having clear run at the furlong marker and with a good late charge caught a fading runner late for the third place share all the while not beaten that much for all the money. GARNET AND GOLD sat alone in midfield watching the lead three along the backside, had a good turn of foot when scrubbed on for more midway on the bend, was coming on five wide at the top of the lane, drifted out under left-handed encouragement fighting for a minor share late and was just caught by the outside foe for the

EMPTY GESTURE had an inside spot near the back in the early stages, made little gain inside another through the bend, angled three wide turning for home, shifted out further in the four path with a furlong from home finding a seam, had to be checked at the seventy-yard marker losing her path and could not factor afterwards. YA MAR tracked the frontrunner on the inside along the backside, could not match strides with the outside rivals making a rally at the quarter pole and yielded on the fence with a furlong remaining.

ONE MORE BREW tracked the lead pair outside another foe along the backside, narrowed the margin on the leader in the three path between foes at the three eighths pole, moved well in hand in the mix five wide in upper stretch, closed in under steady encouragement by the eighth pole, took over control with a sixteenth mile left to go and held safe for the win at the wire. BREAKING ALONE settled in the third flight just off the rail inside another rival along the backside, was roused picking up the bit three wide between horses at the three eighths pole, gathered more momentum angling out six wide for the drive, lugged in staying on the left lead in mid-stretch, kept gaining steadily on the leader to the finish line but could not get to the winner in time and finished up second best. EL KABONG stalked close to the back of the pack while having runners on either side along the backstretch, made a savvy move getting to the rail midway on the bend starting to uncork a run, scraped the paint turning for home with a full head of steam, moved in to be in the thick of things on the fence by the furlong pole, could not get to the winner late and just missed holding for the pace share showing a solid effort inside foes down the lane. FIGHTER IN THE WIN had a slim lead early on in the back straight, shook clear loose up top around the turn, still was quite in control three wide at the top of the lengthy stretch, began to fade between foes in the final sixteenth of a mile and settled on the fringes in the end. ALLEY OOP JOHNNY travelled on the rail watching the lead duo along the backside, crept closer to the frontrunner on the fence with three furlongs to run, was in the thick of things in the two path at the top of the lane, battled on until the furlong marker and stalled between horses in deep stretch. C MY MEISTER was away a step slow to trail on the break, advanced mildly inside rivals to sit in midfield into the turn, closed gap on the leaders going three wide midway around the bend, shifted out in the four path looking for running room at the head of the lane, shifted out six wide going back to the incorrect lead at the sixteenth pole and could not factor late.
